






Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council Population Estimate 2018 by Gender COG Population = 1,318,610


Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council Counties Population Estimate 2018 by Gender

Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council 2018 Population by Age Groups COG Population = 1,269,063



Population gy Age Group County Population = 217,555






Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council Population Estimate 2017 by Race & Ethnicity COG Population = 1,281,579


Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council Counties Hispanic and Non hispanic Population Estimate 2017












Council of Governments Percent of Population with No Health Insurance Coverage - All Ages by Gender










Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council Percent Estimate of Educational Attainment by Individuals Age 25 and Over Attaining Population = 712,602








Percent Estimate of Educational Attainment by Individuals Age 25 and Over




Lower Rio Grande Valley Development Council 2018 Labor Force






Council of Governments 2018 Unemployment




Council of Governments 2018 Unemployment Rate
