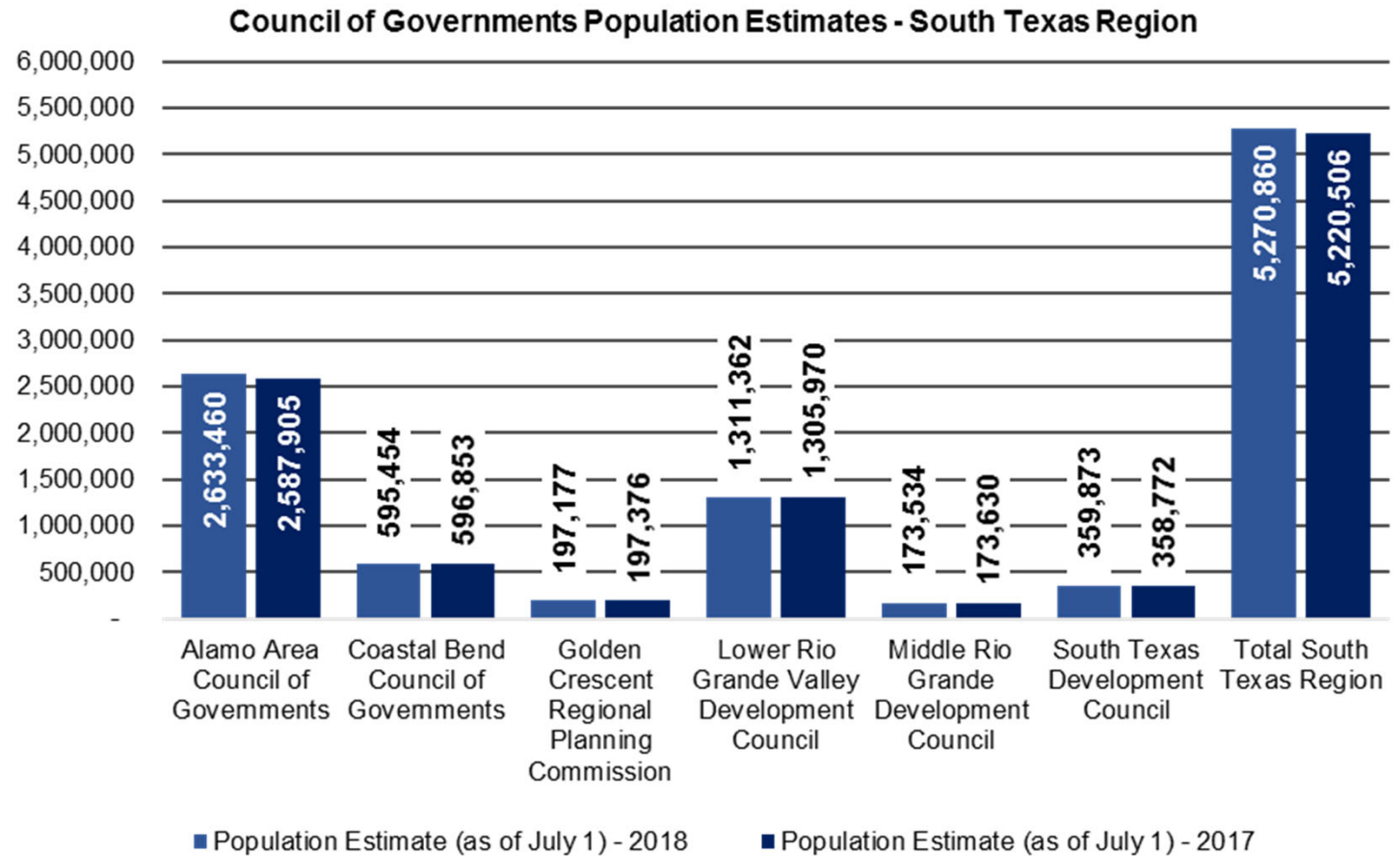

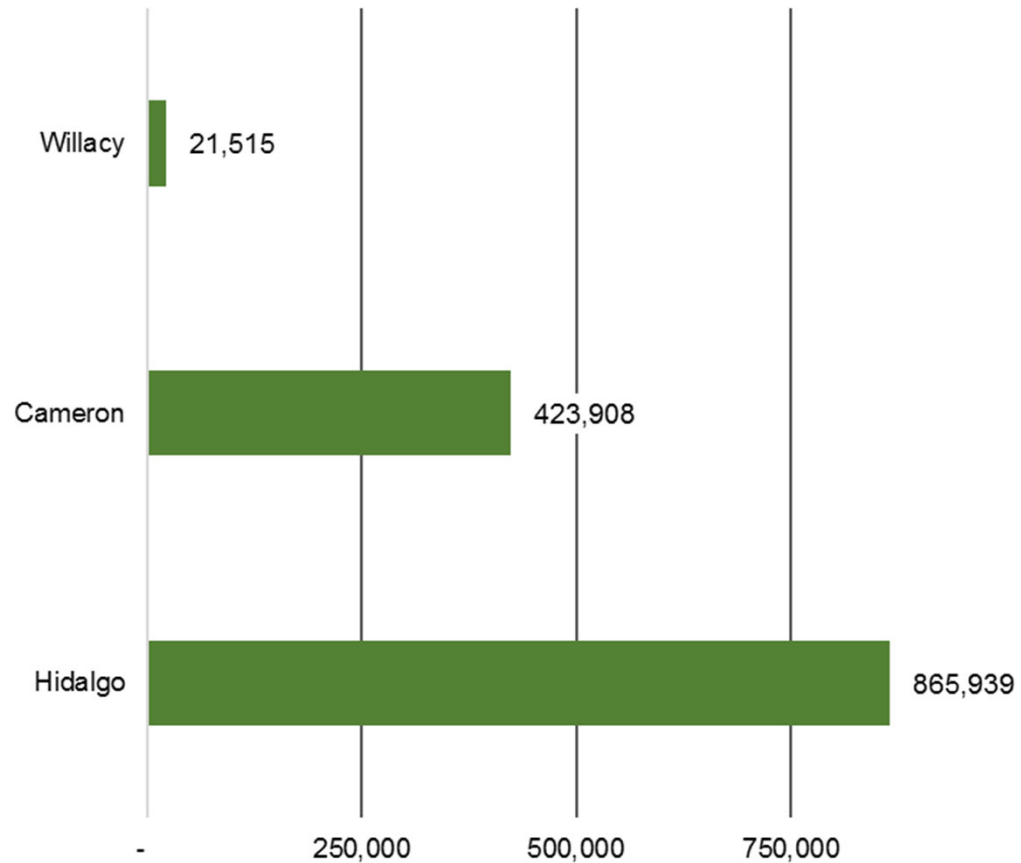

COG Population = 1,305,970



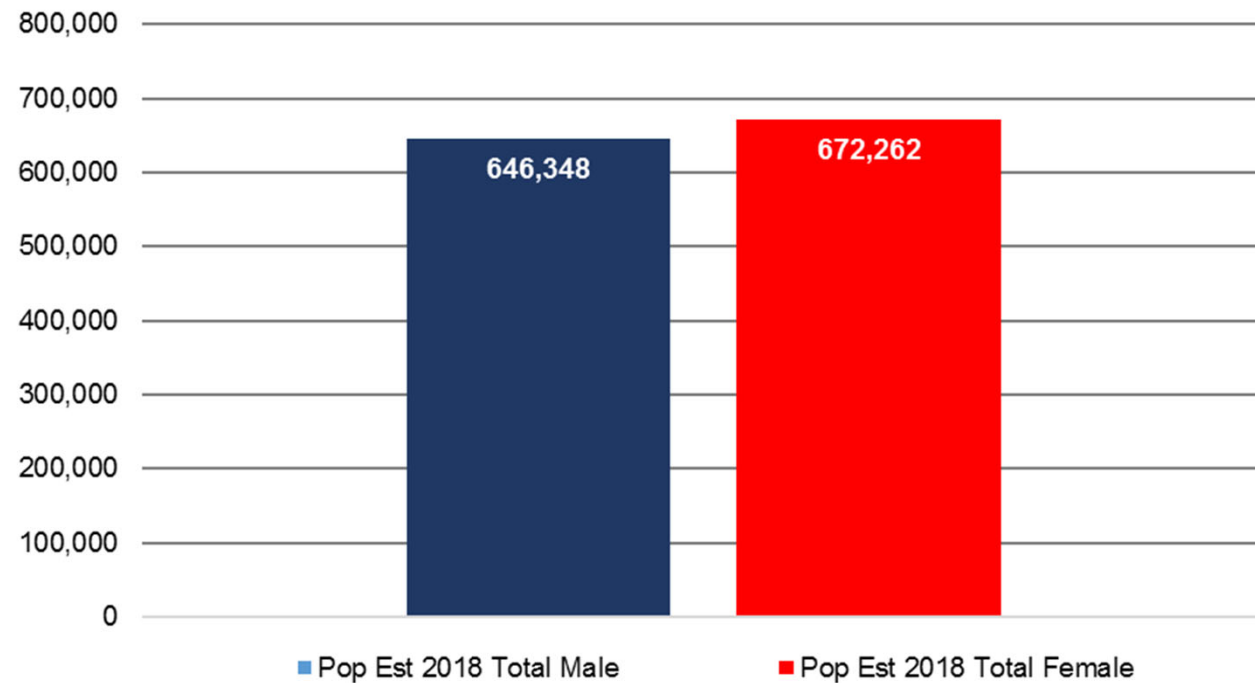

COG Population = 1,318,610**



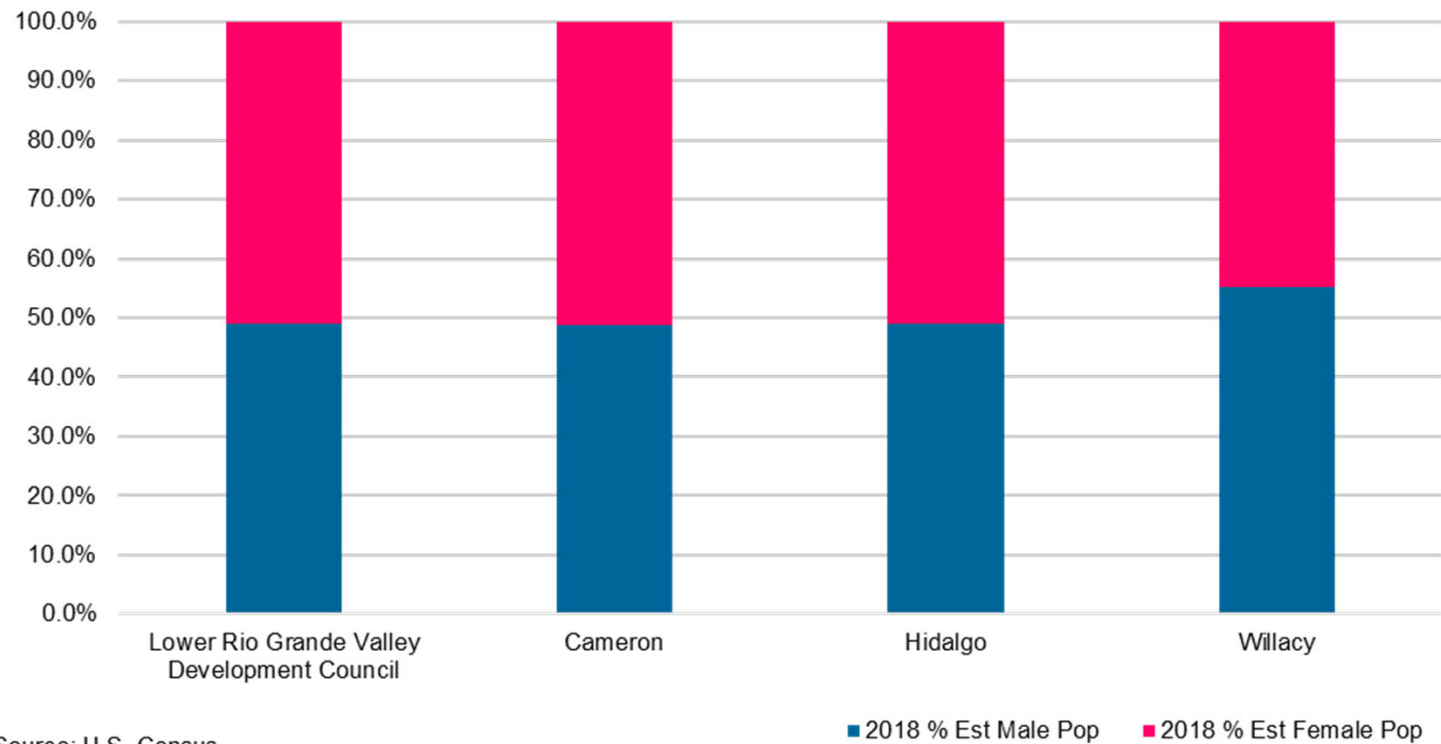

Population Estimate 2018 by Gender

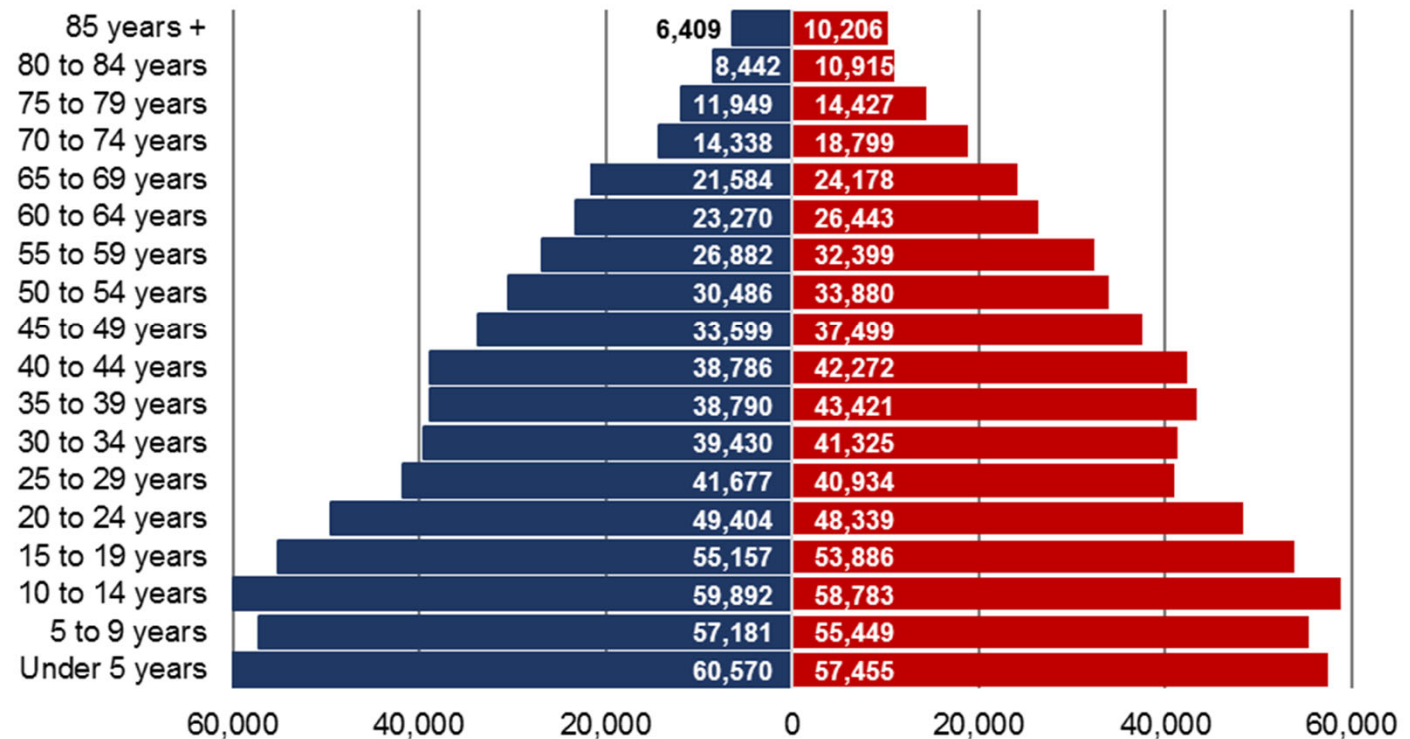

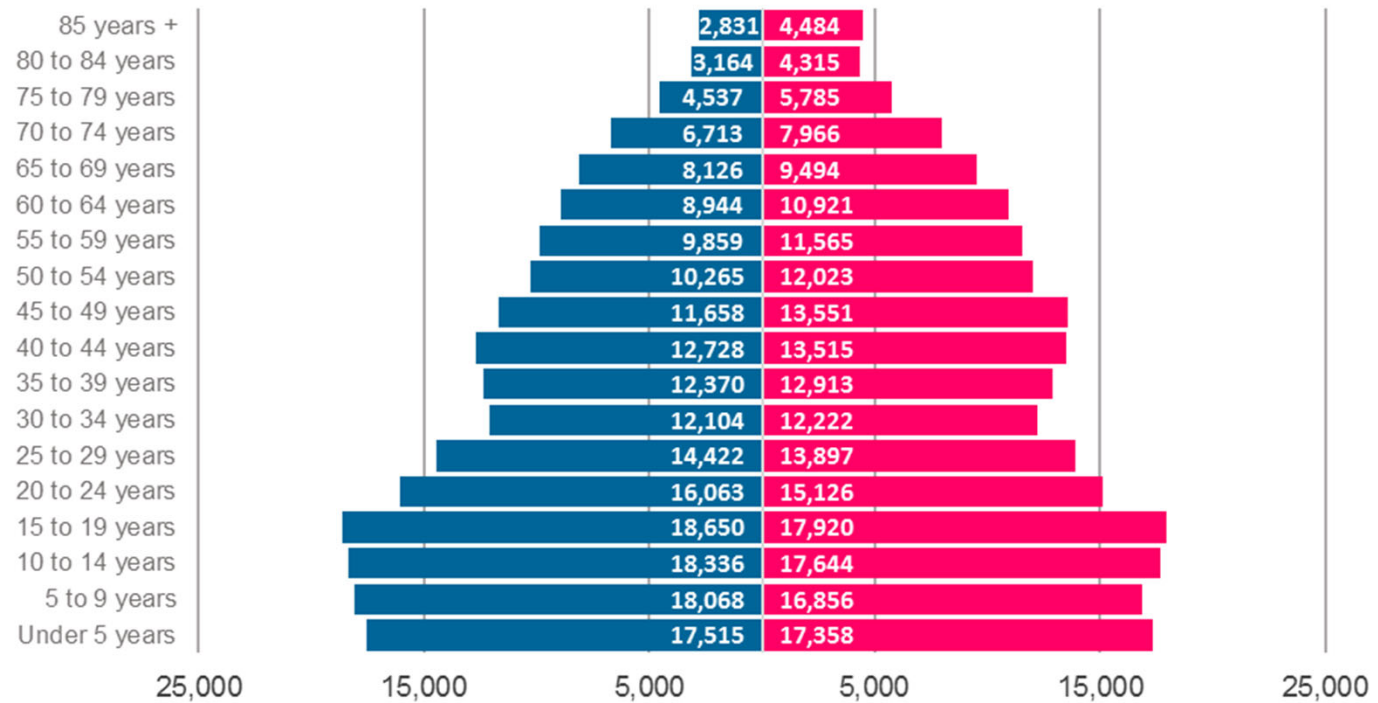

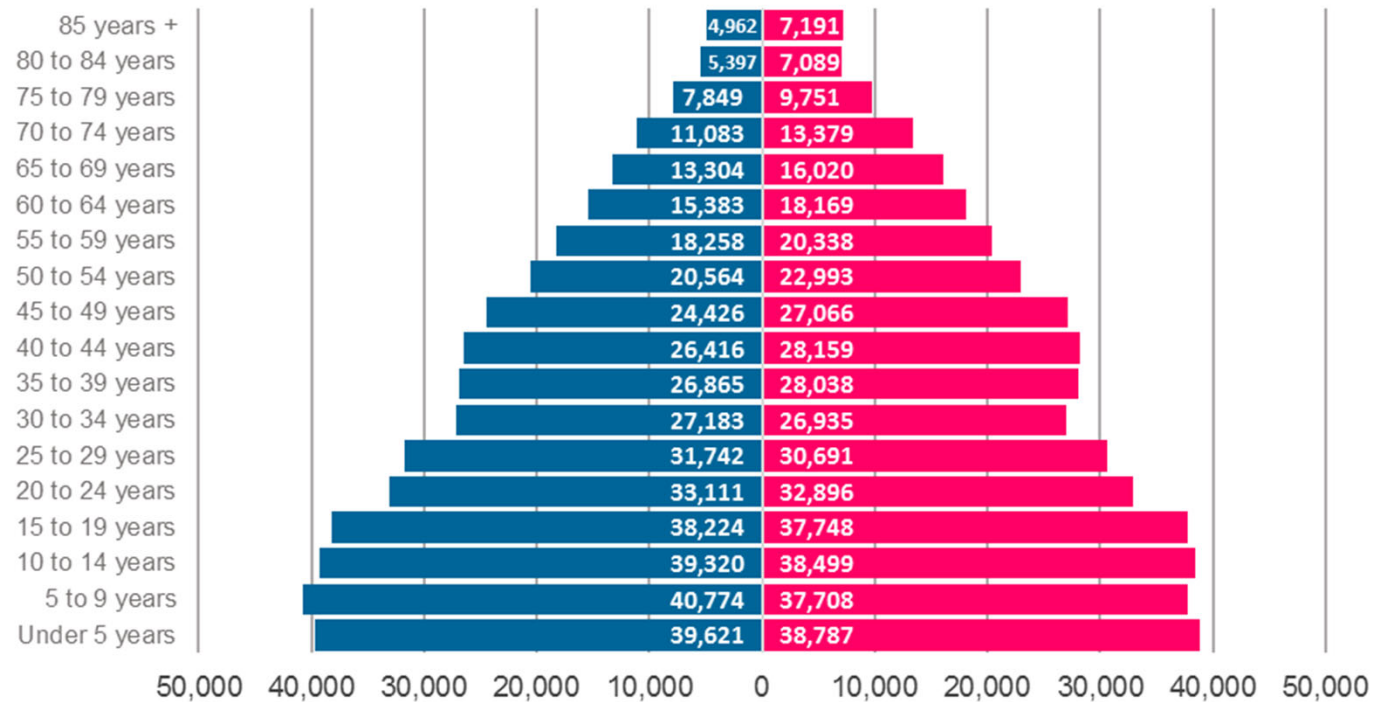

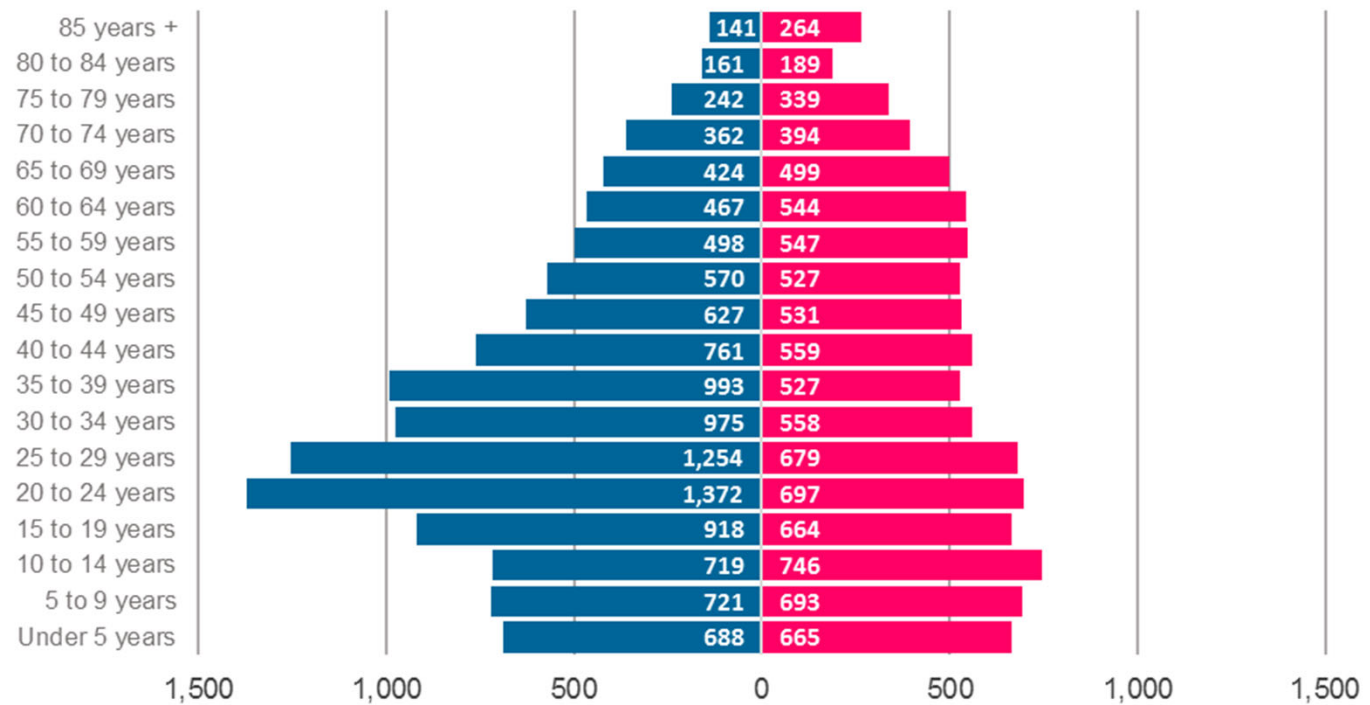

County Population = 21,515

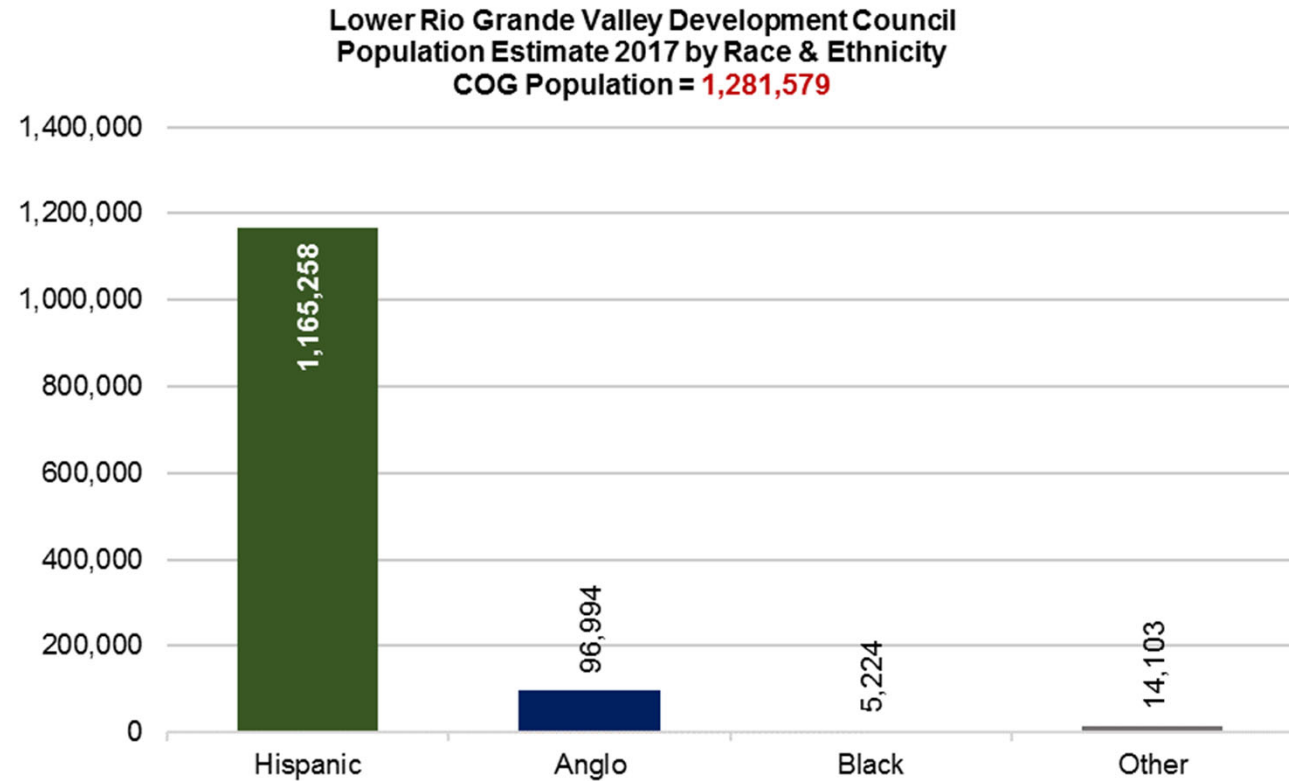

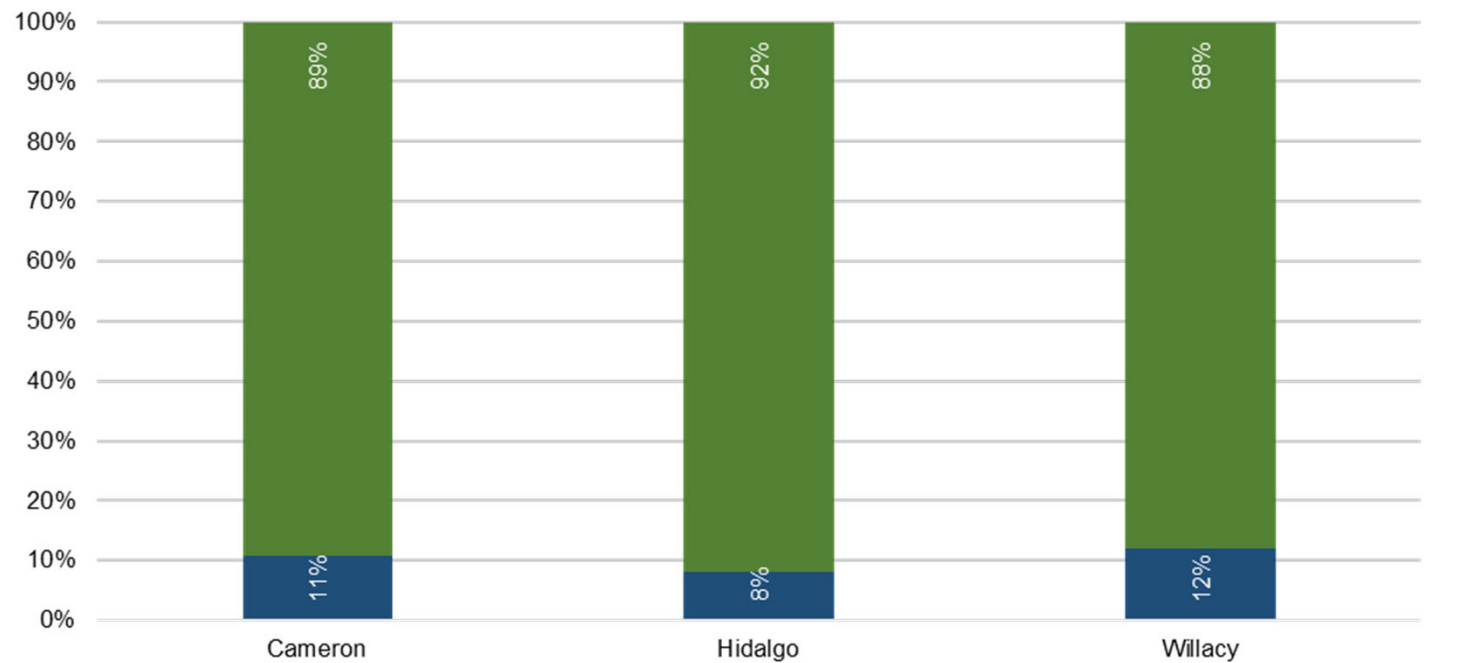

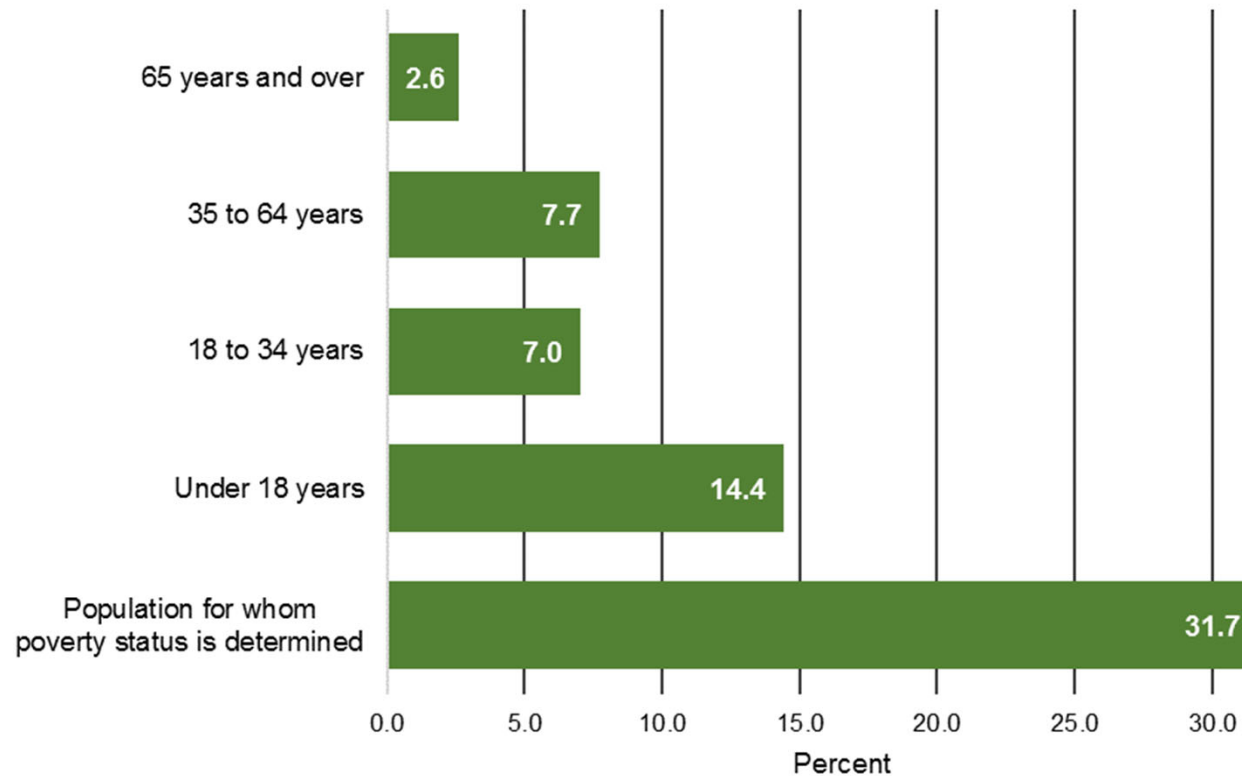

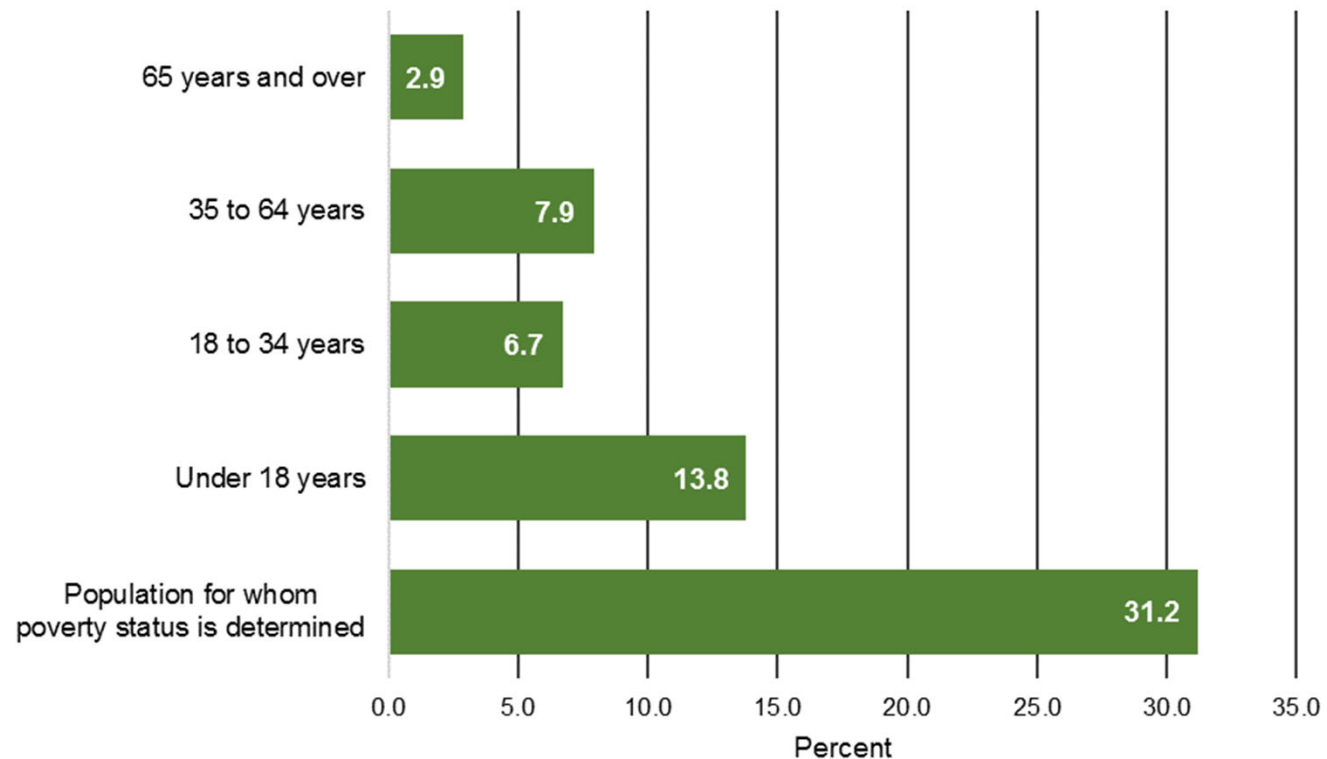

County Population = 415,789



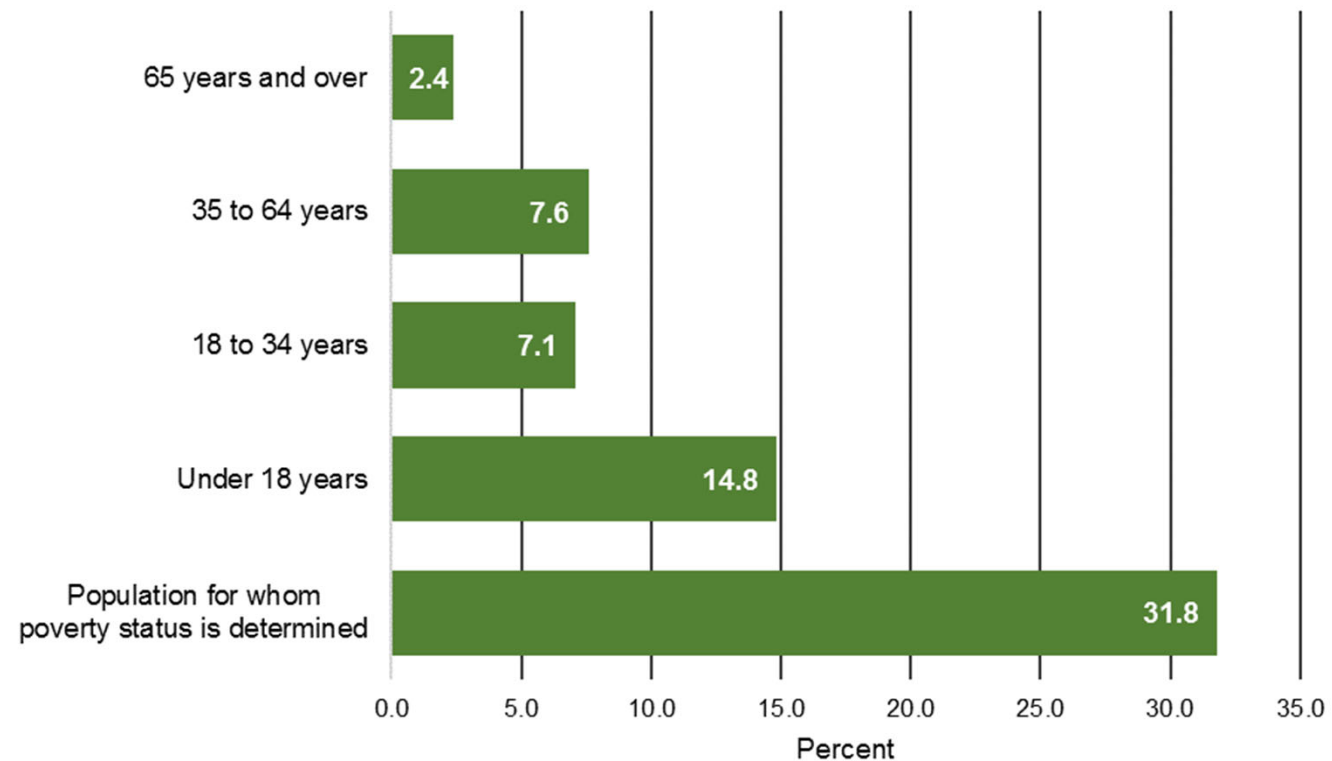

County Population = 828,672



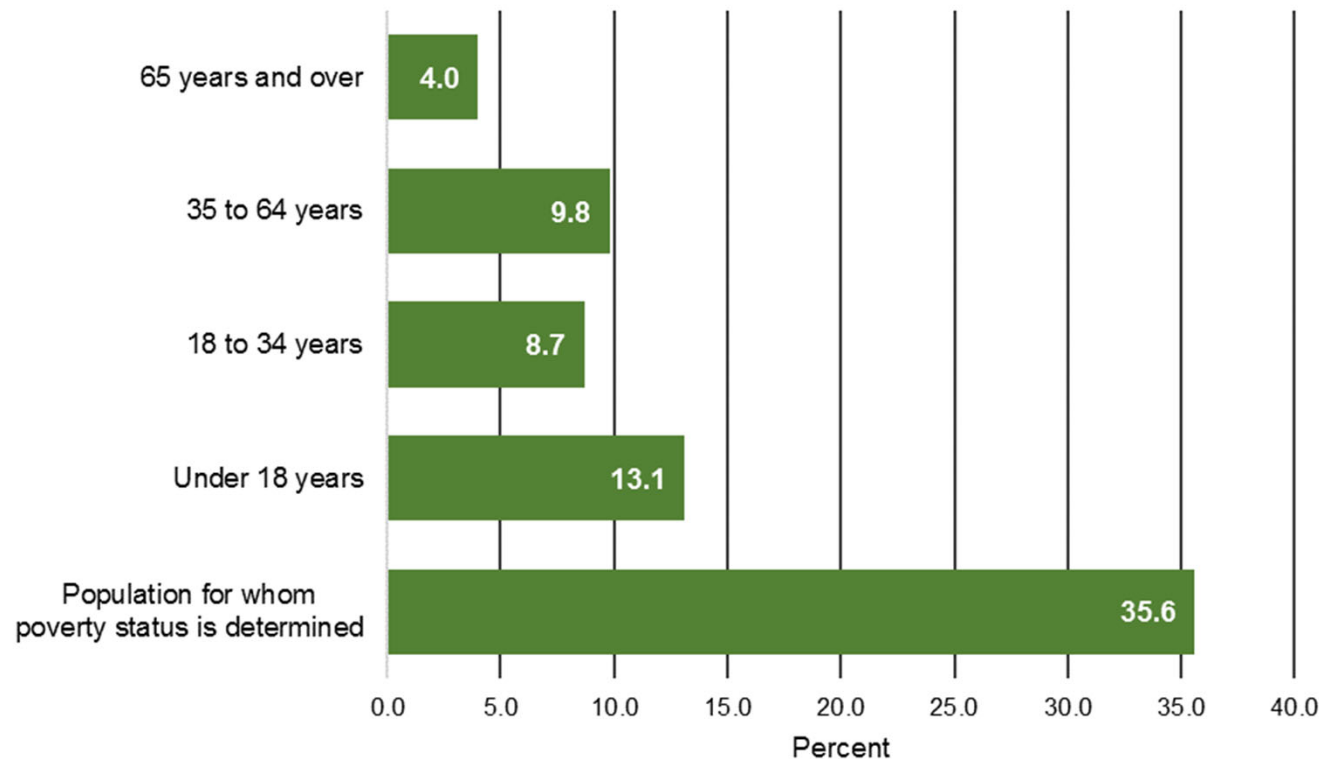

County Population = 20,090

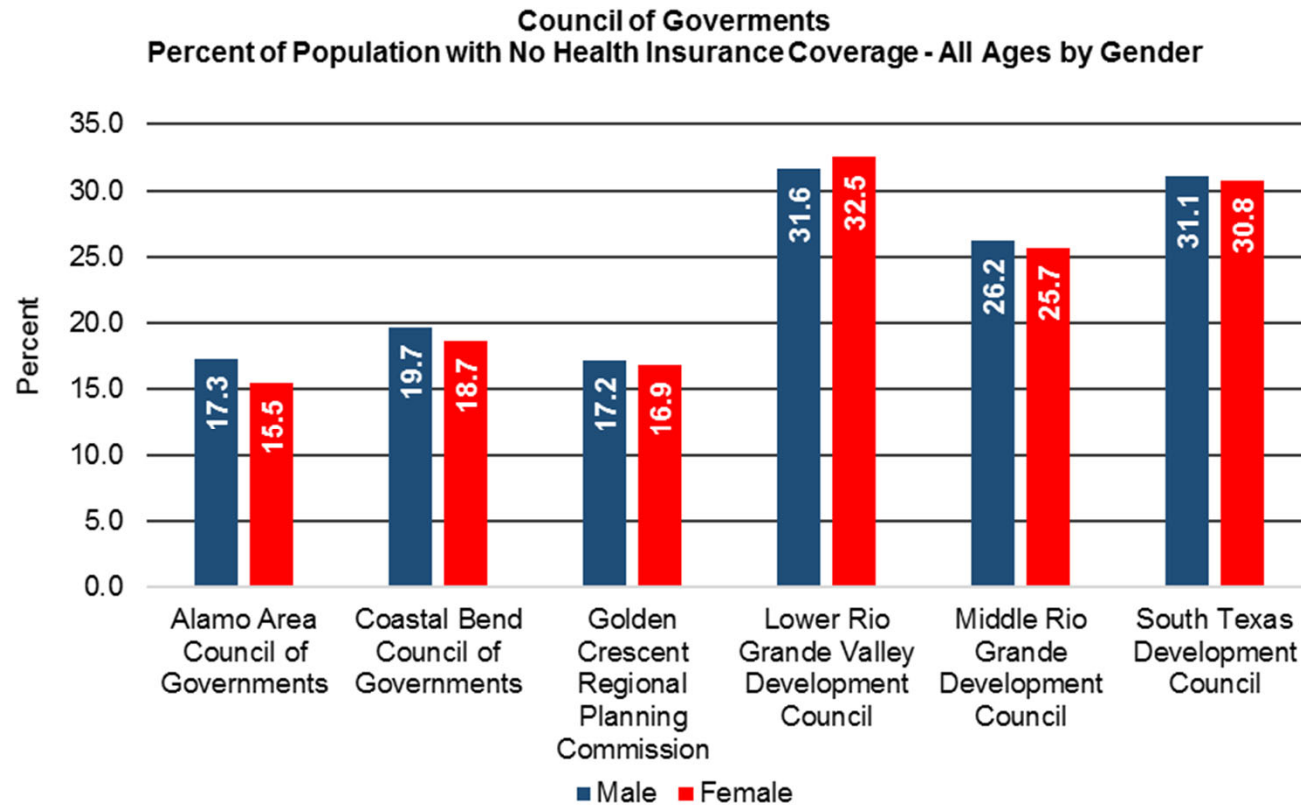

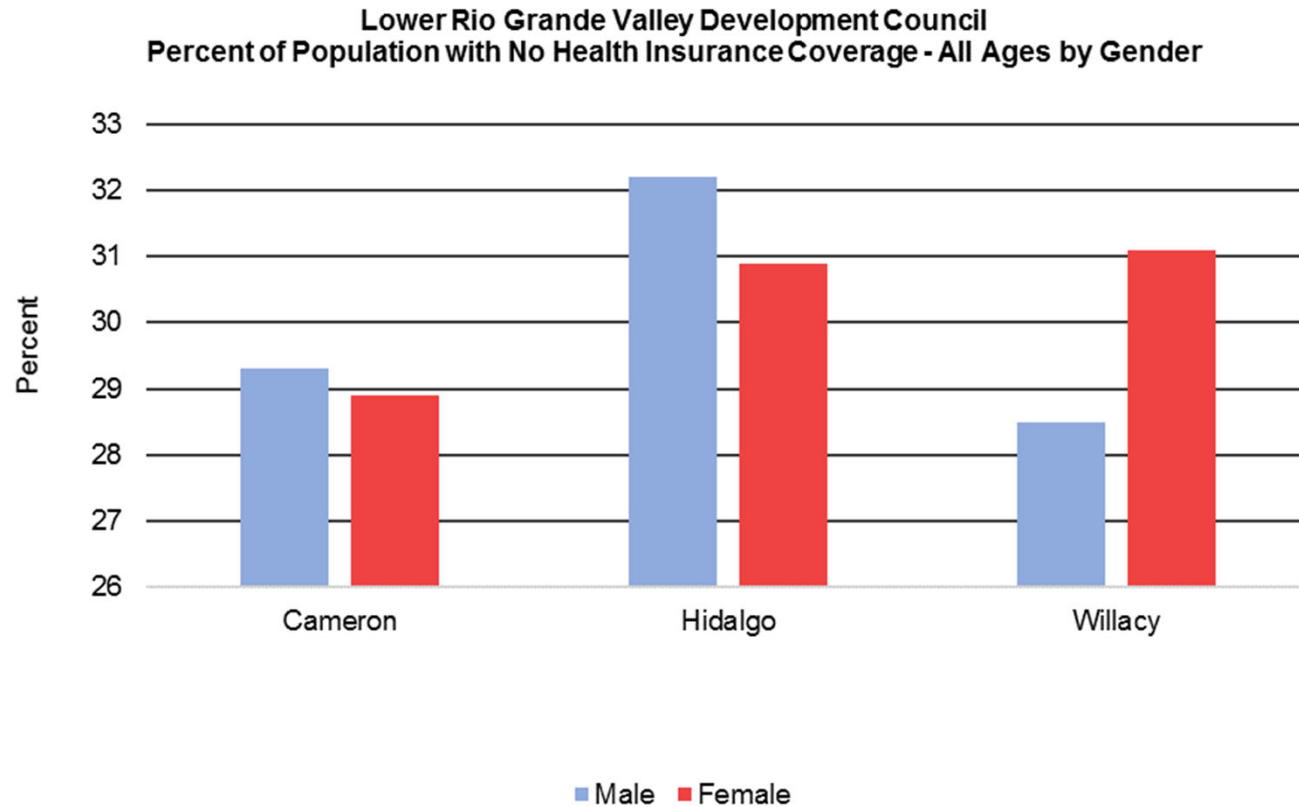

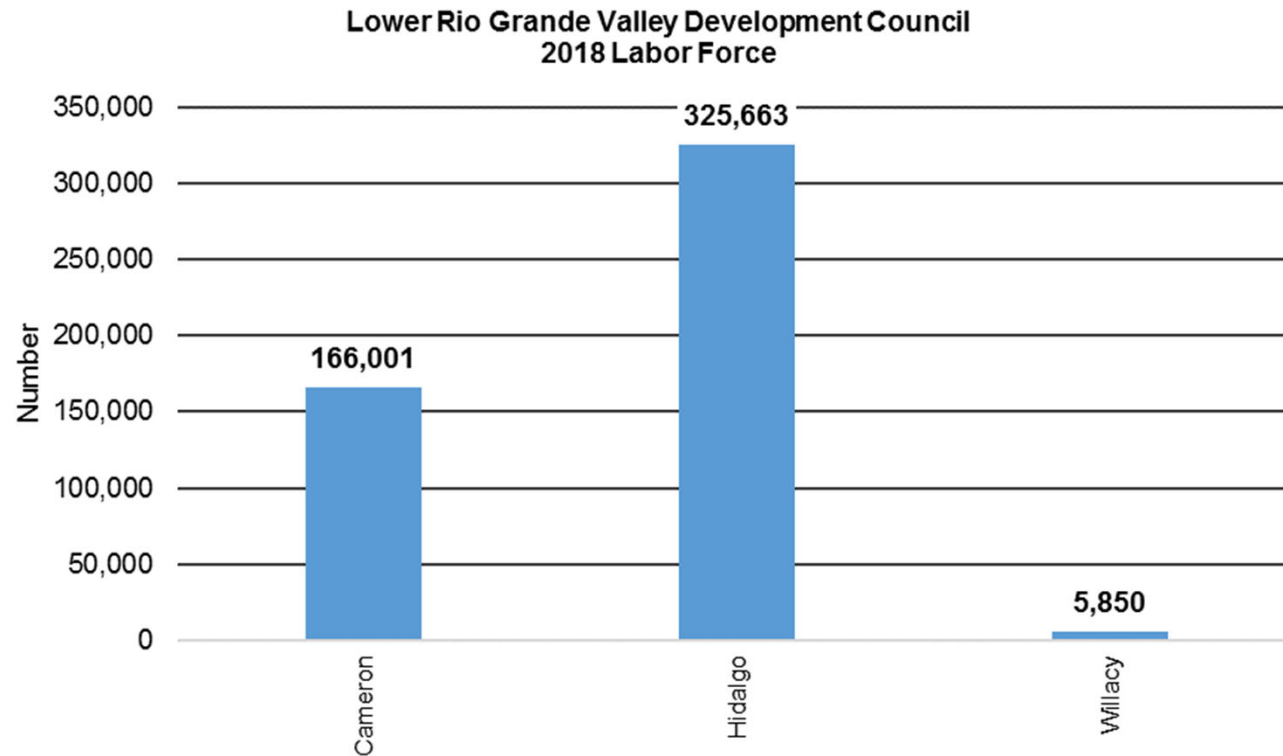
