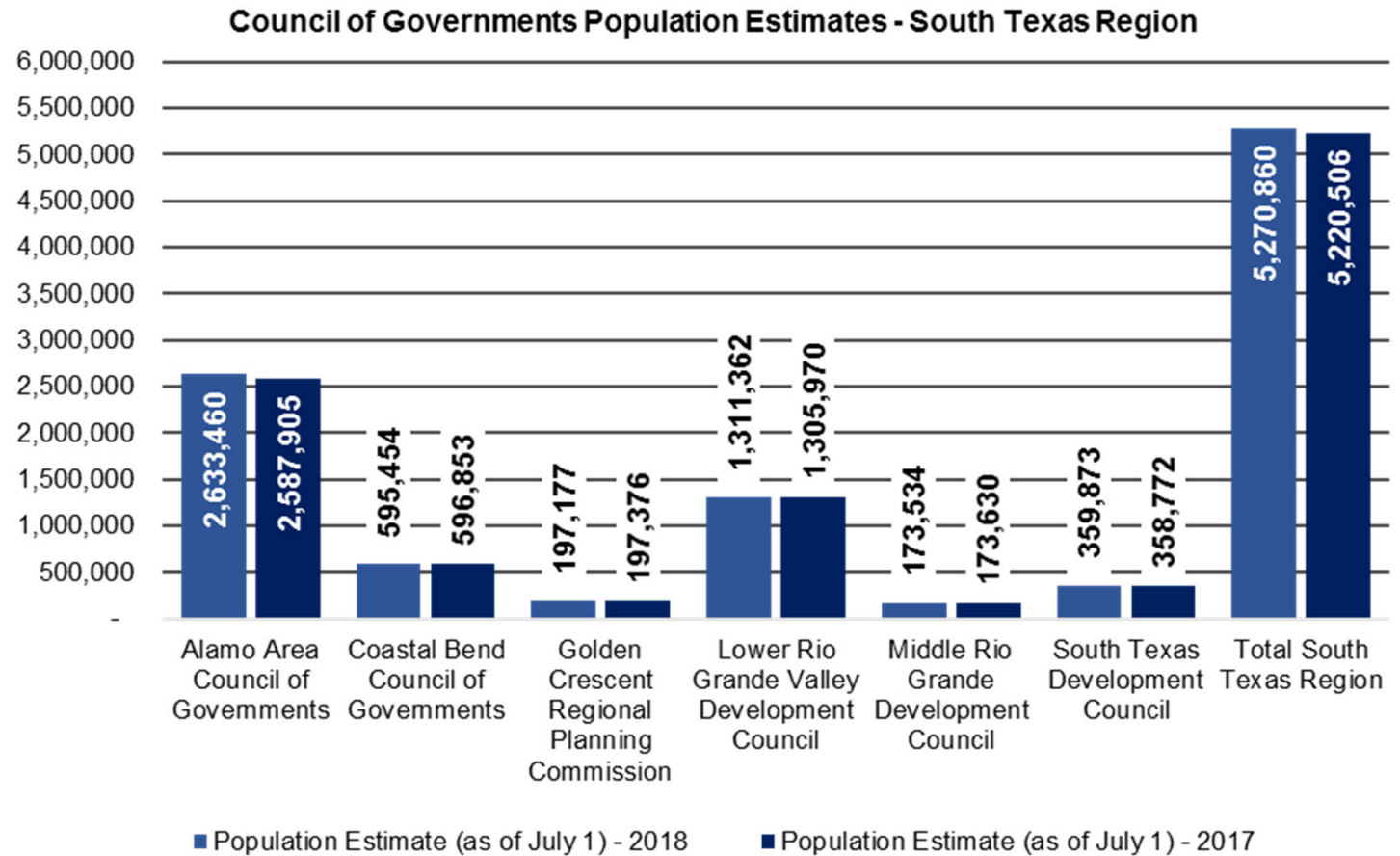

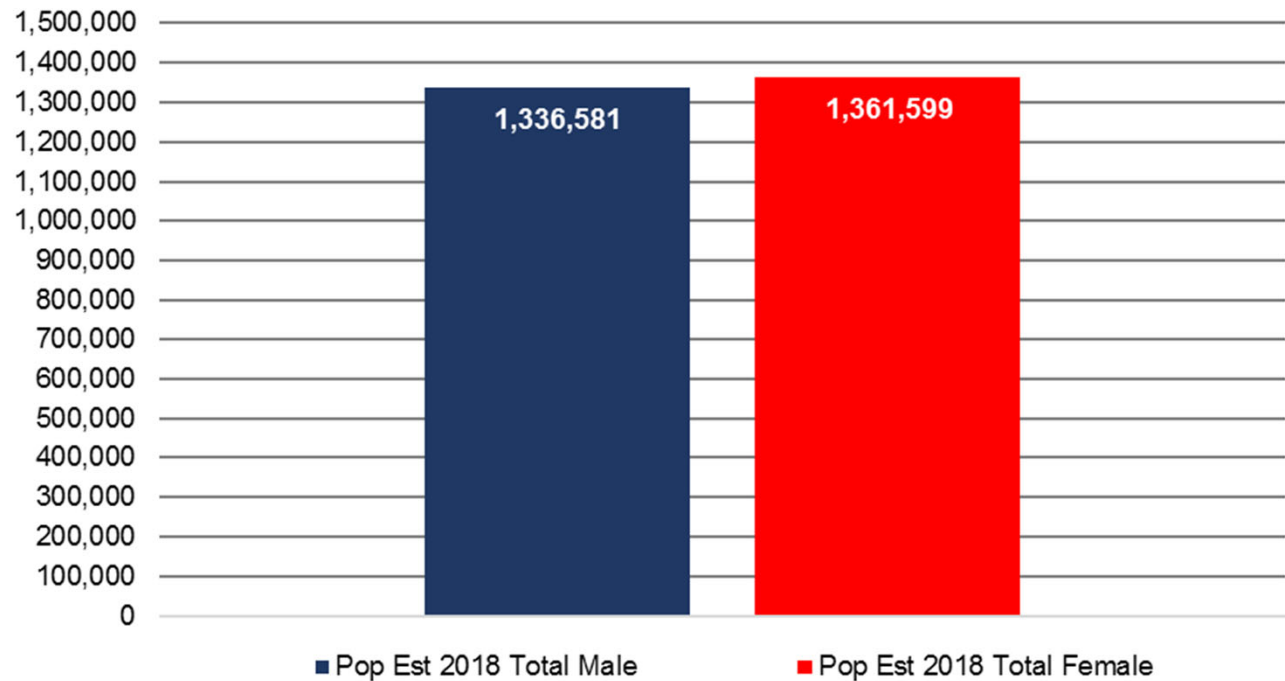

COG Population = 2,698,180

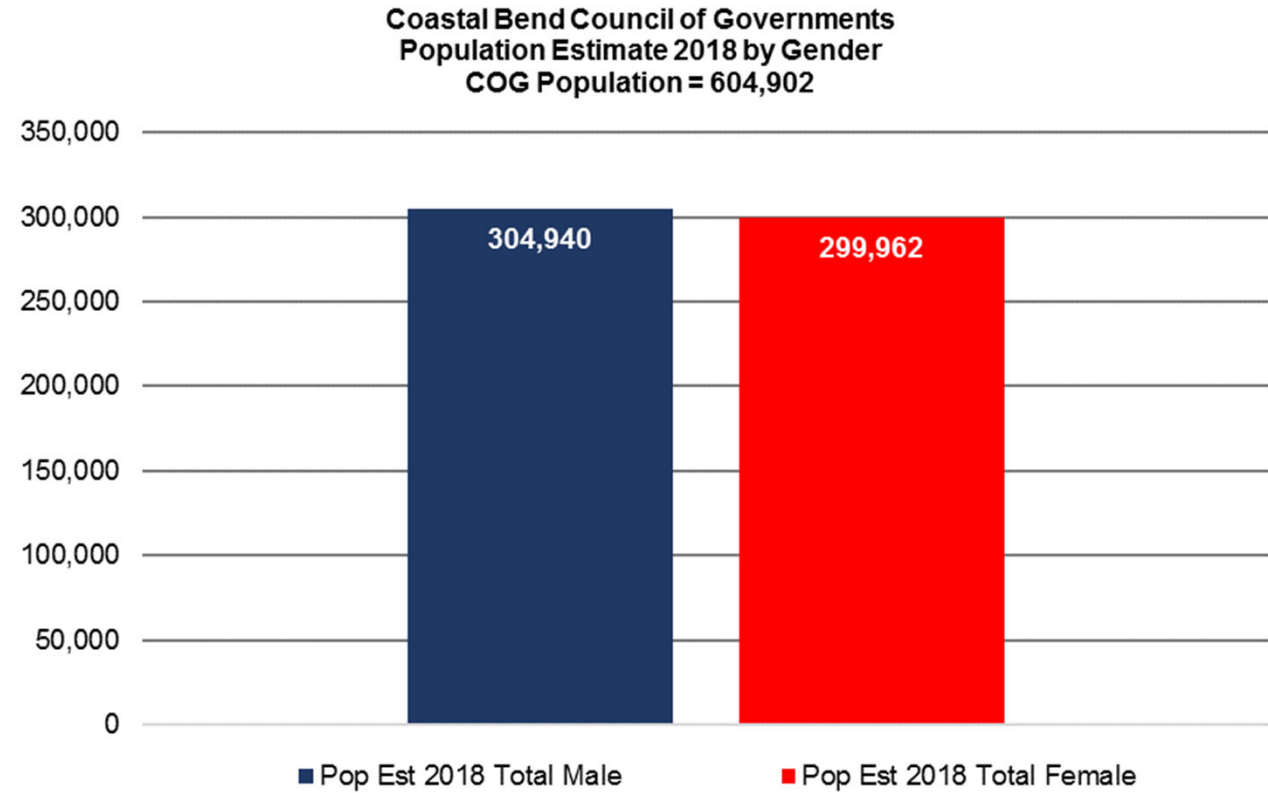

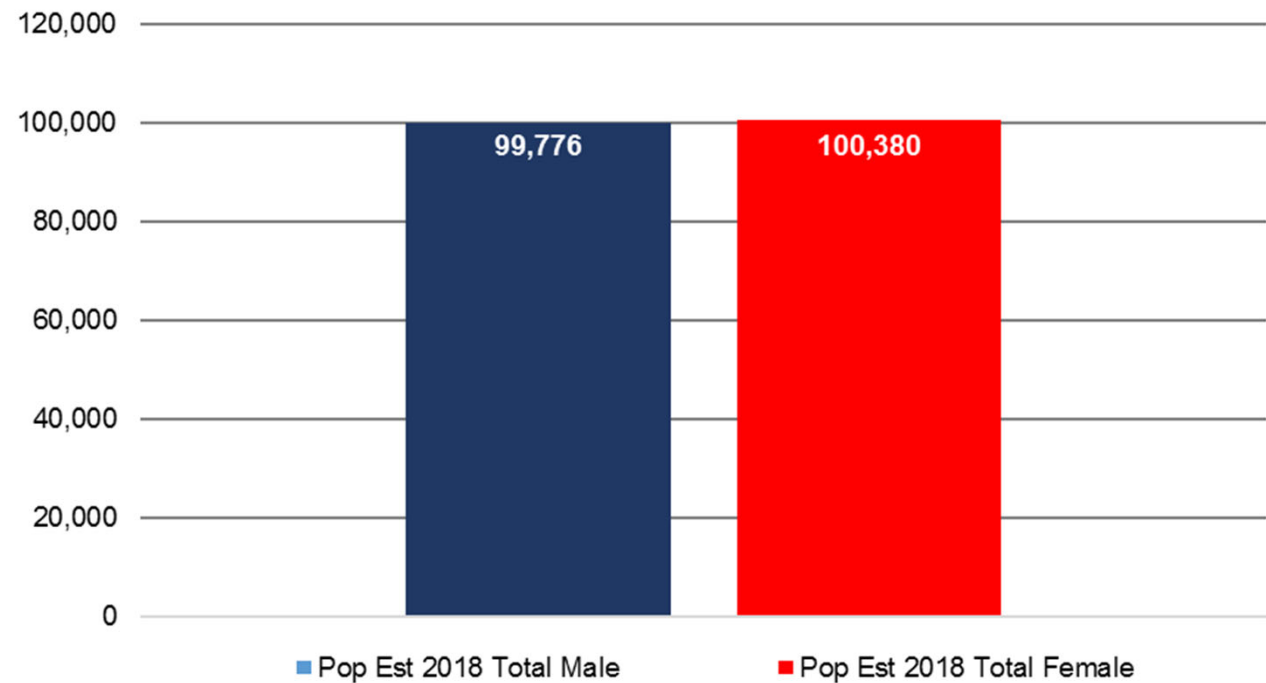

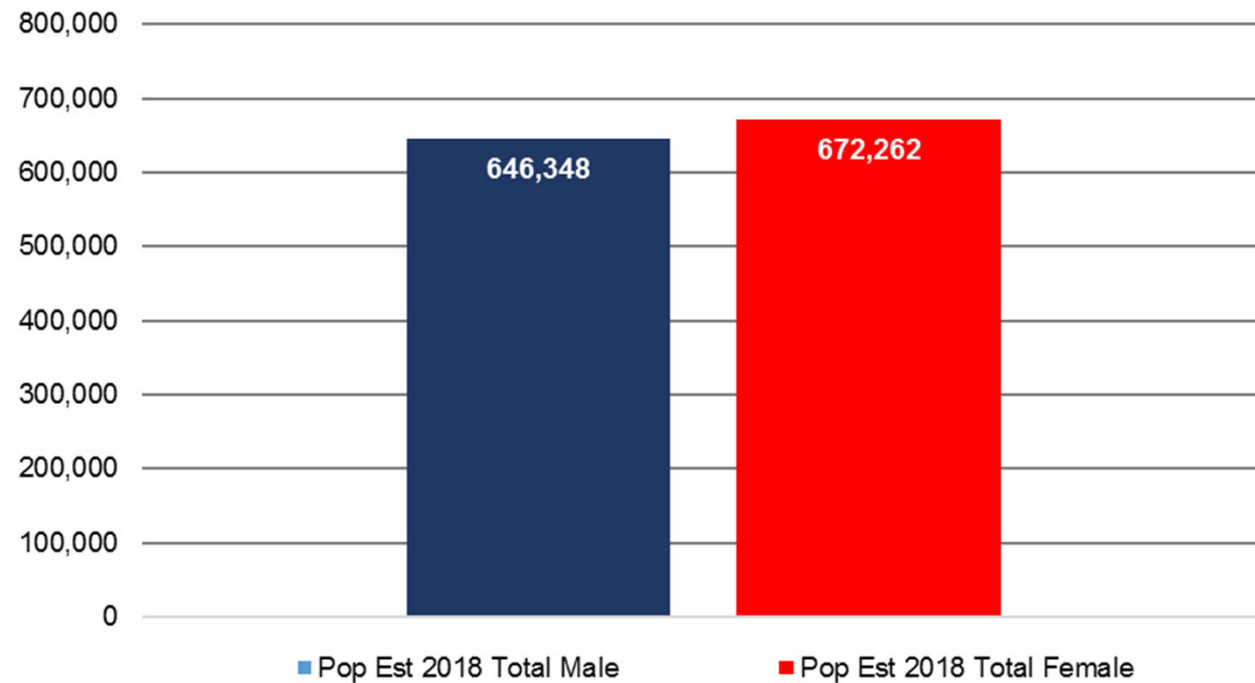

COG Population = 1,318,610



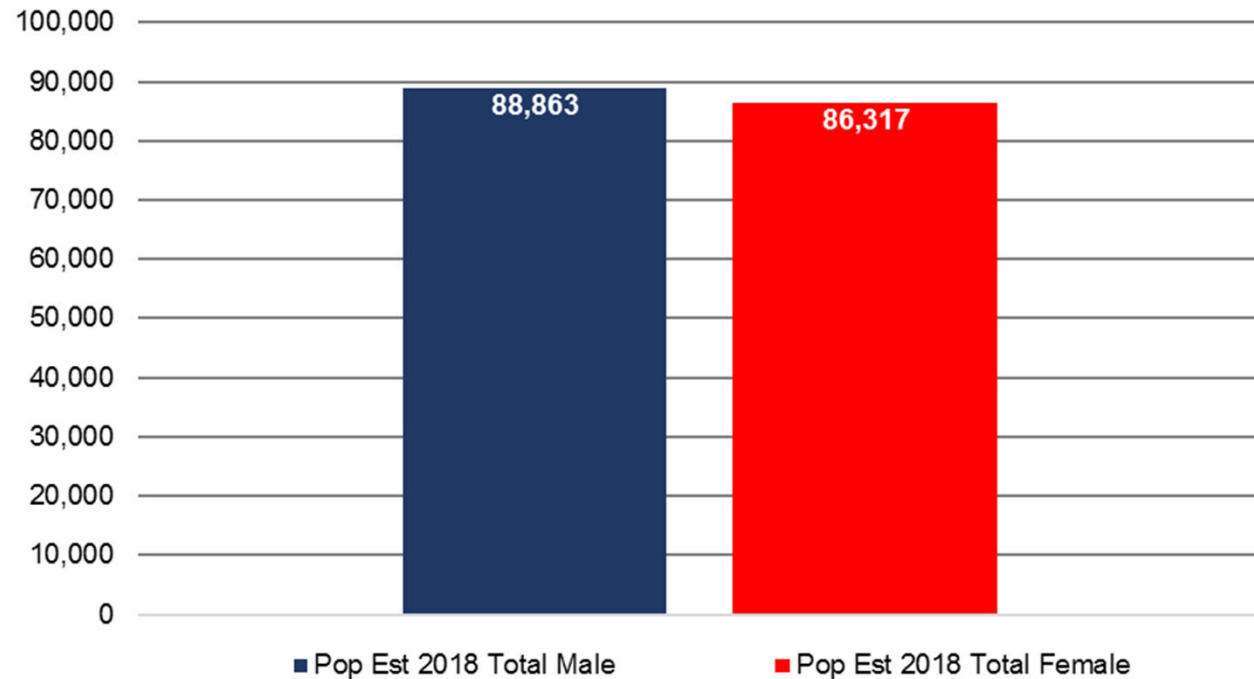

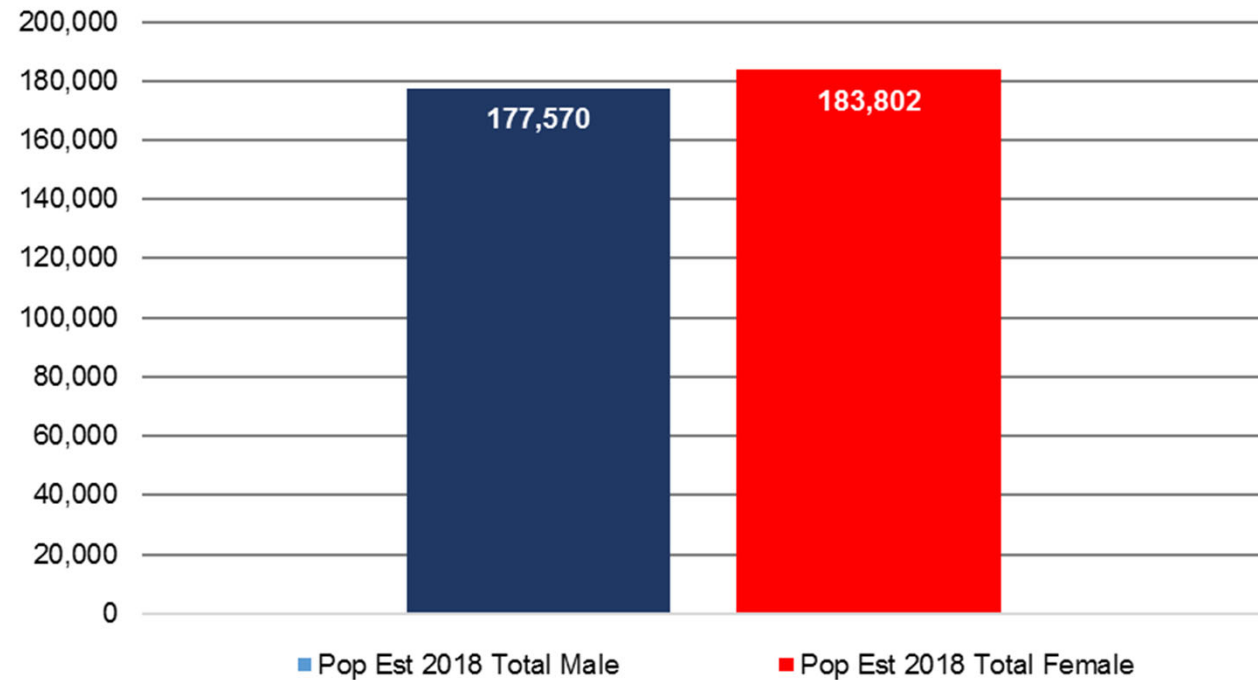

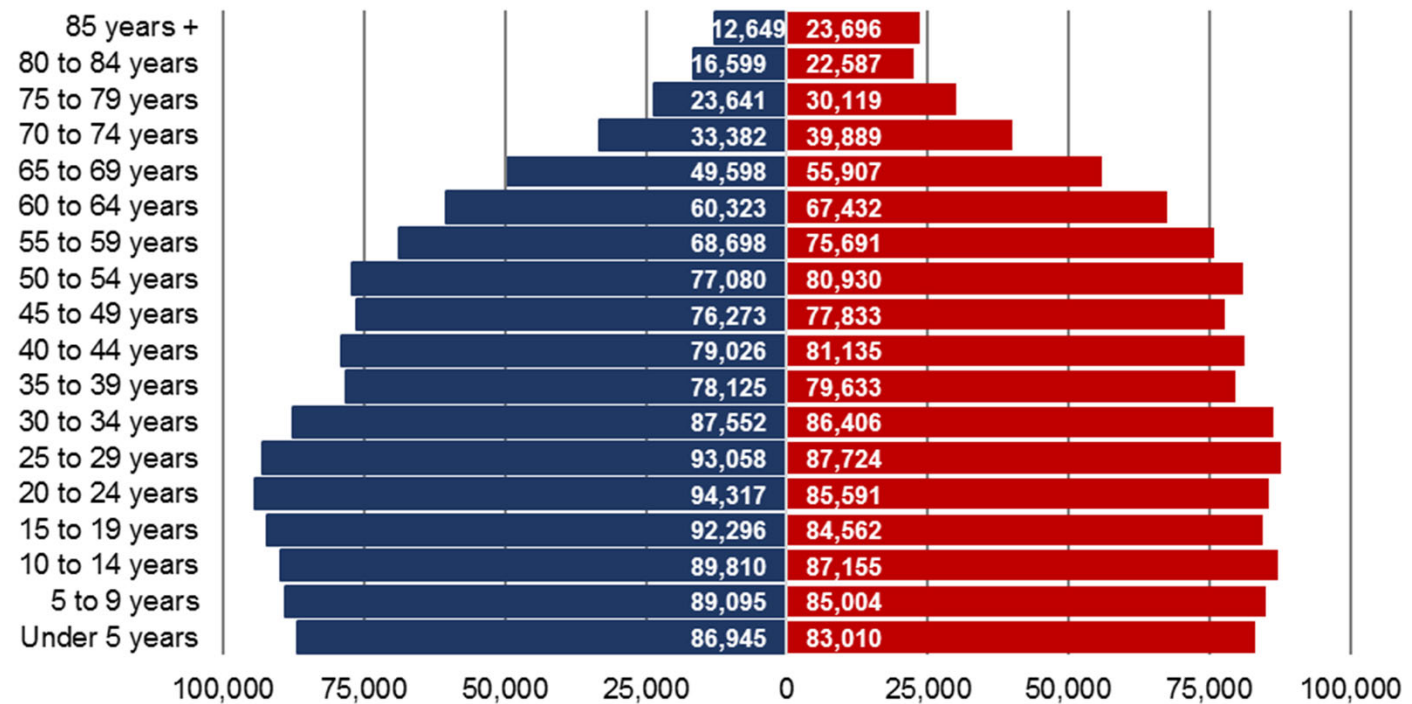

COG Population = 2,442,779



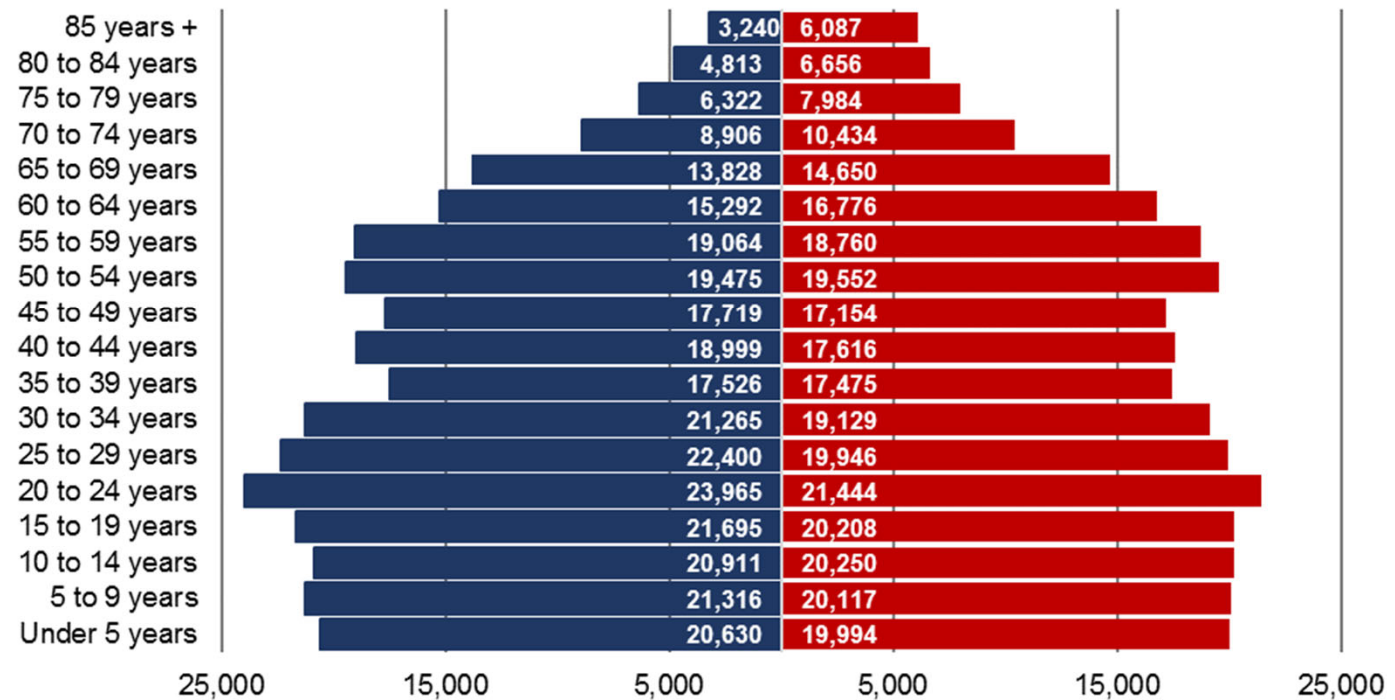

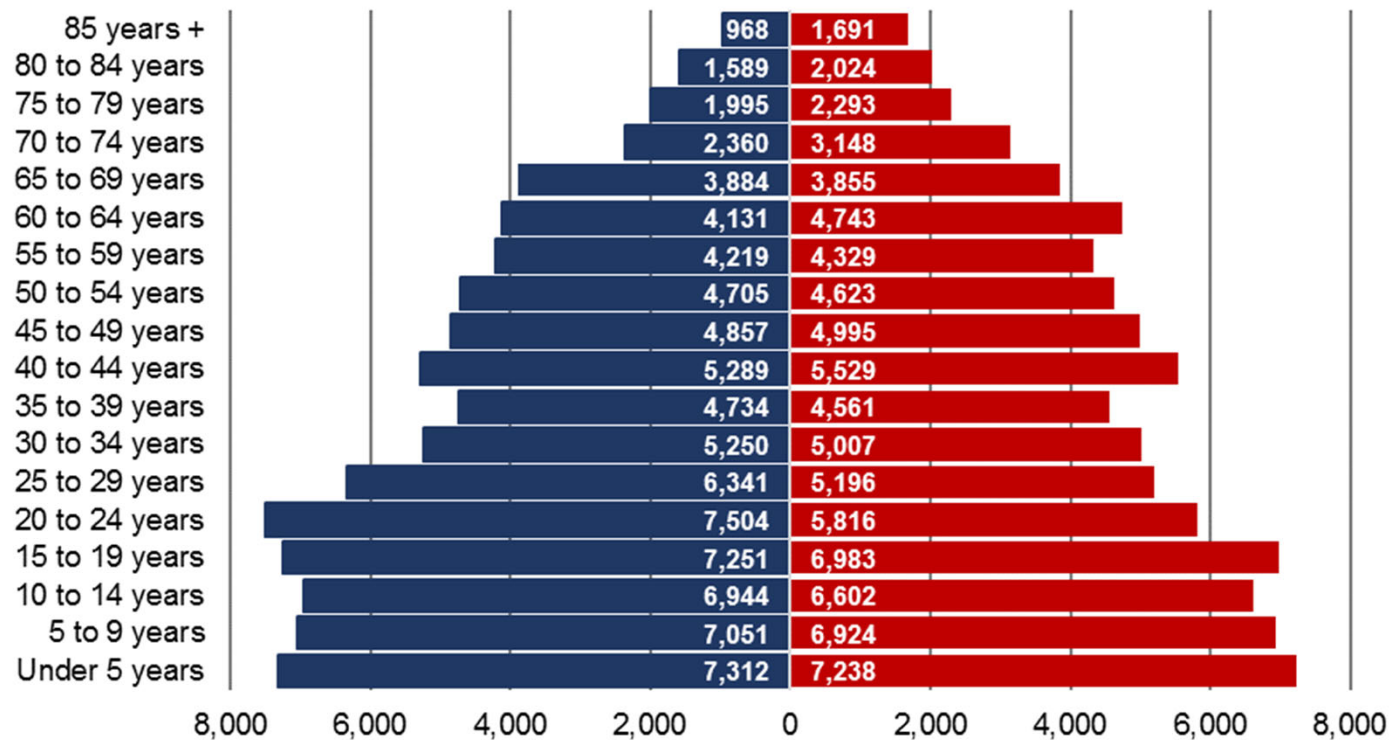

COG Population = 171,969



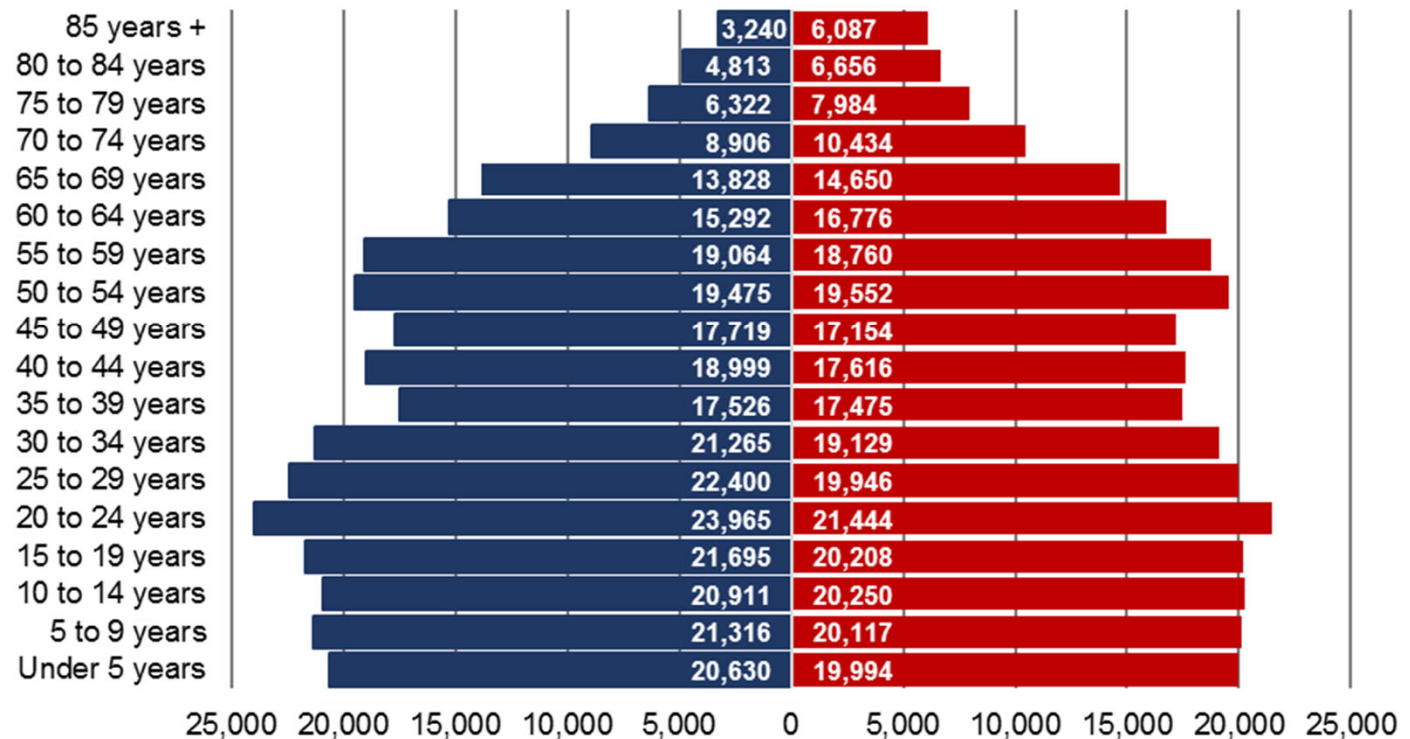

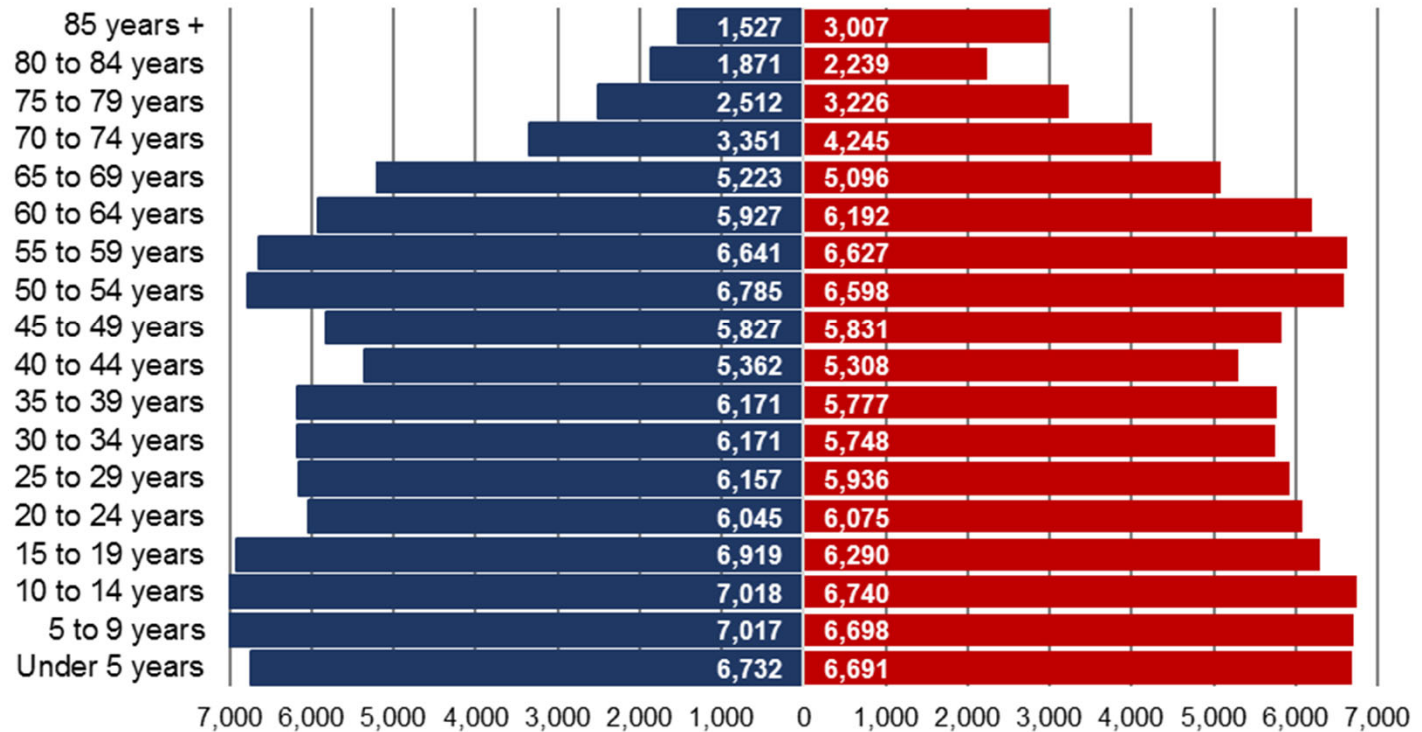

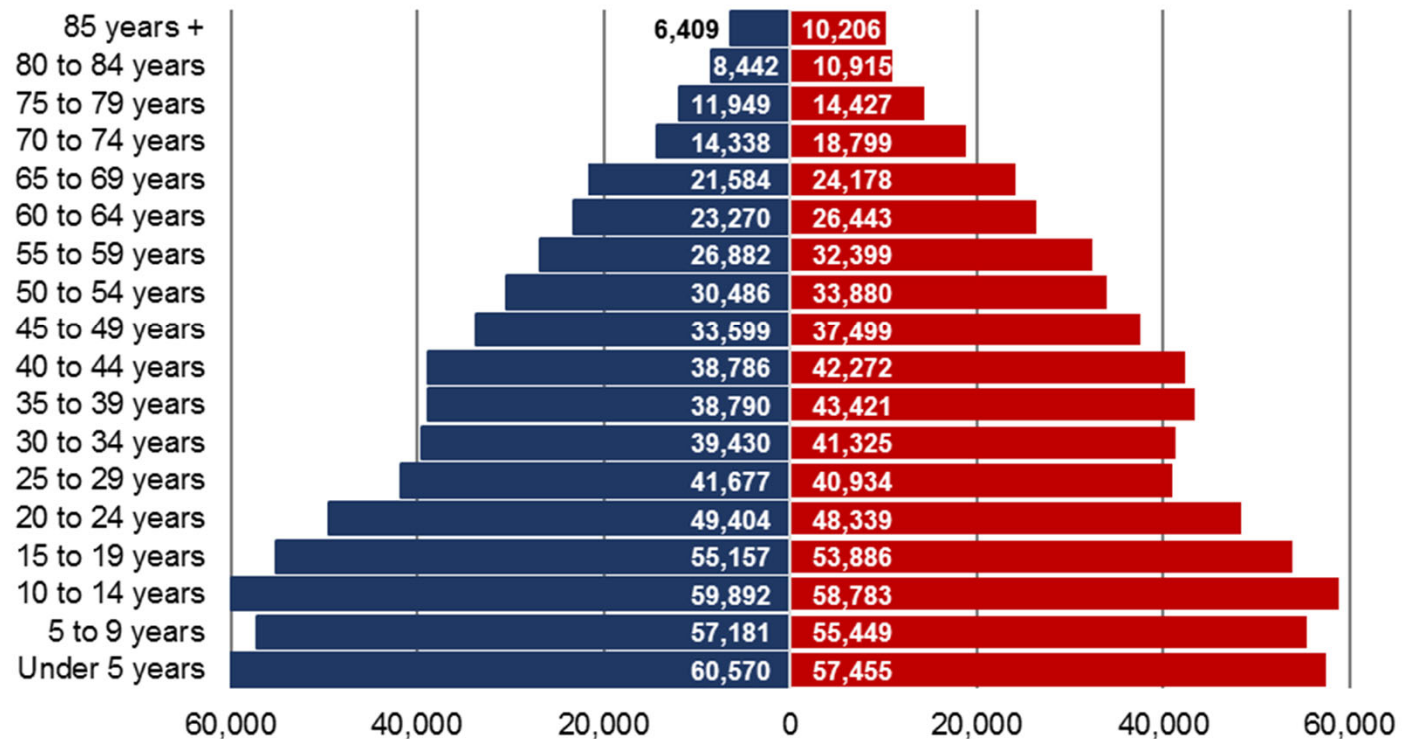

COG Population = 1,269,063



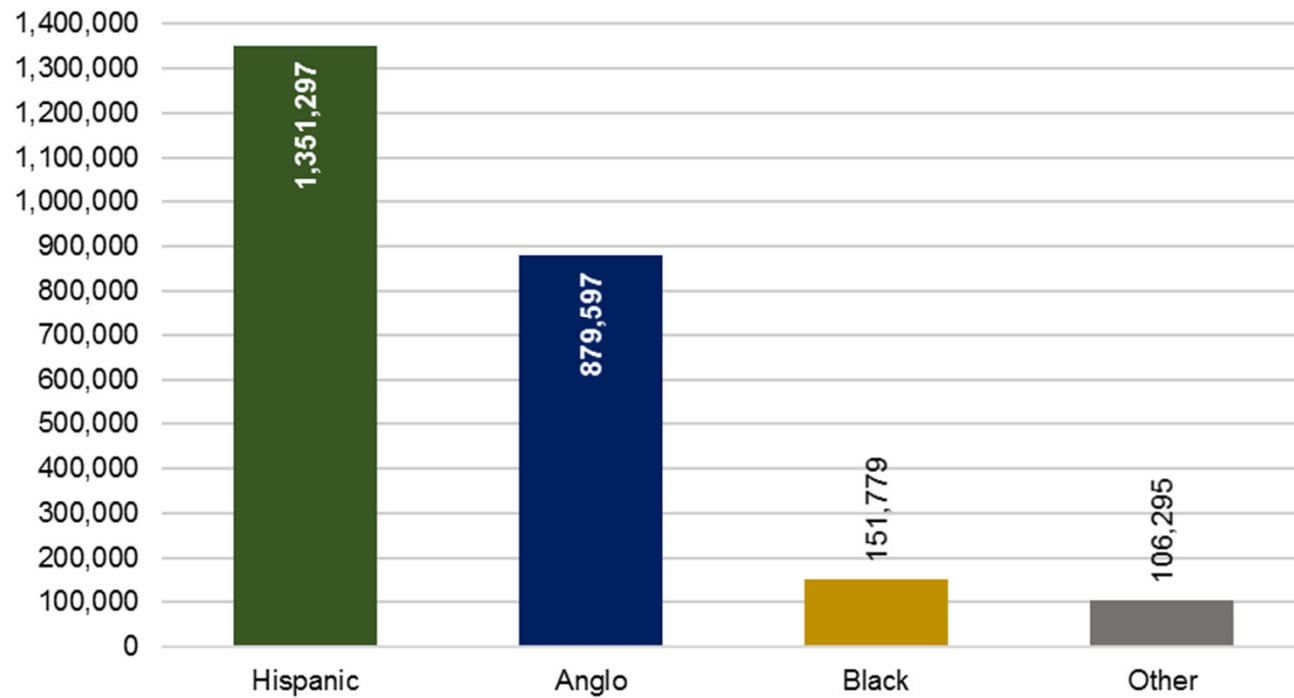

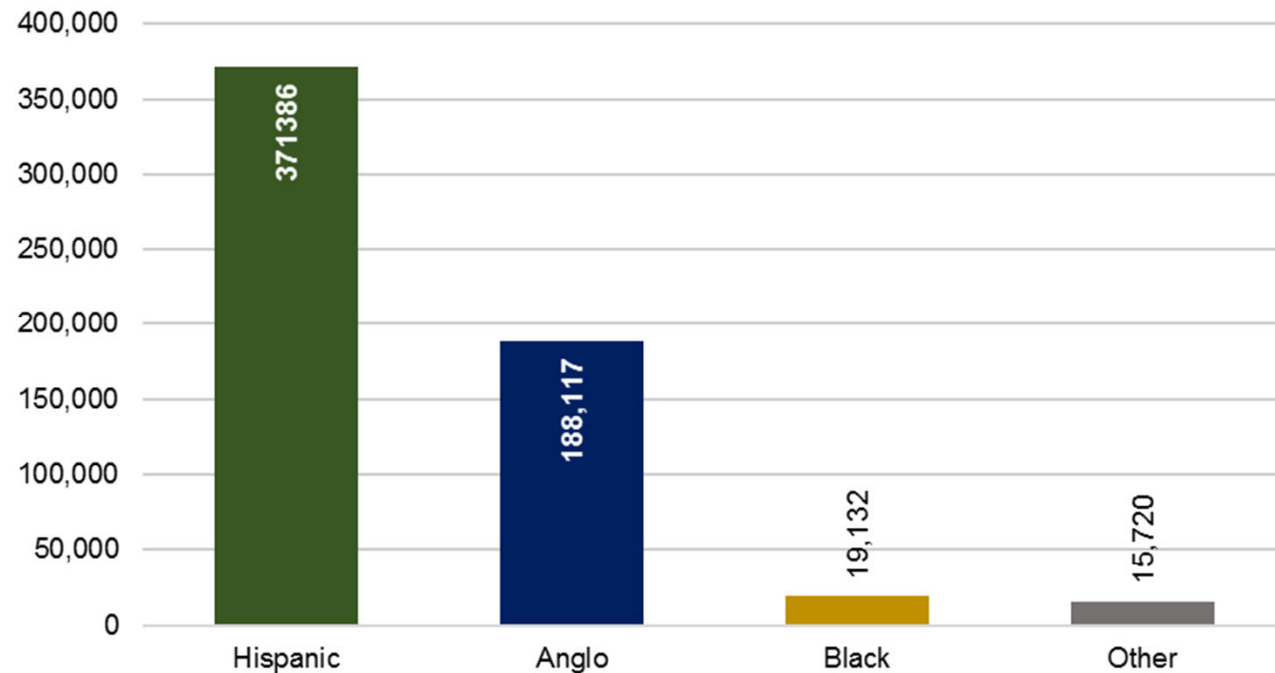

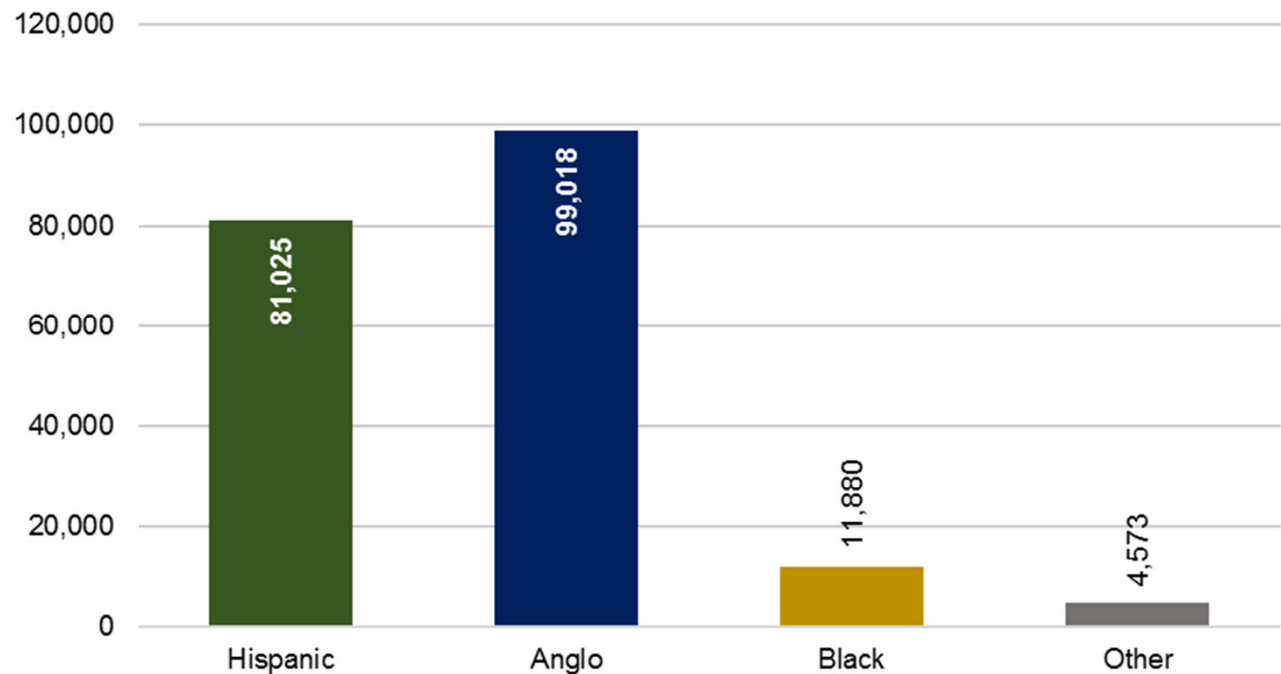

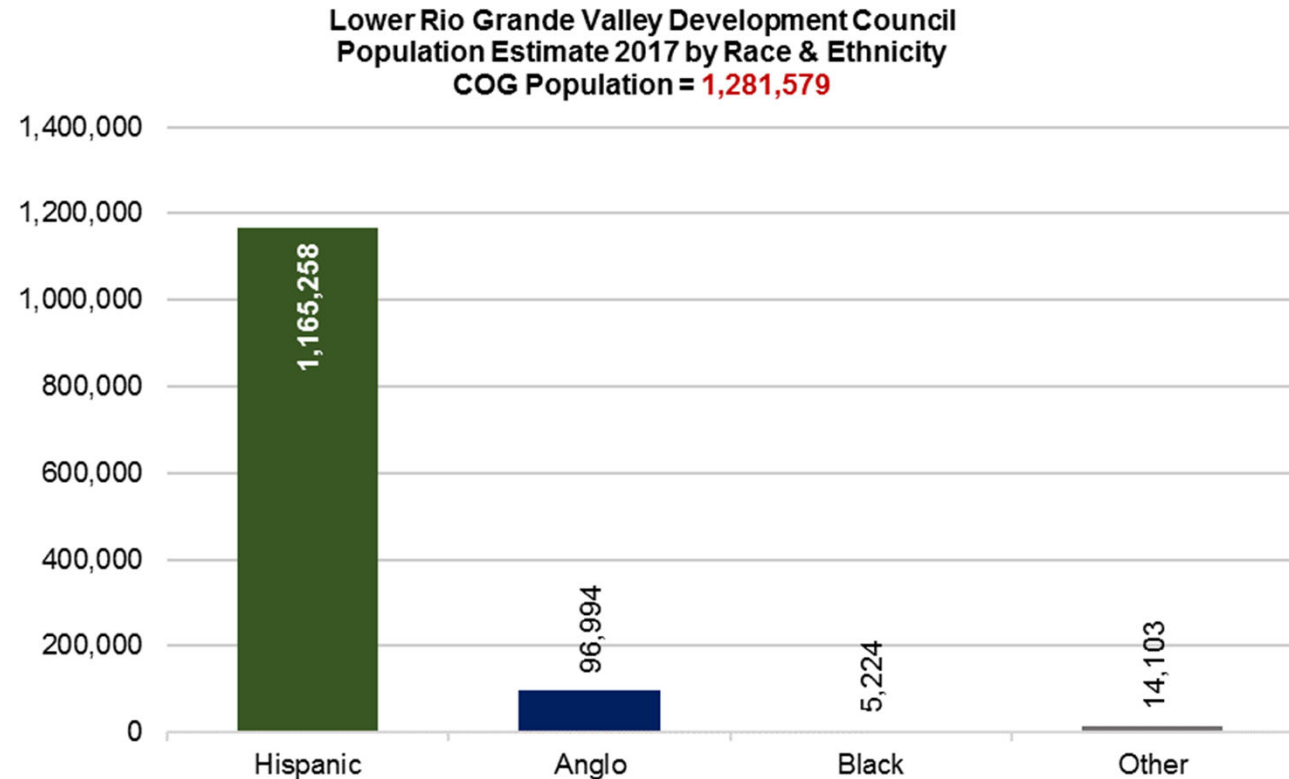

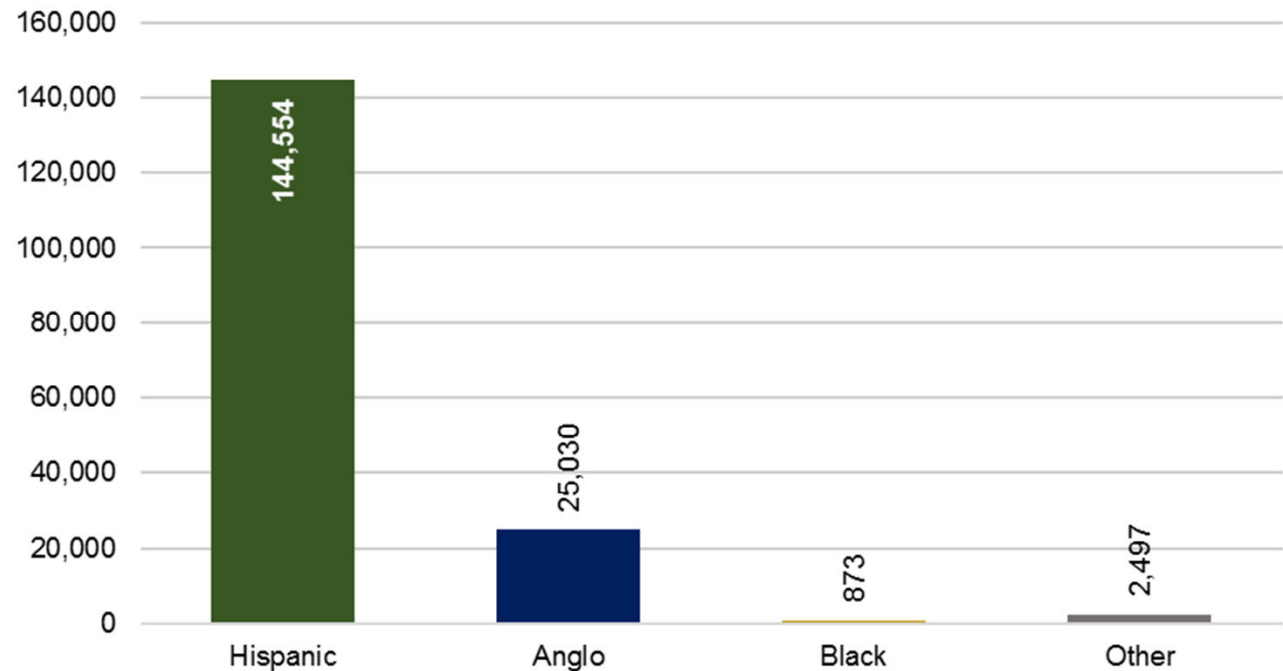

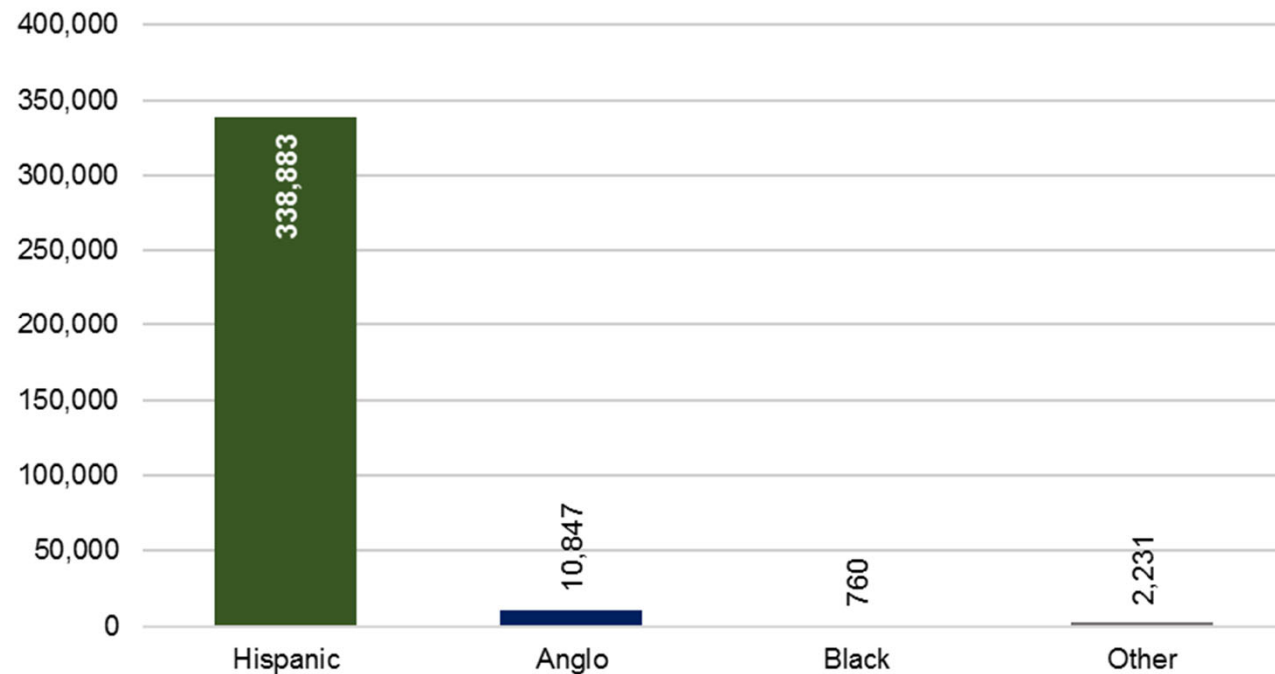

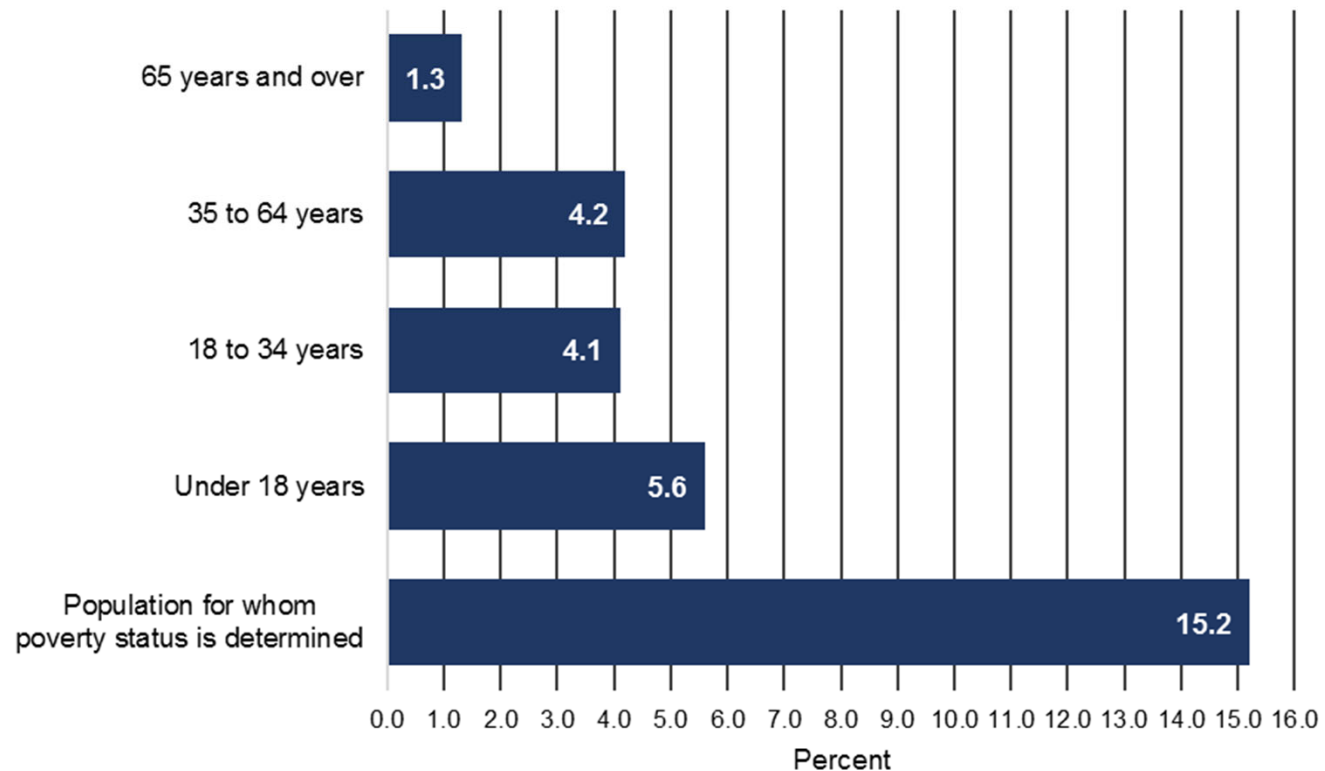

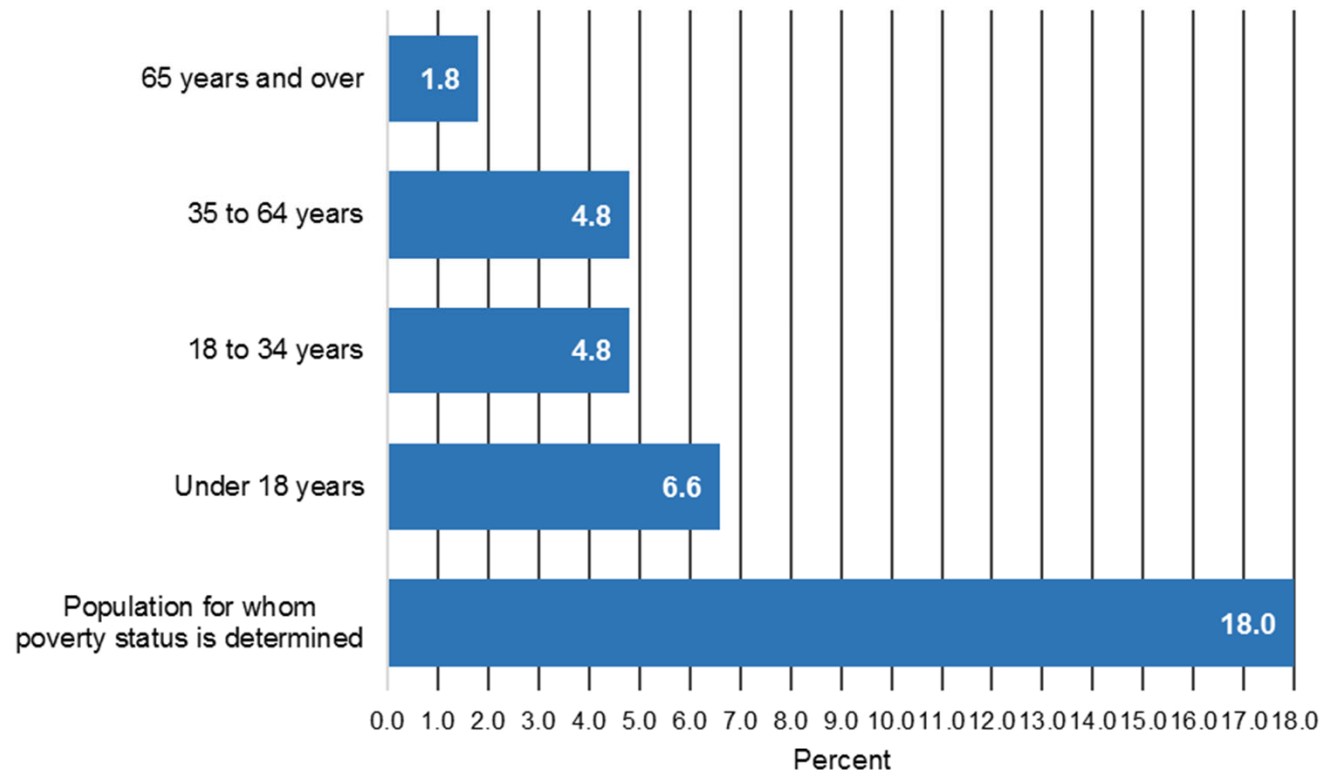

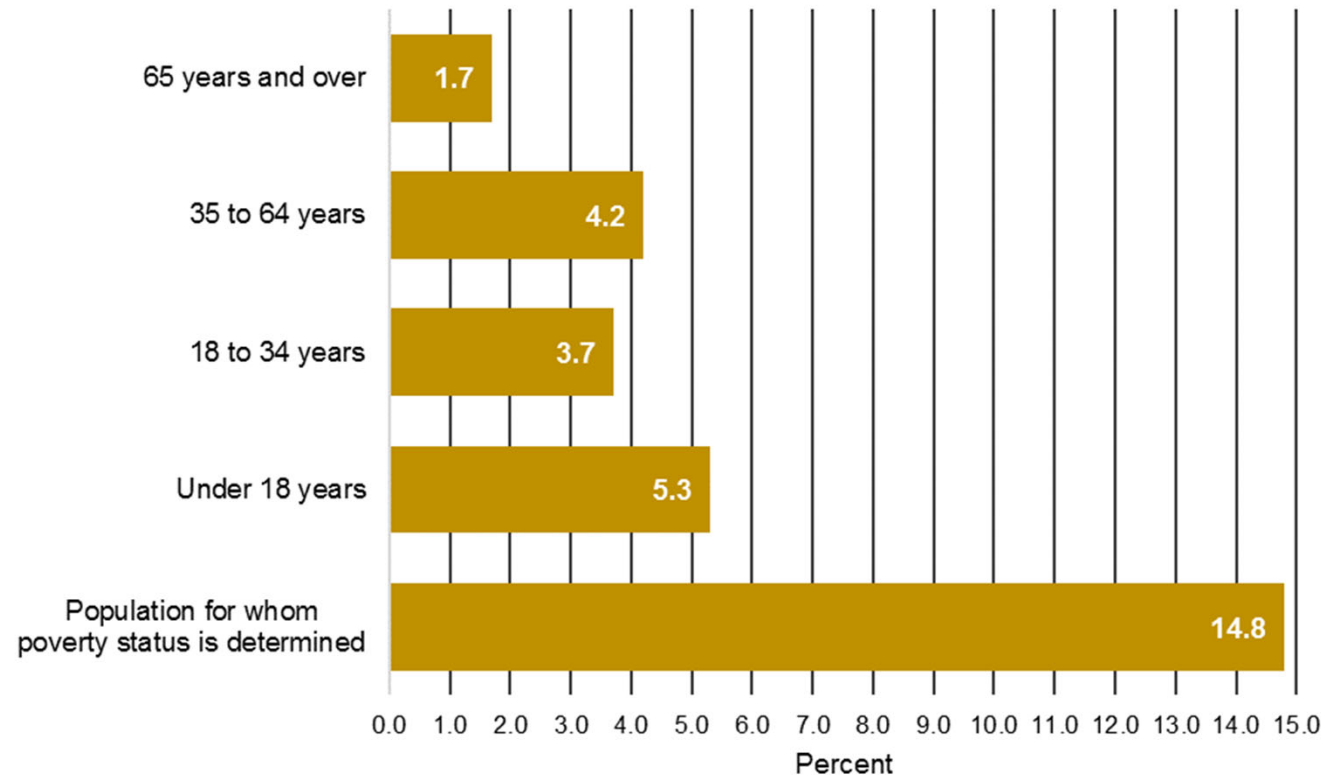

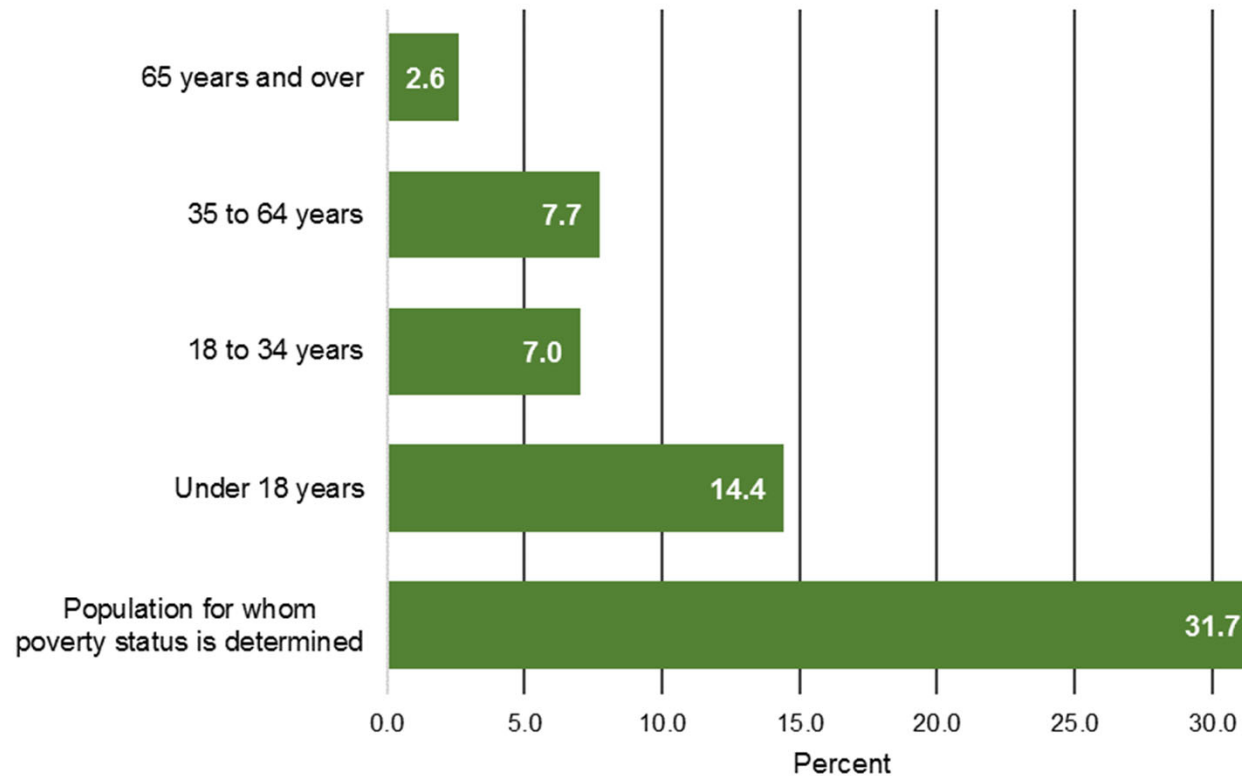

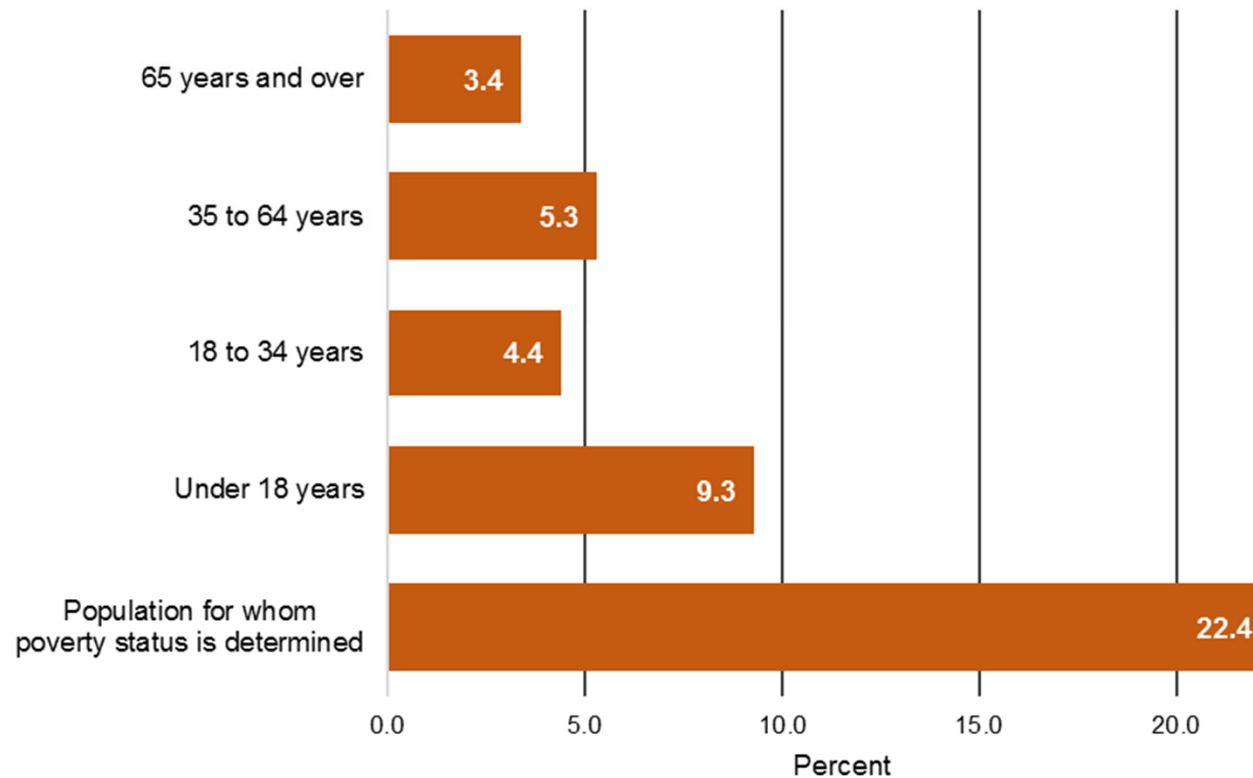

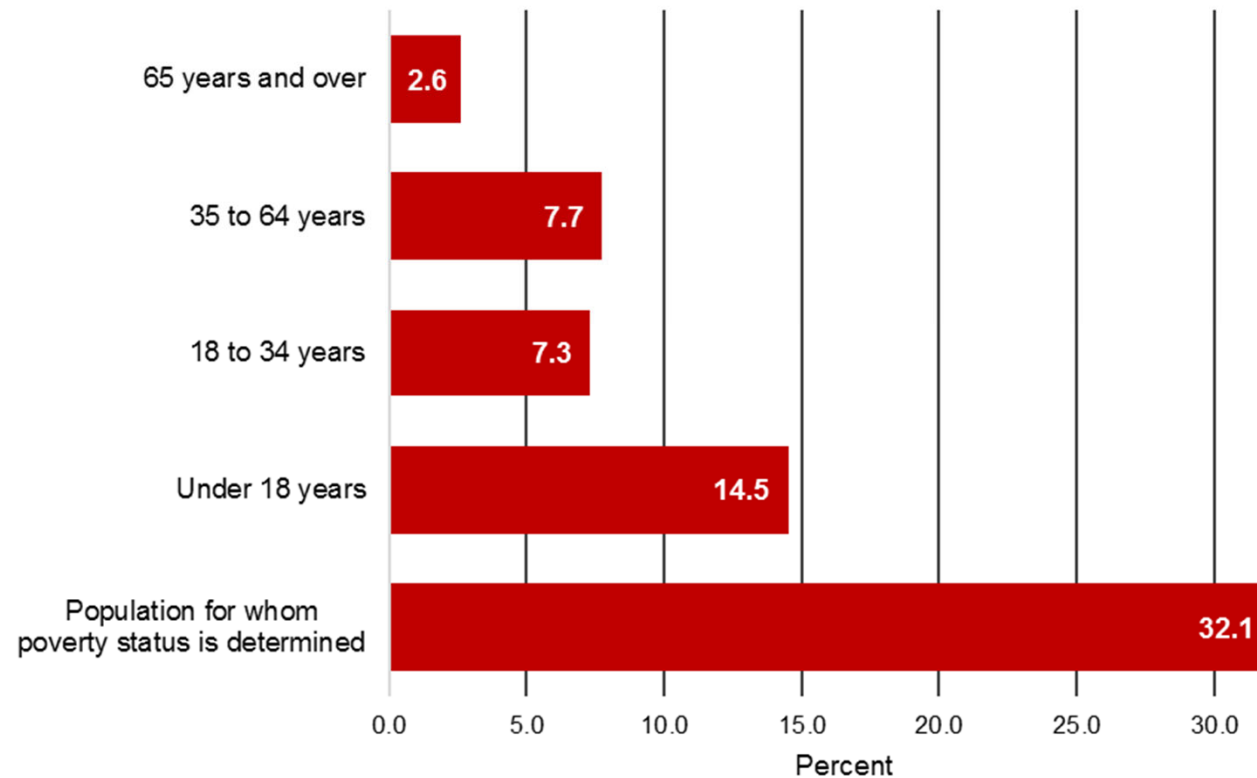
