






#### Council of Governments Population Estimates - South Texas Region



### Future of the Region South Texas




Middle Rio Grande Development Council Population Estimate 2018 by Gender COG Population = 175,180


#### Middle Rio Grande Development Council Counties Population Estimate 2018 by Gender












Middle Rio Grande Development Council Counties Hispanic and Non hispanic Population Estimate 2017






Percent Estimate of Population Below Poverty Level














Council of Goverments Percent of Population with No Health Insurance Coverage - All Ages by Gender








Middle Rio Grande Development Council Percent Estimate of Educational Attainment by Individuals Age 25 and Over Attaining Population = 102.346






Middle Rio Grande Area - La Salle Co. Percent Estimate of Educational Attainment by Individuals Age 25 and Over














#### Council of Governments 2018 Unemployment


