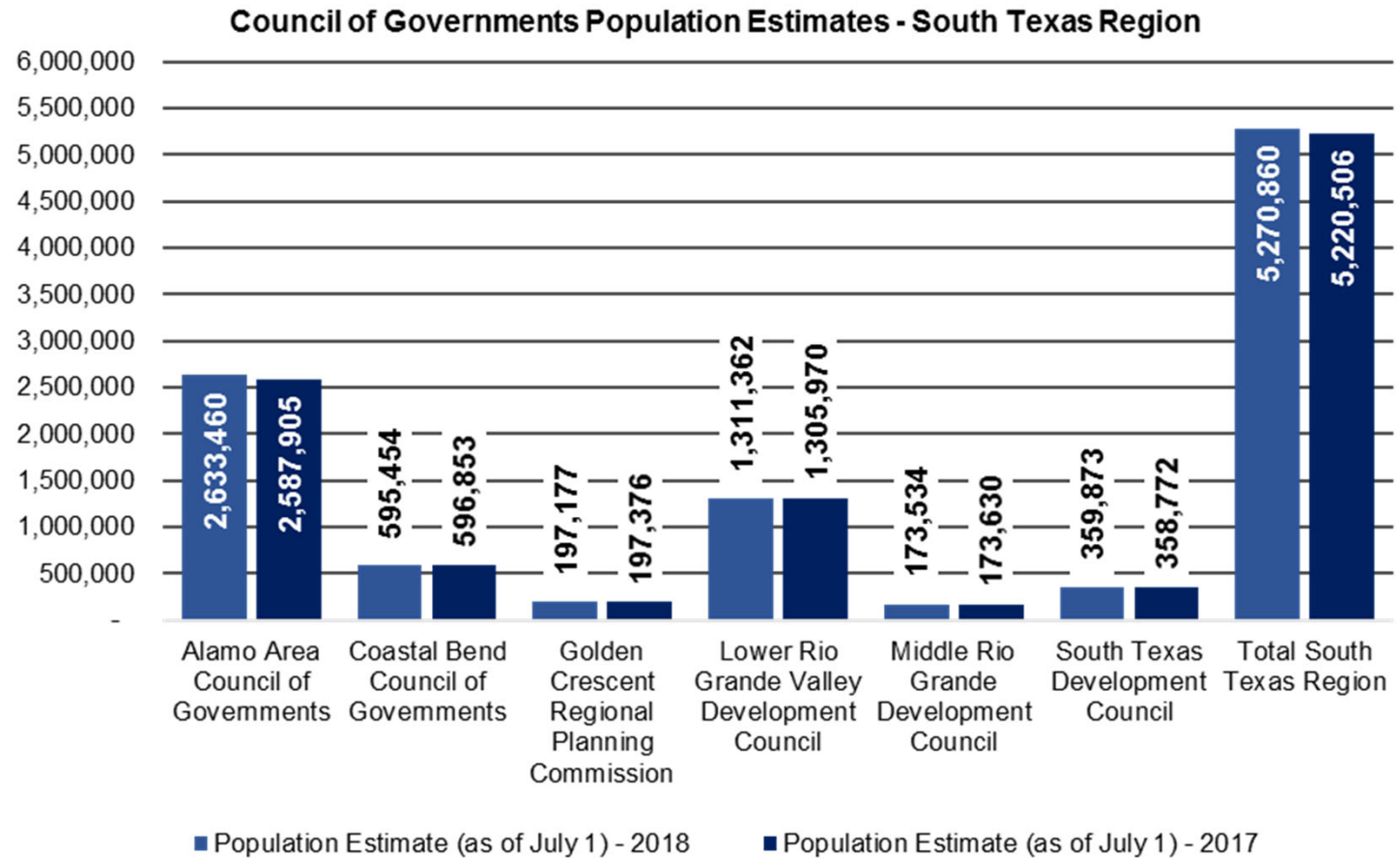

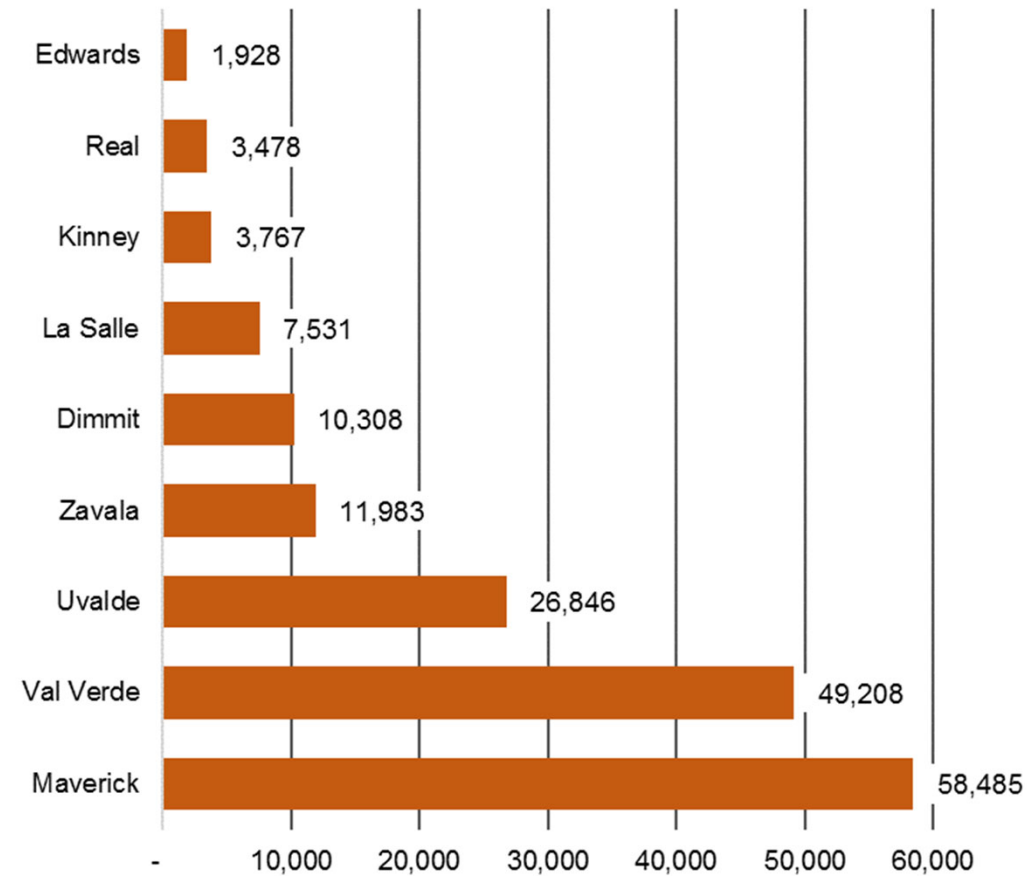

COG Population = 173,630



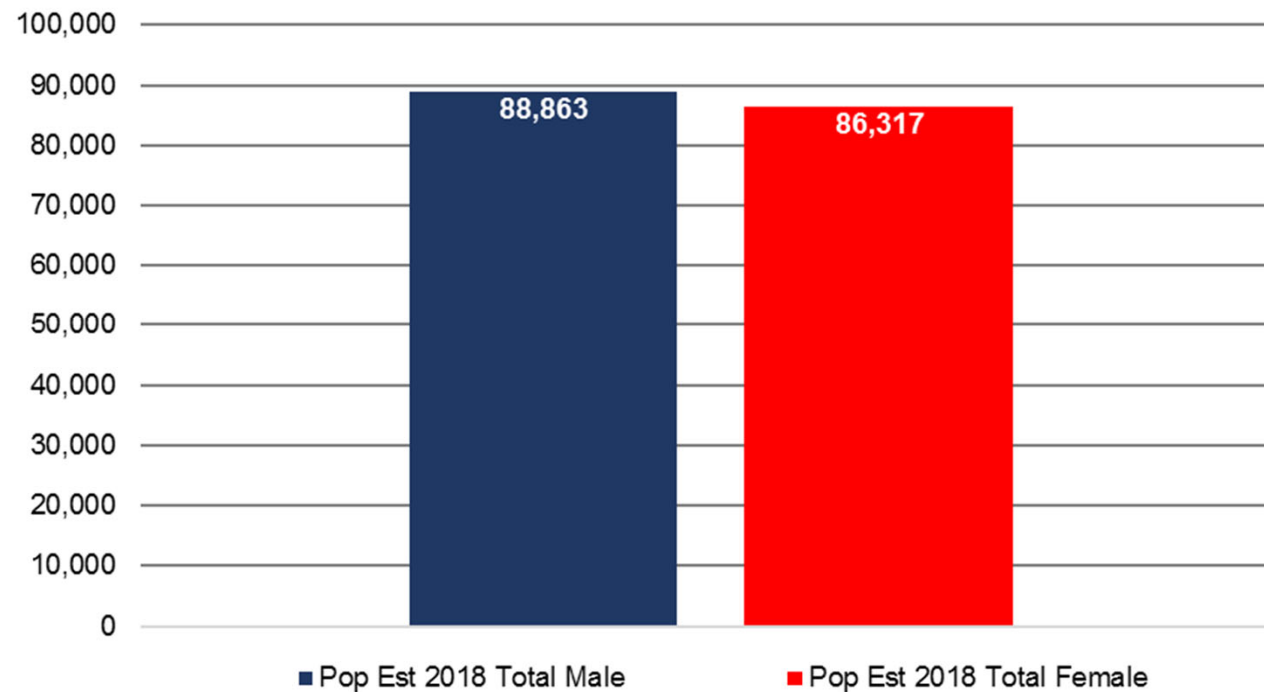

COG Population = 175,180



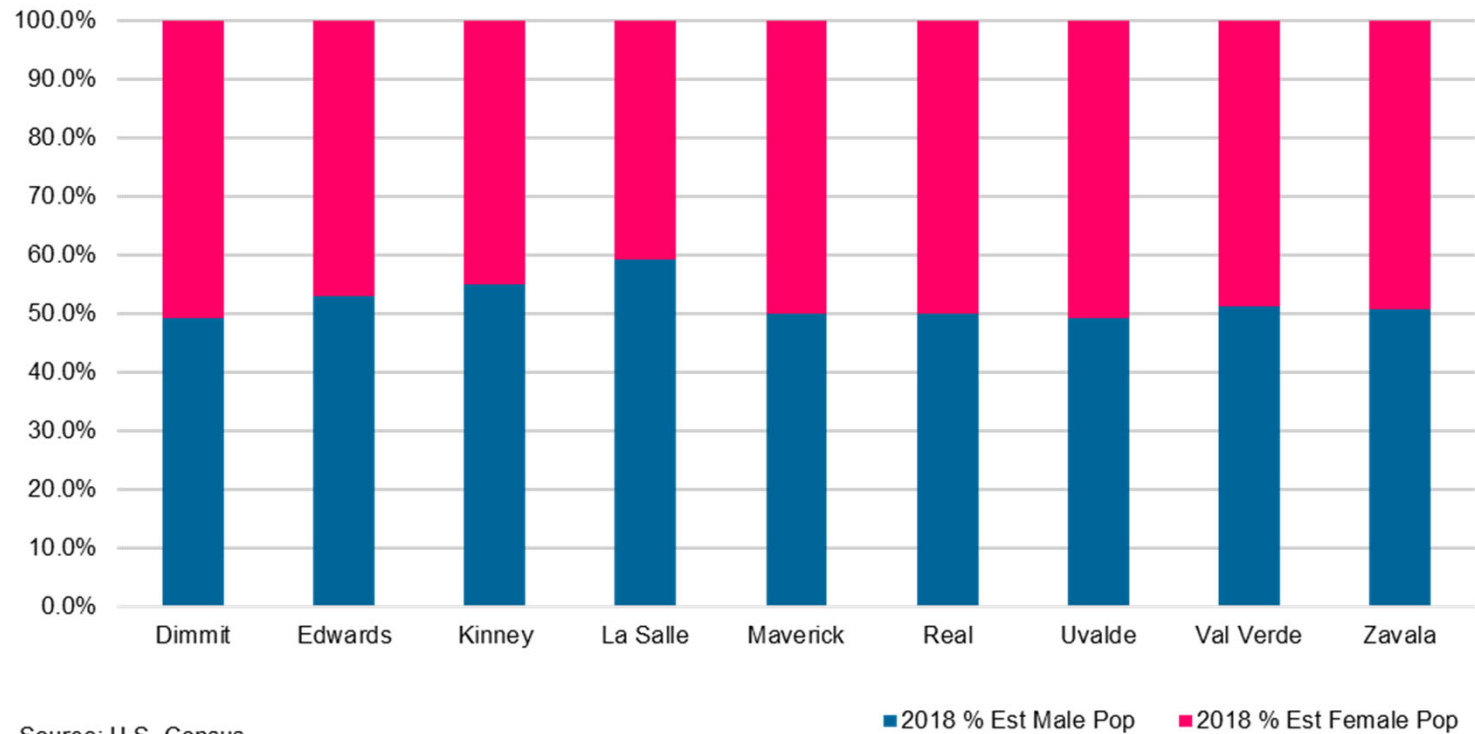

Population Estimate 2018 by Gender

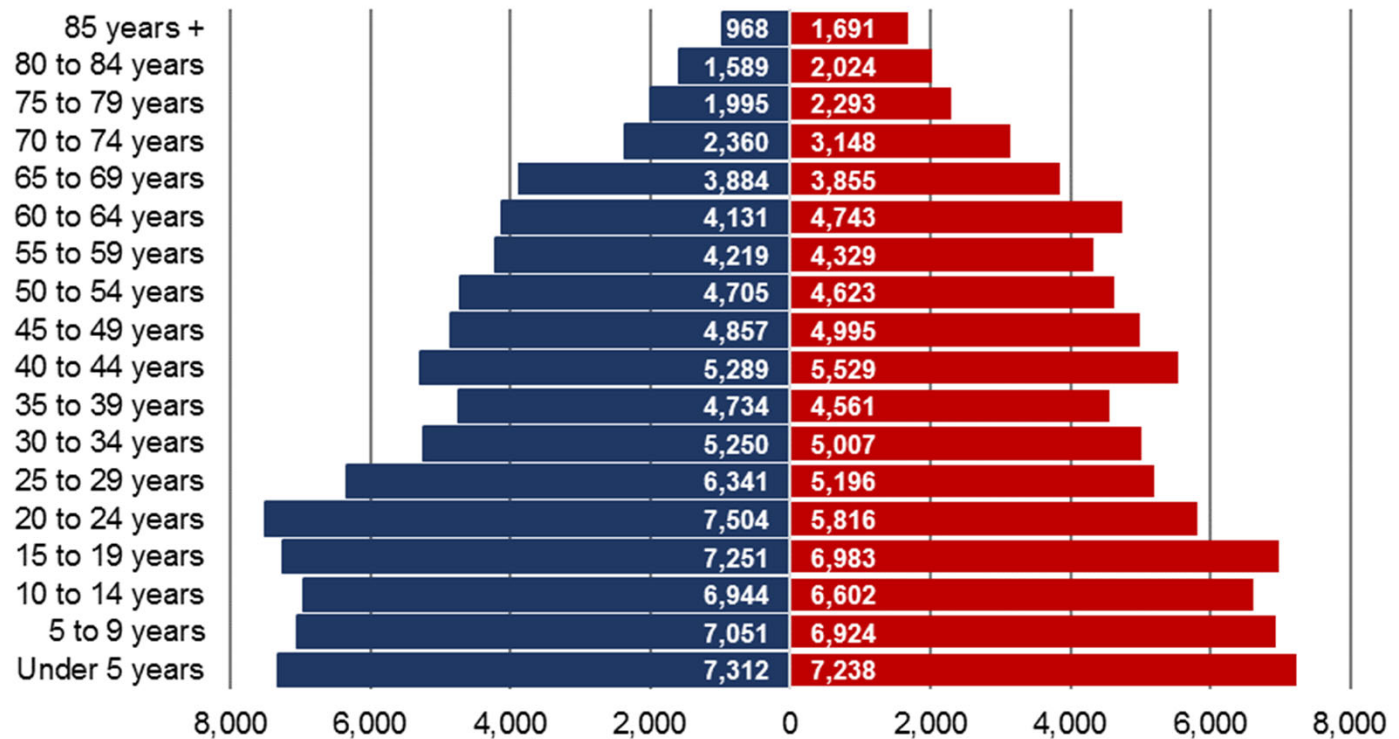

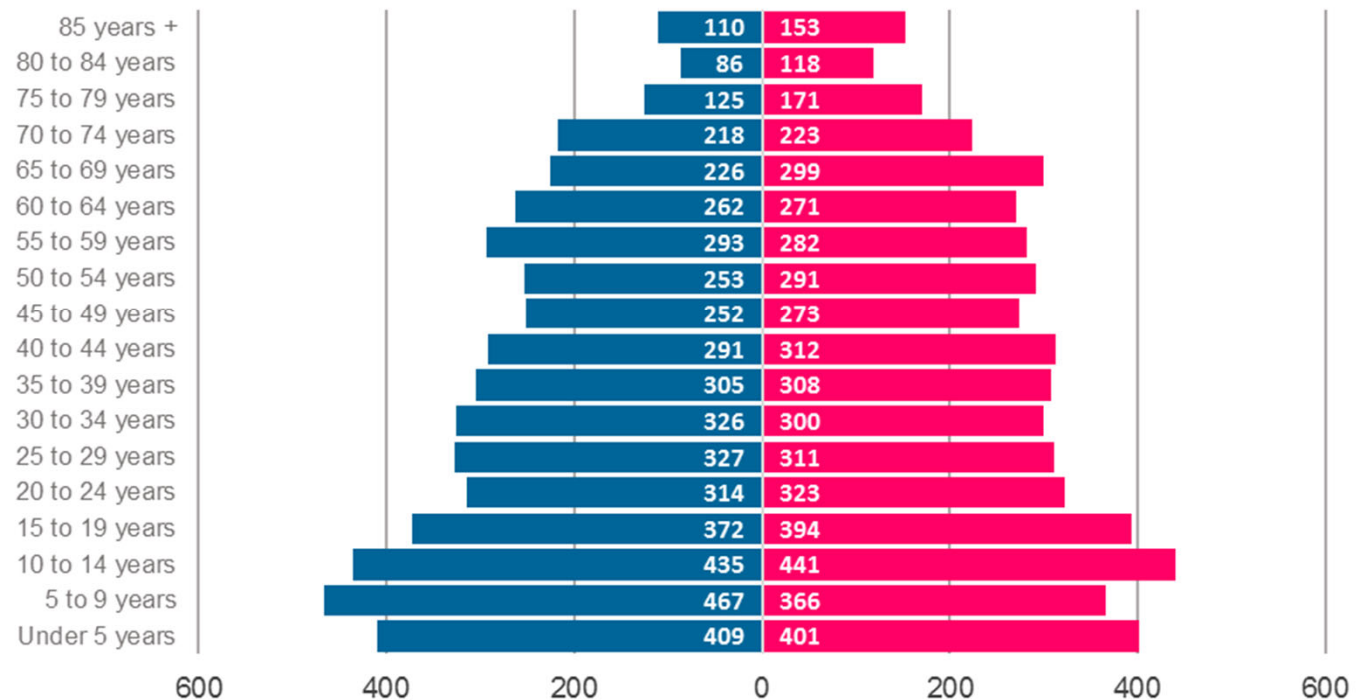

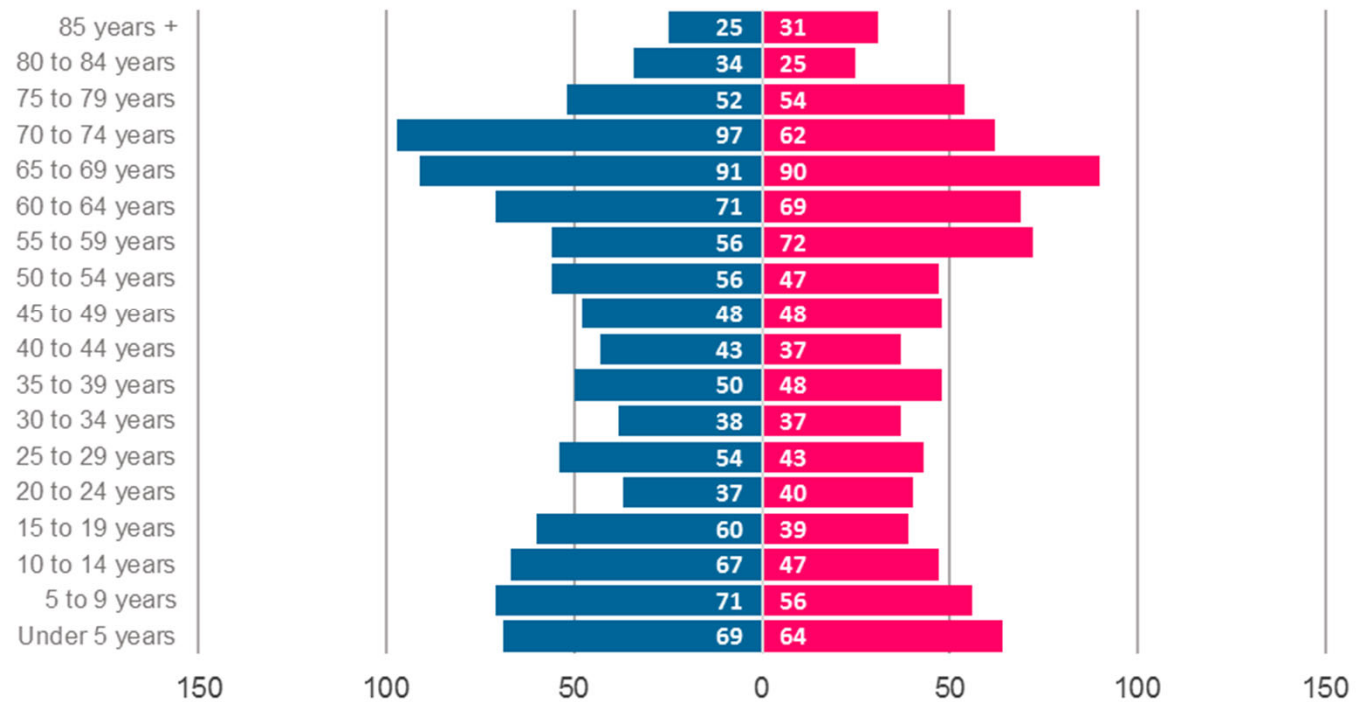

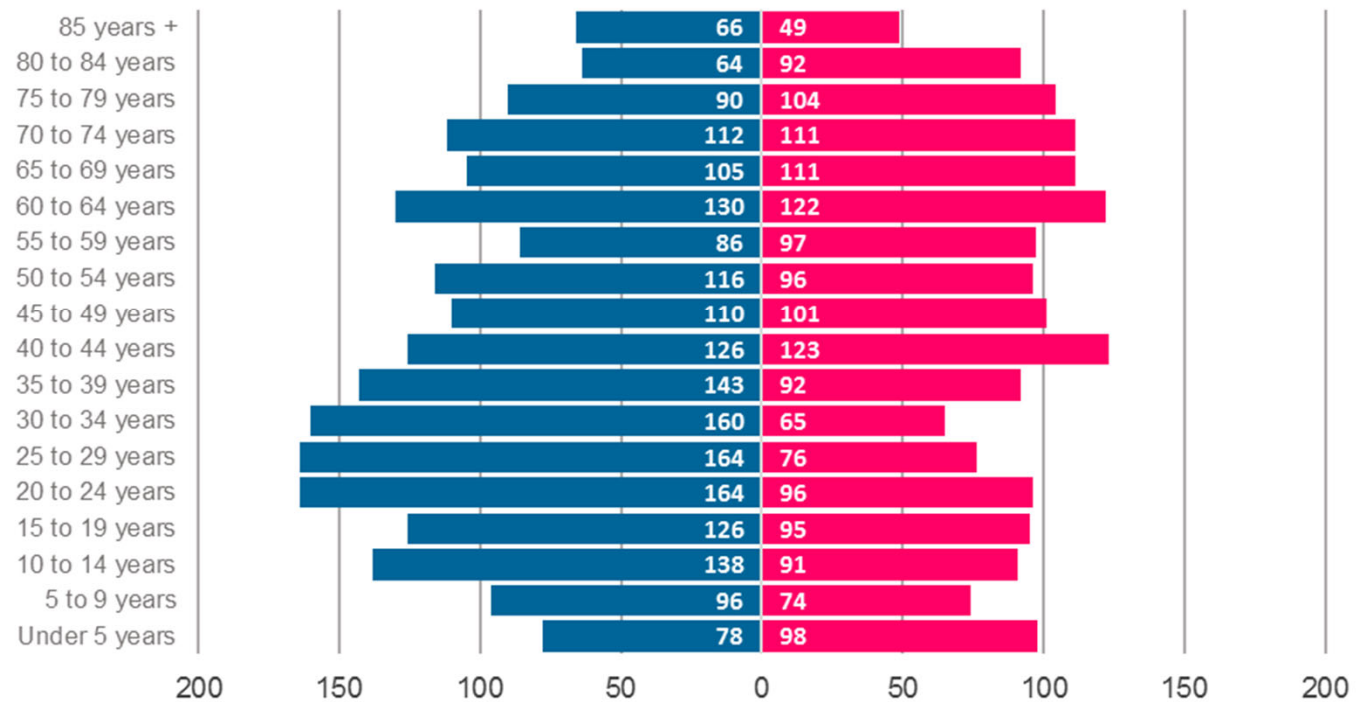

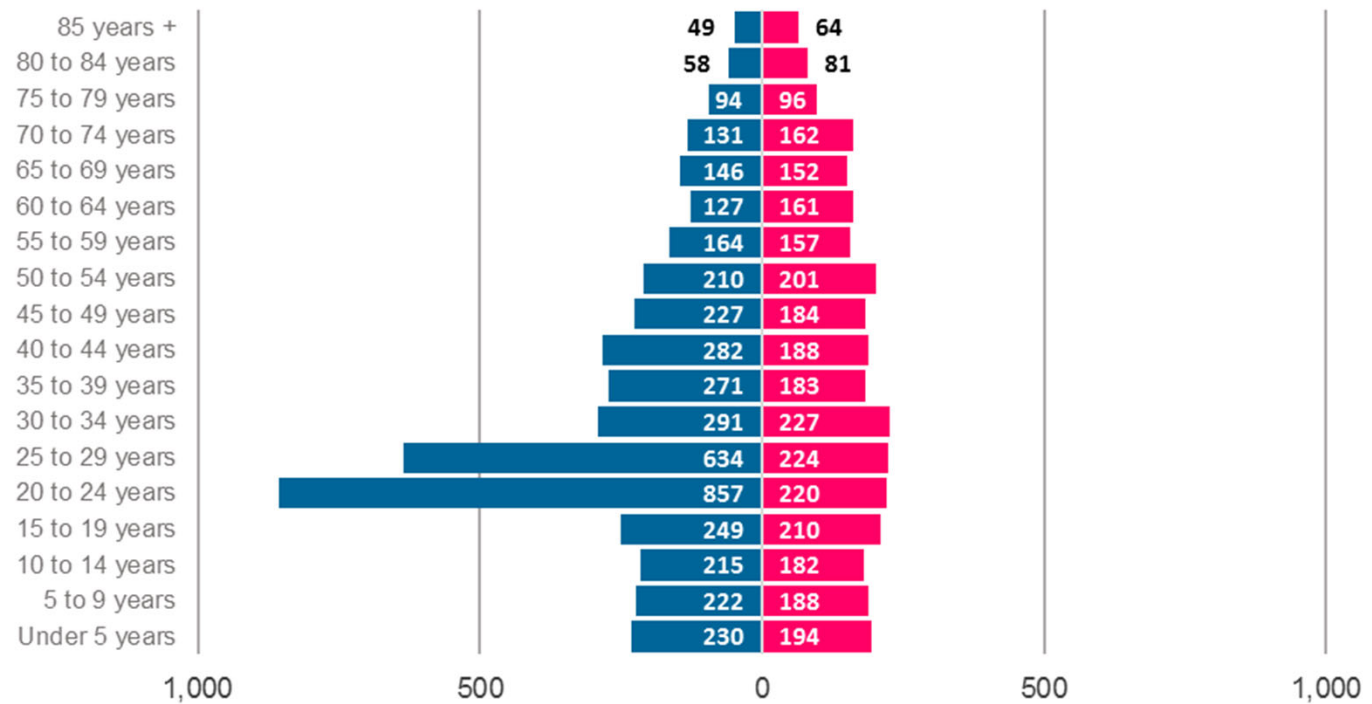

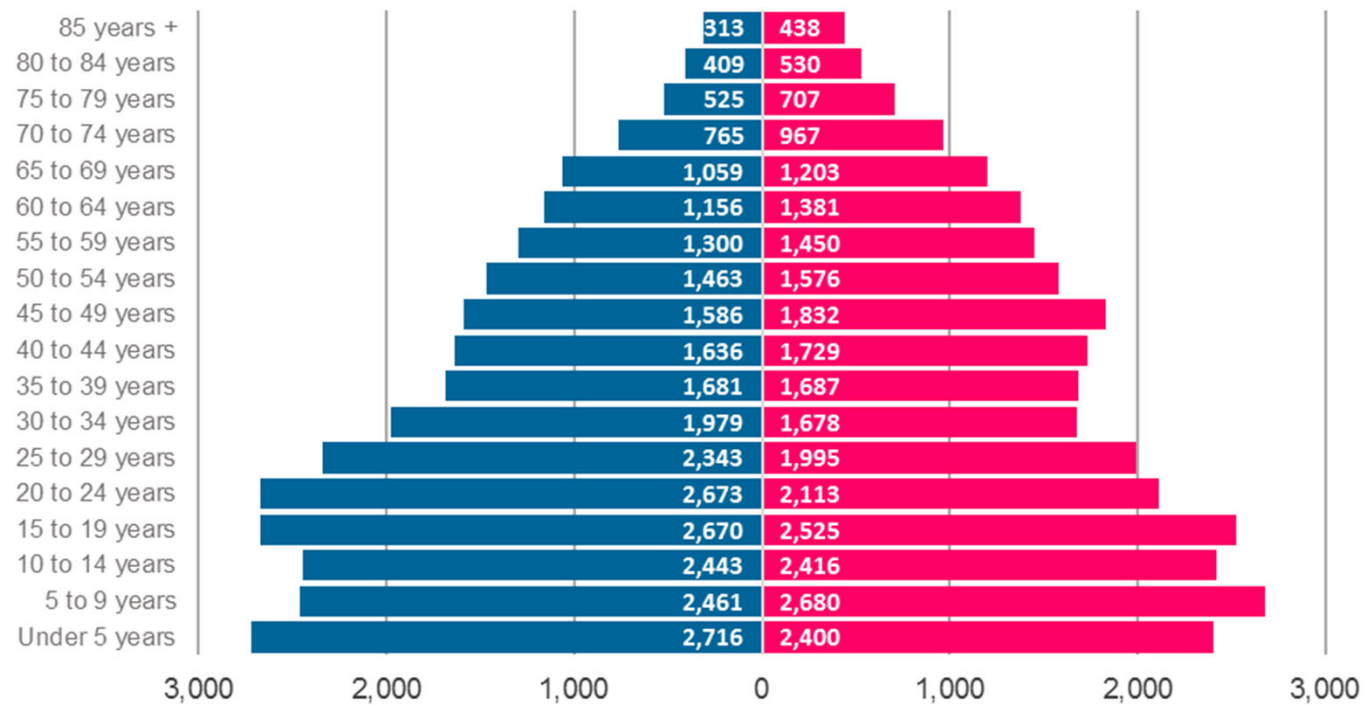

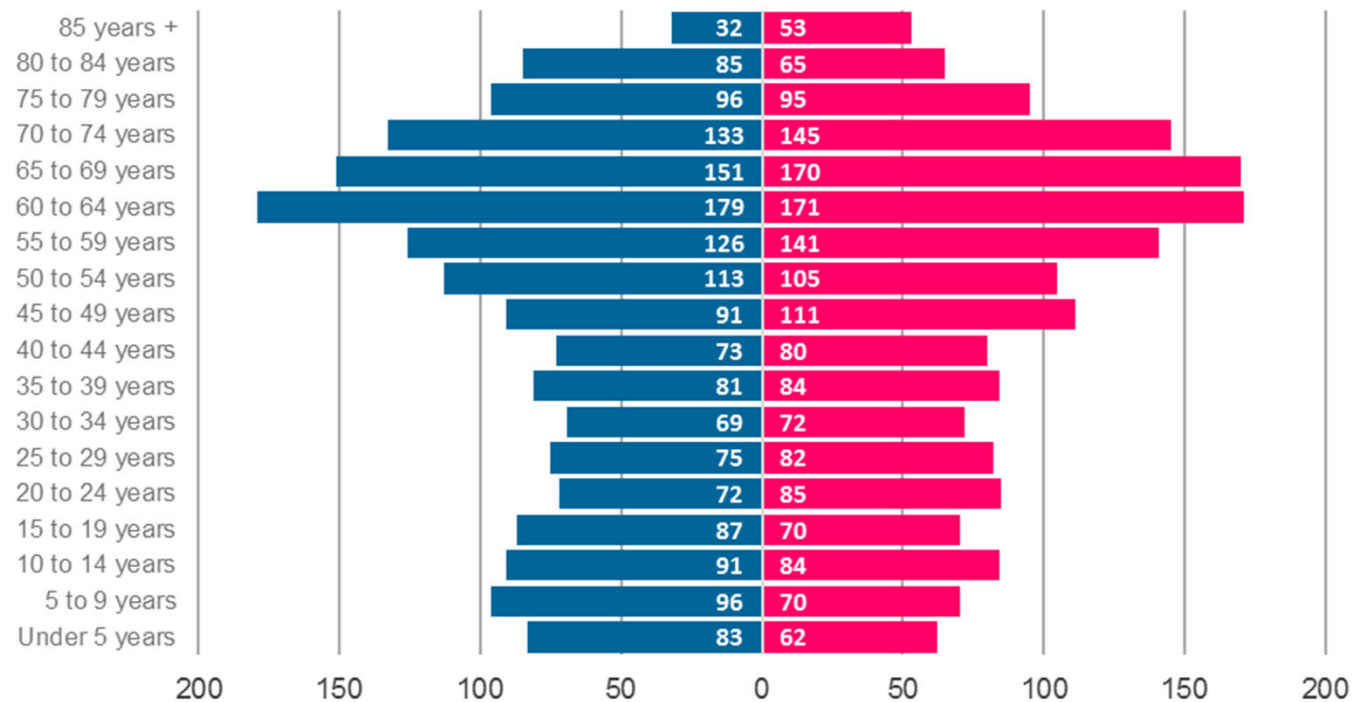

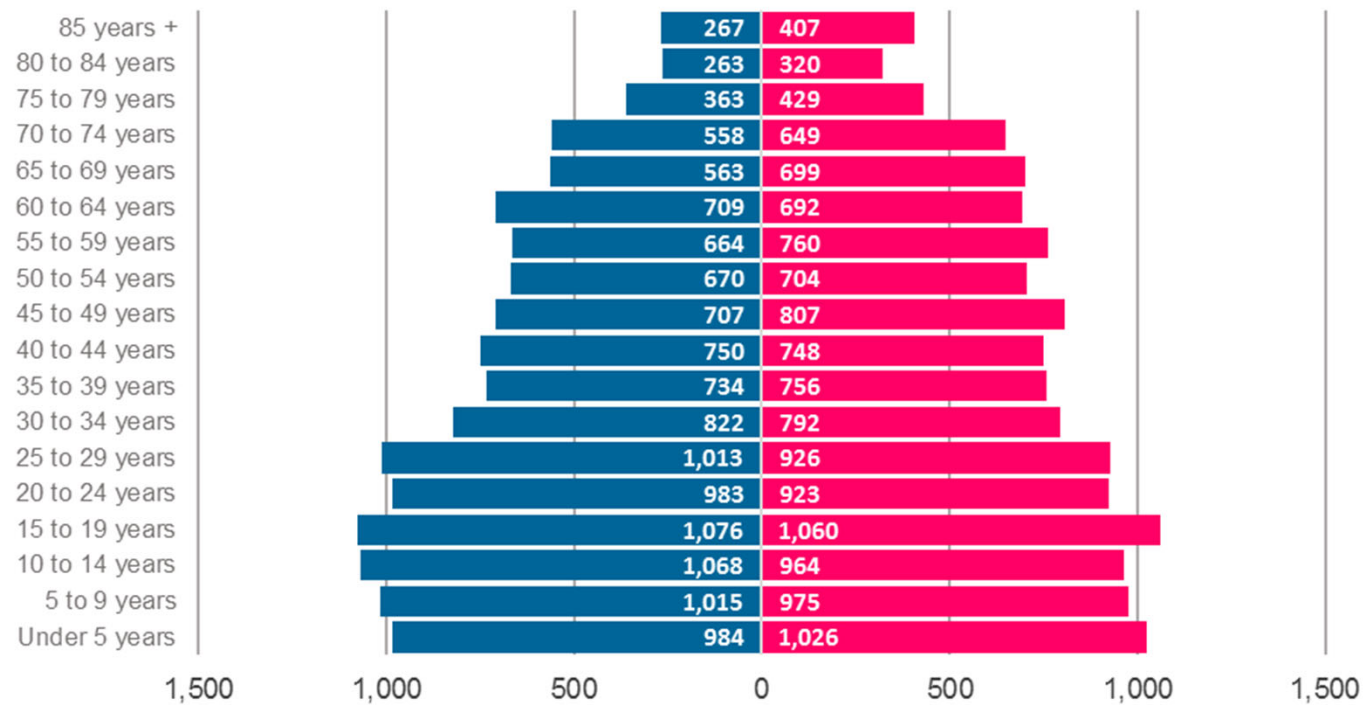

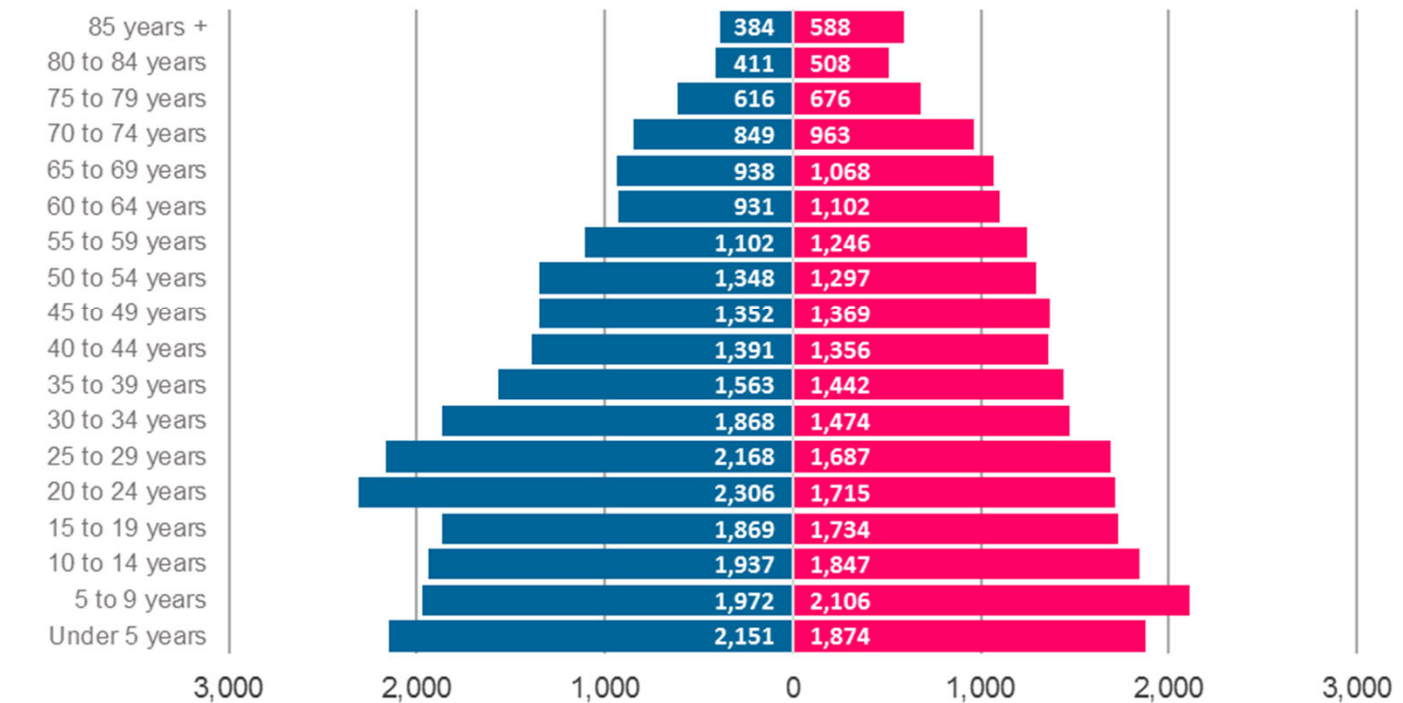

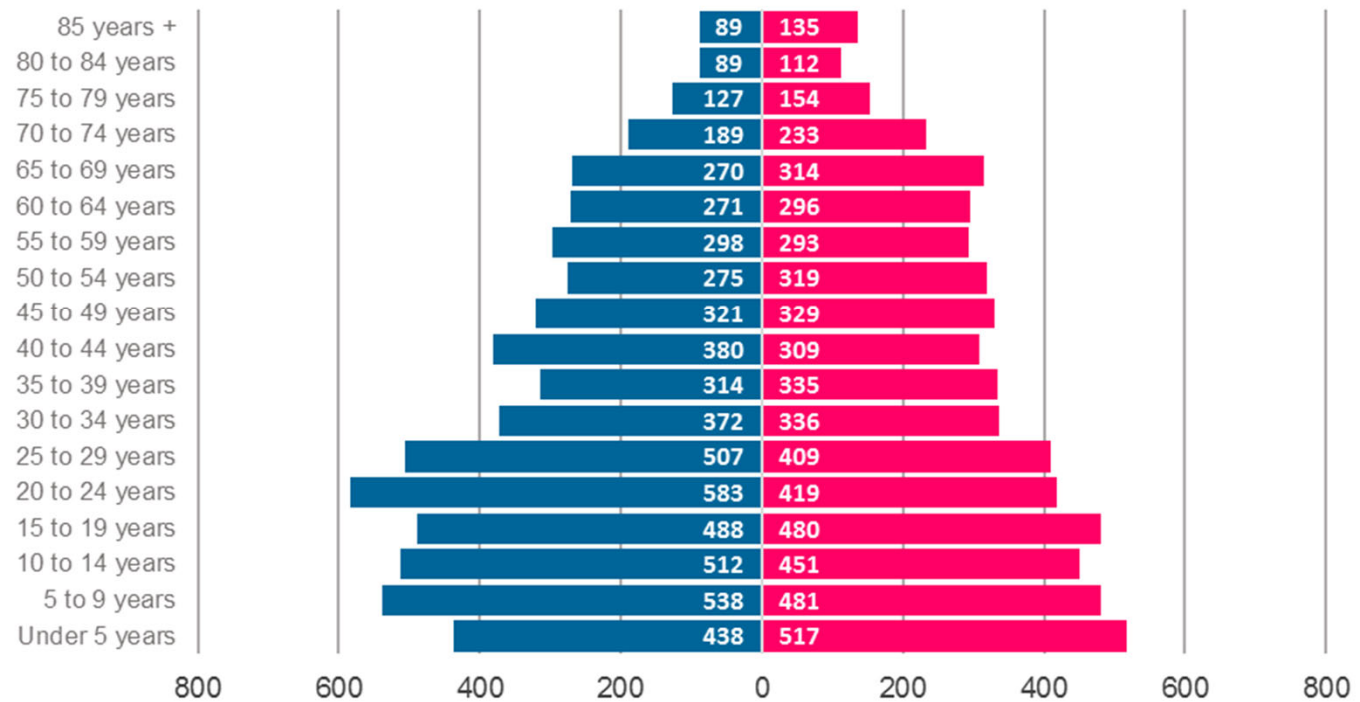

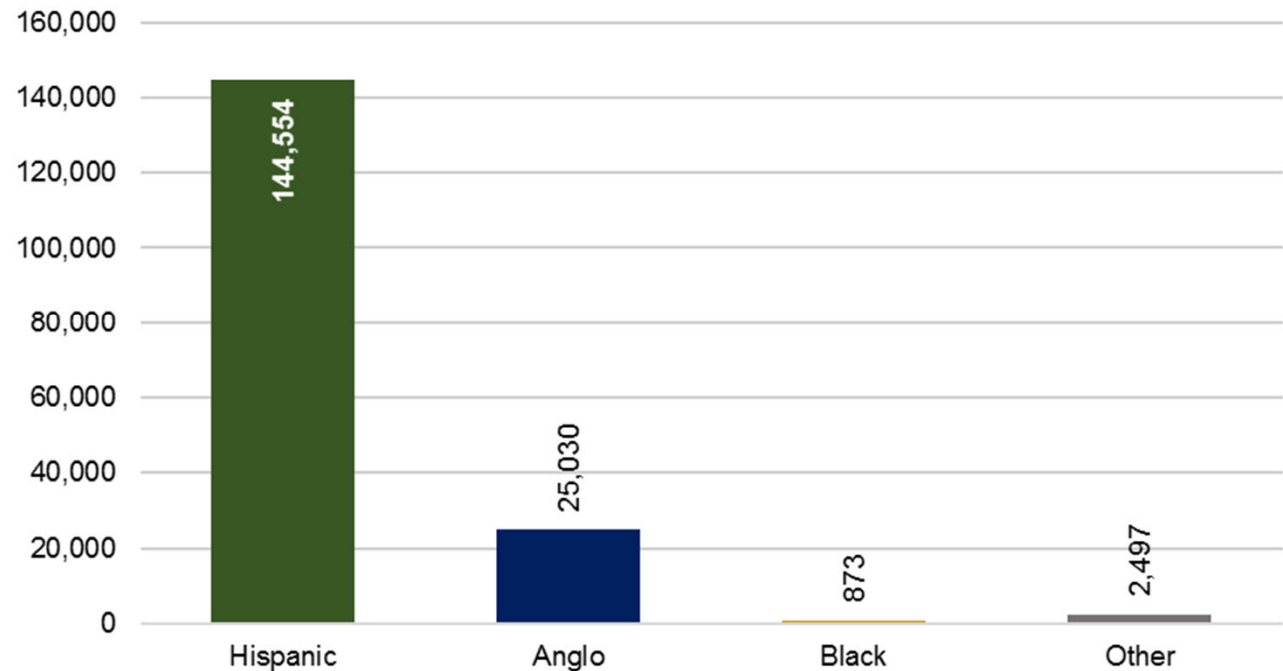

COG Population = 172,954



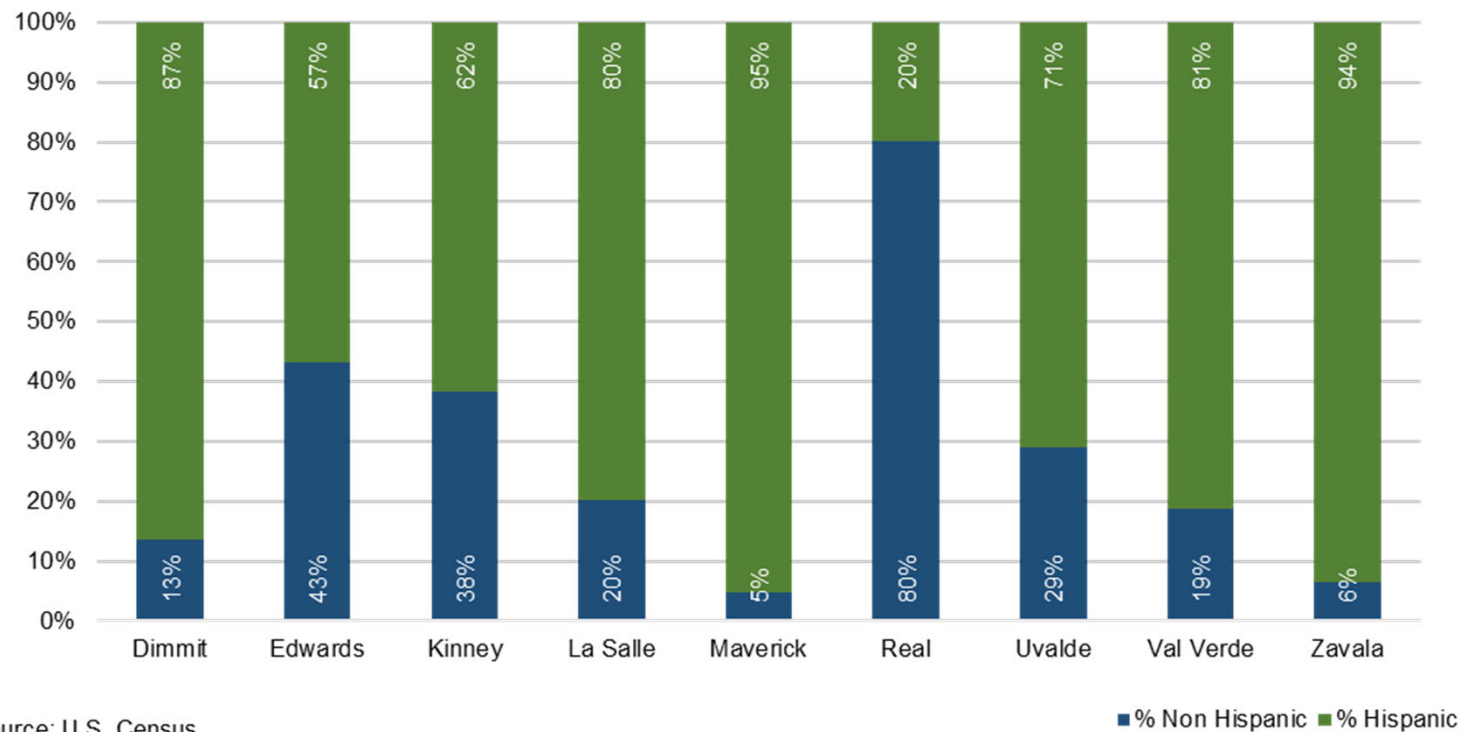

Hispanic and Non hispanic Population Estimate 2017

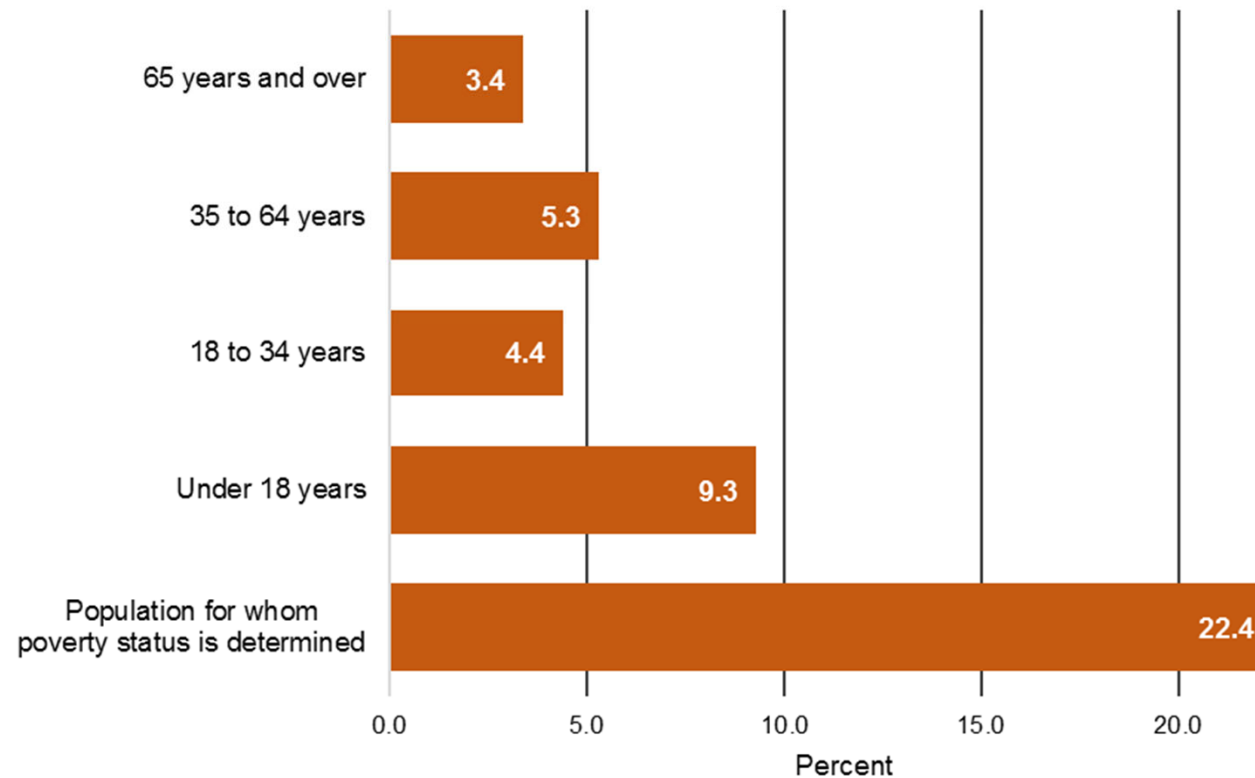

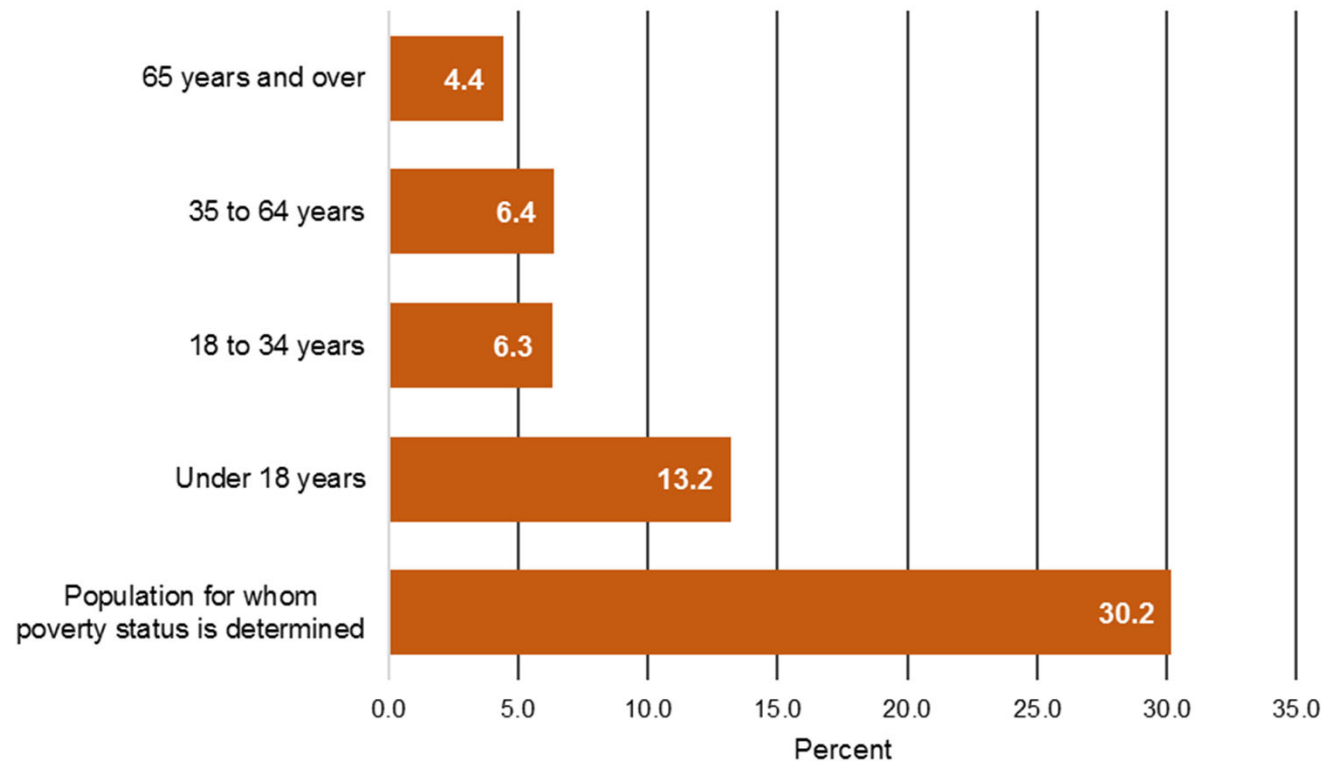

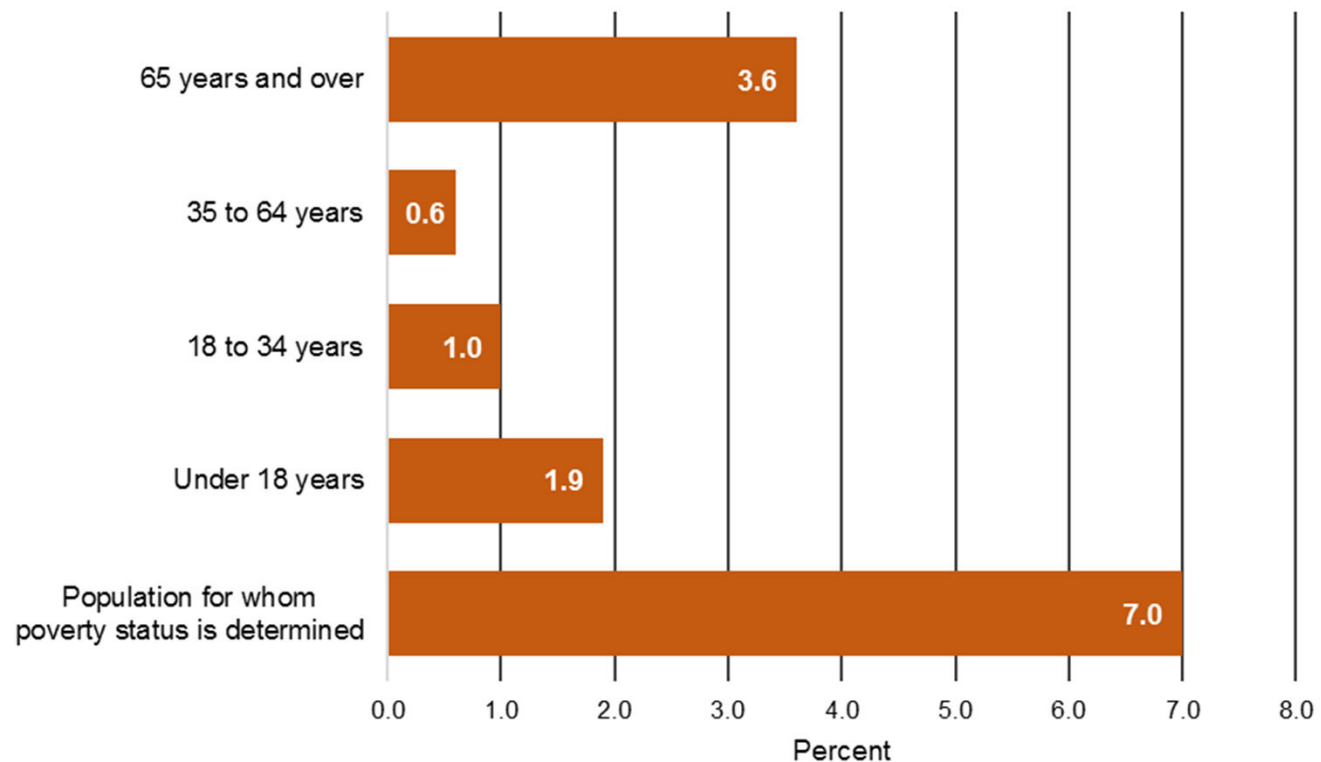

County Population = 2,100



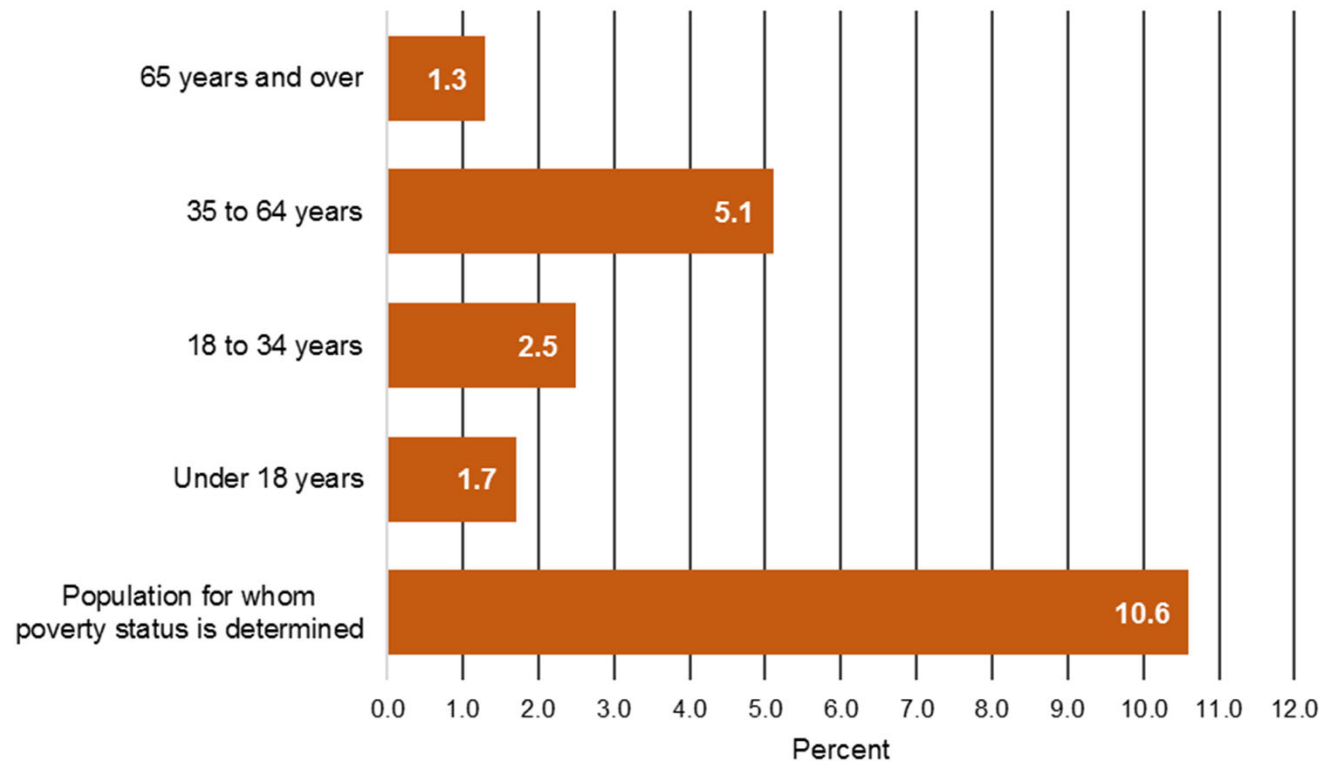

County Population = 3,327**



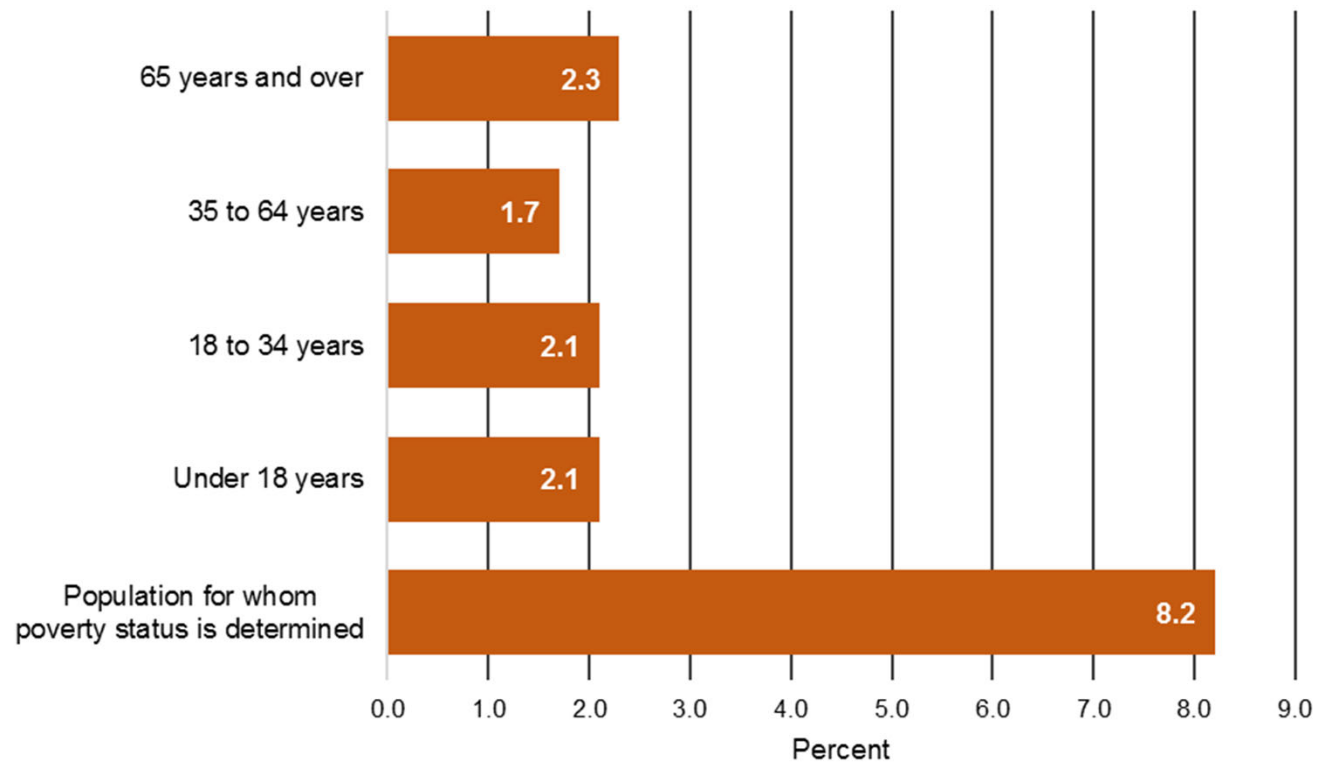

County Population = 6,511



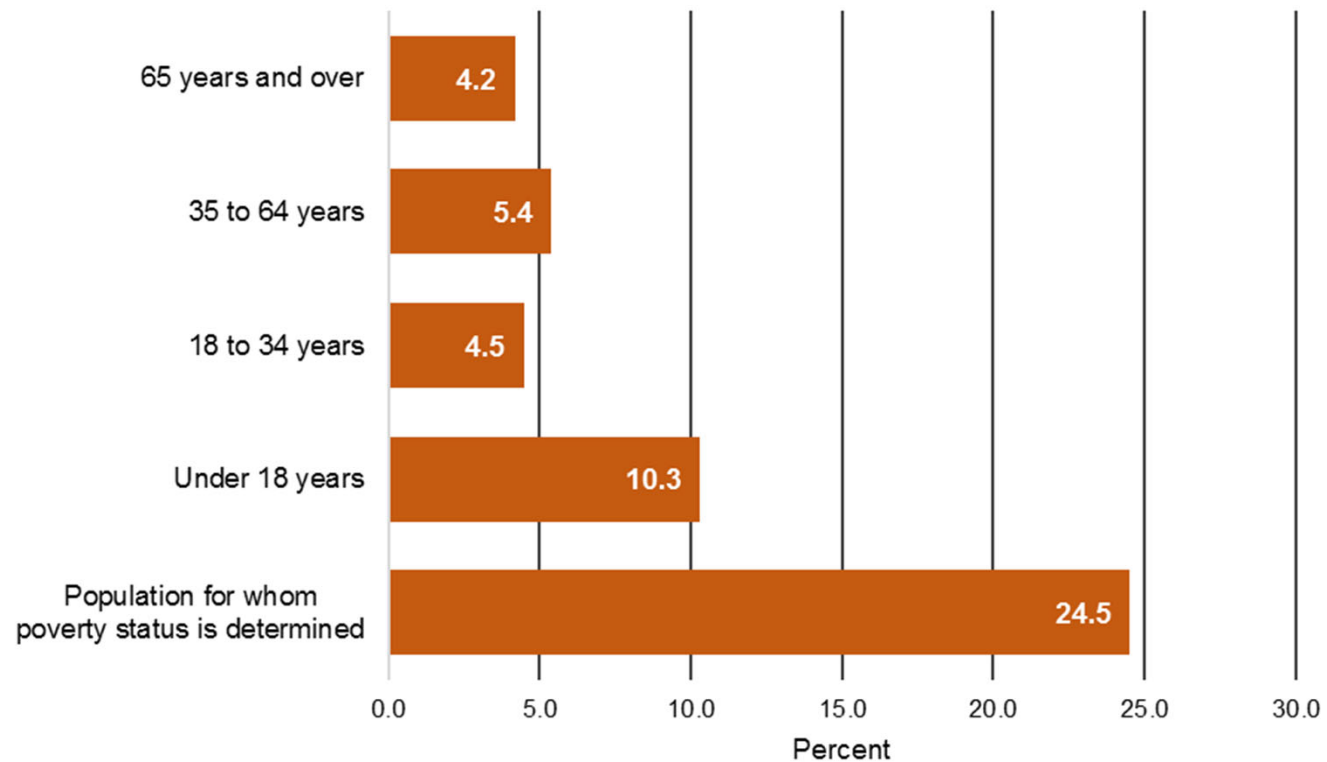

County Population = 56,994**



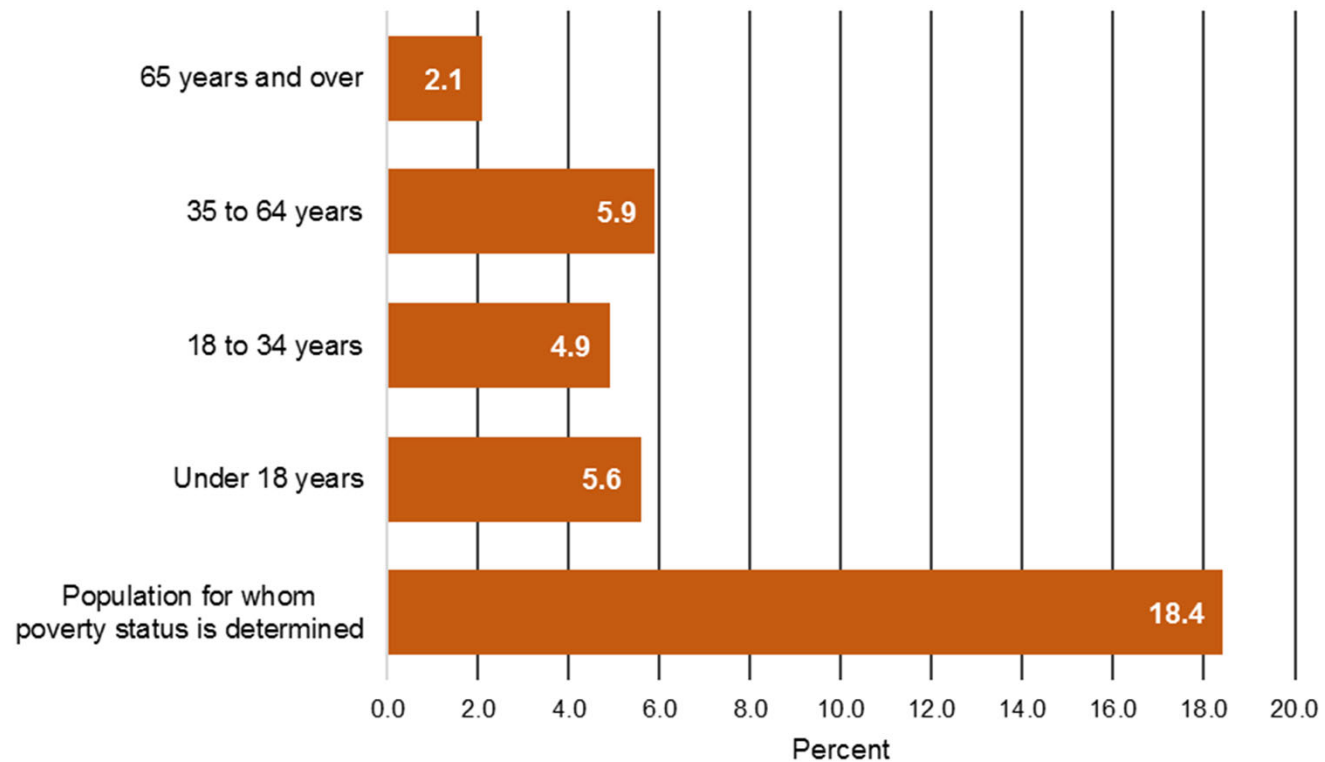

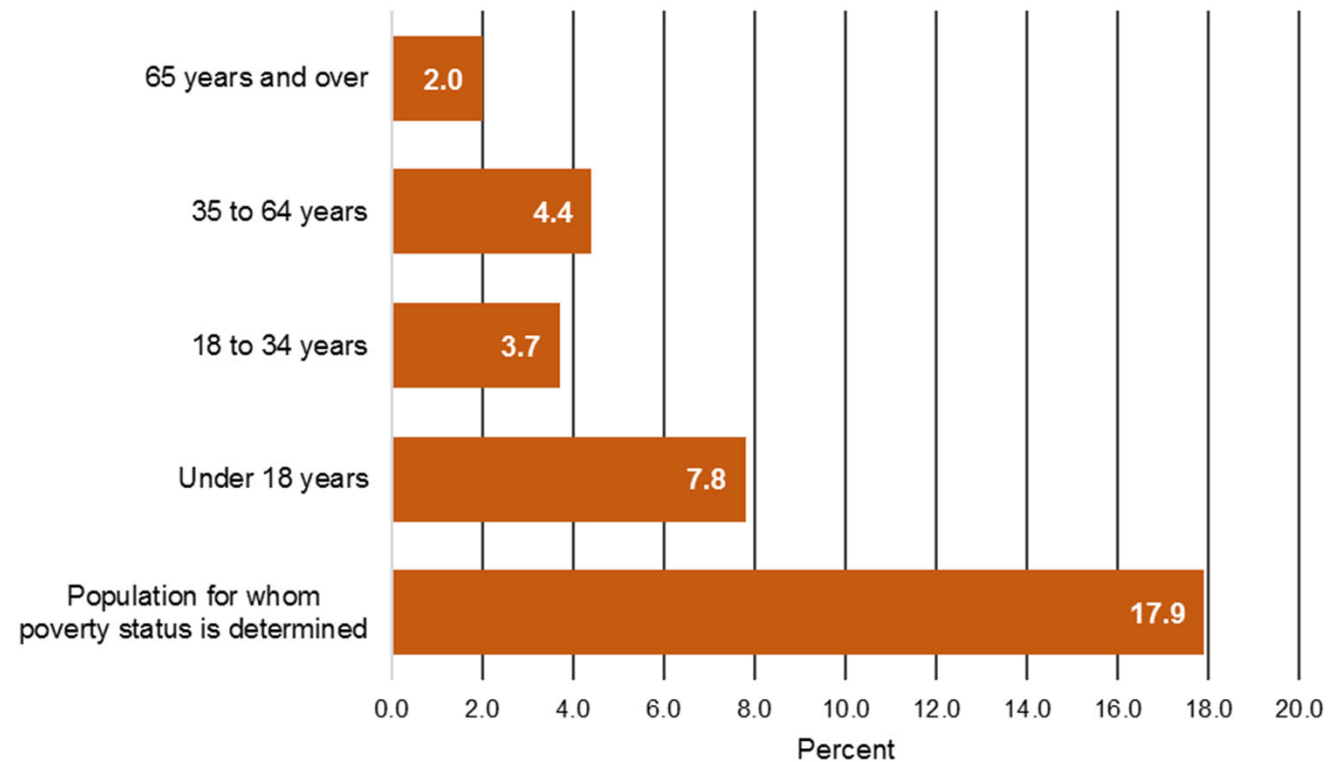

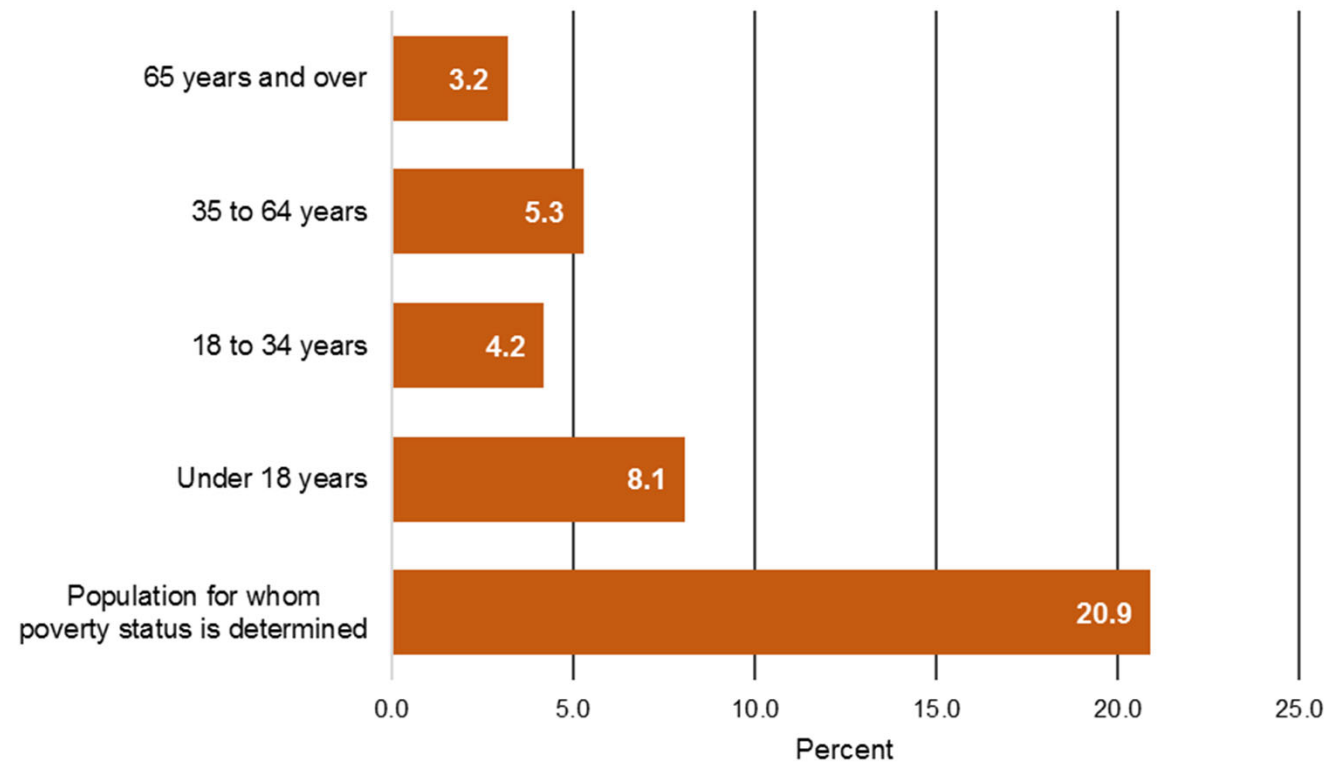

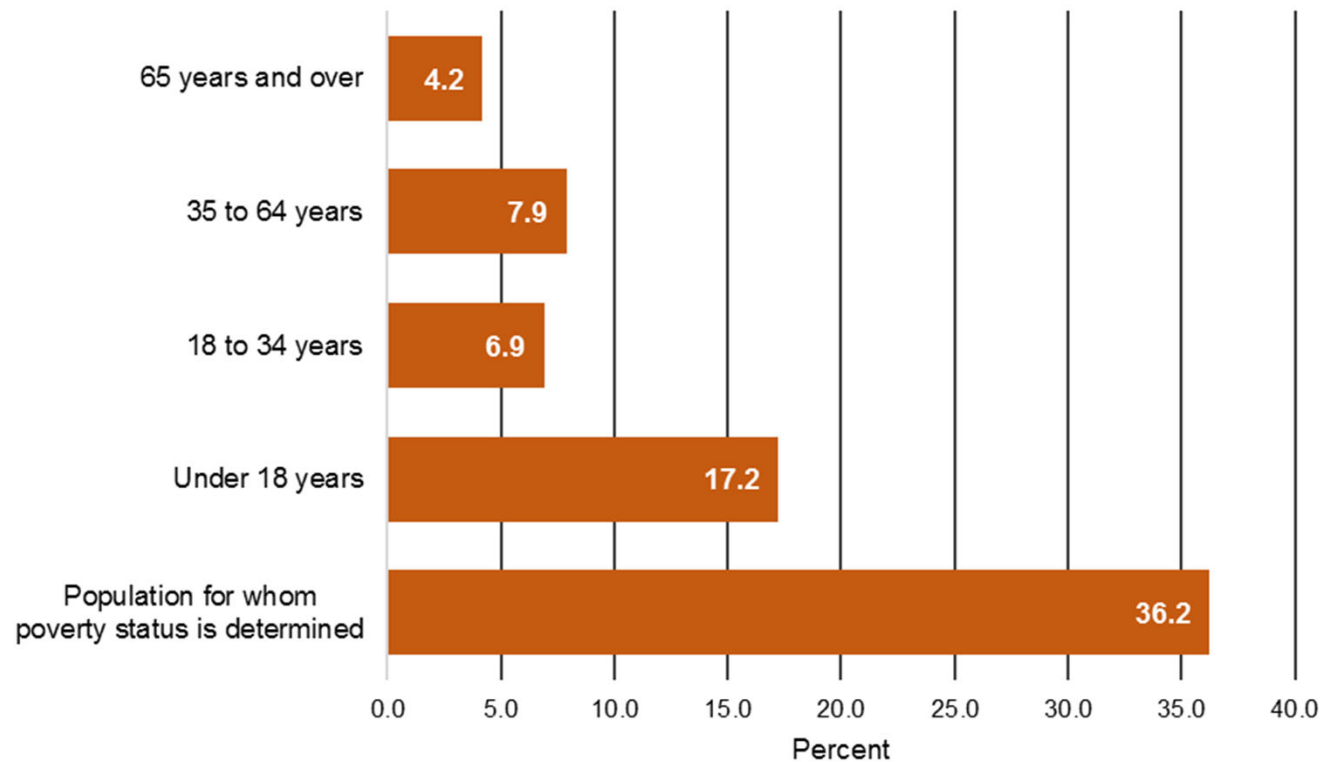

County Population = 11,926

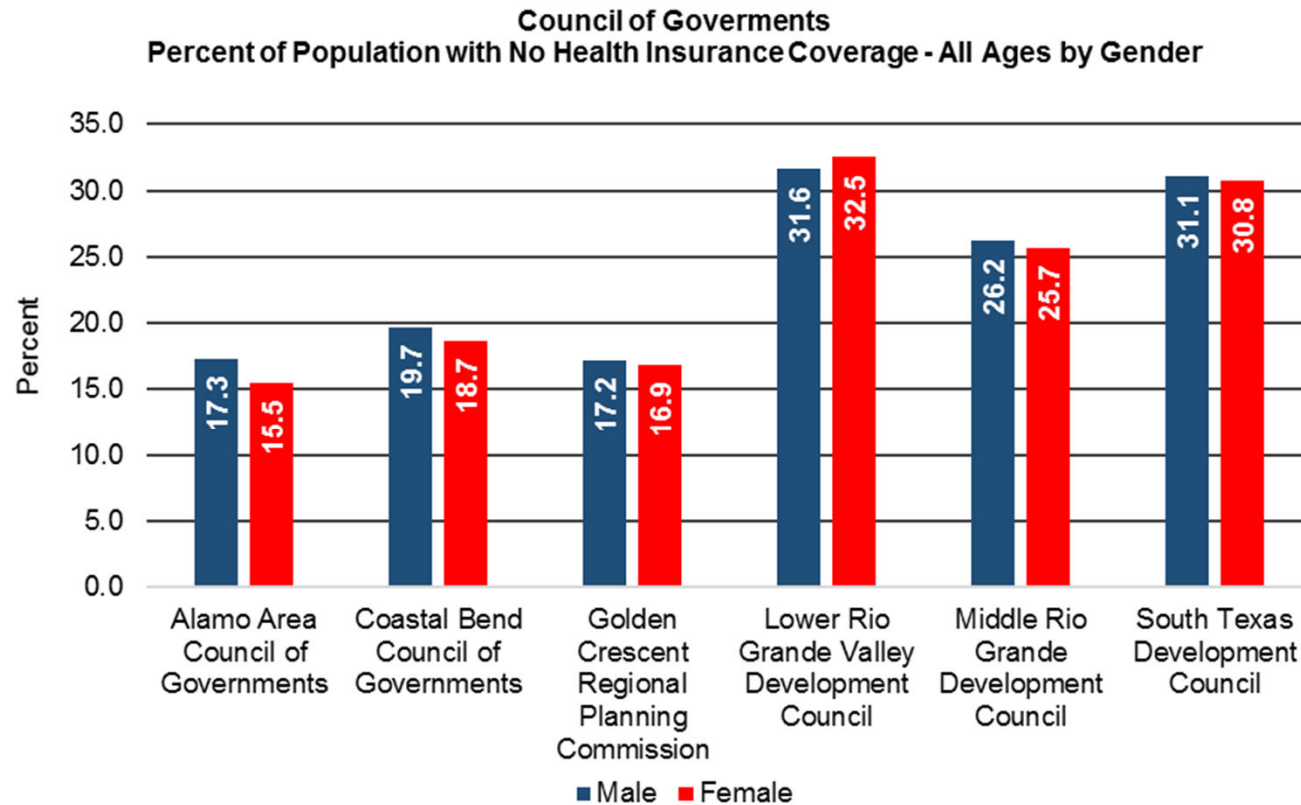

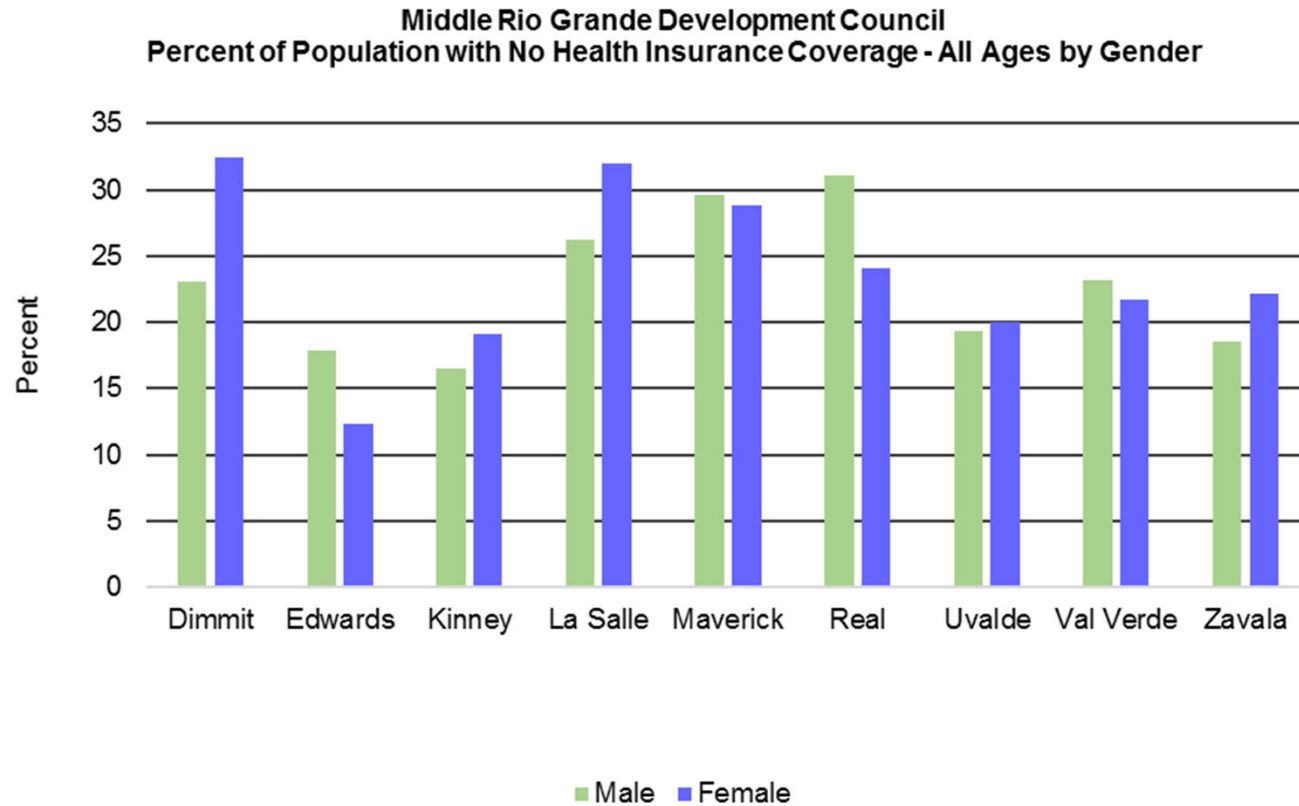

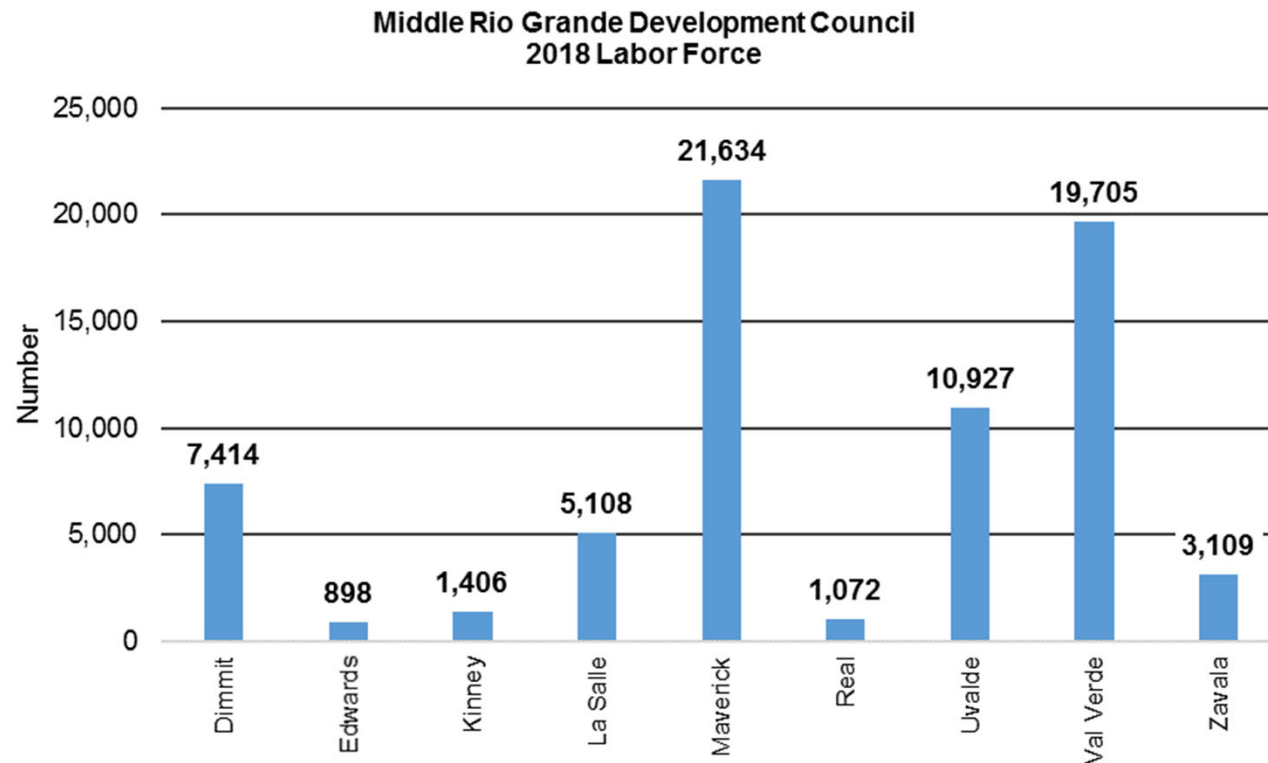

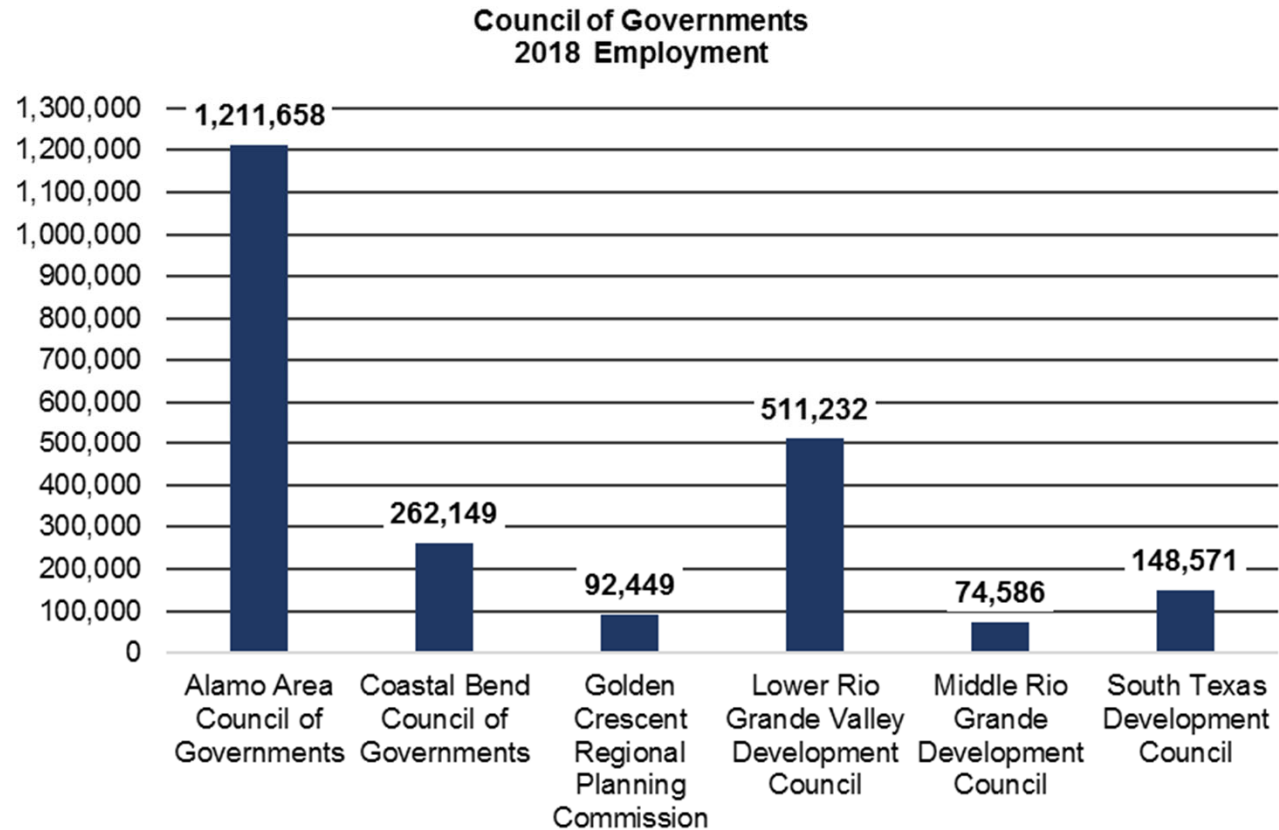

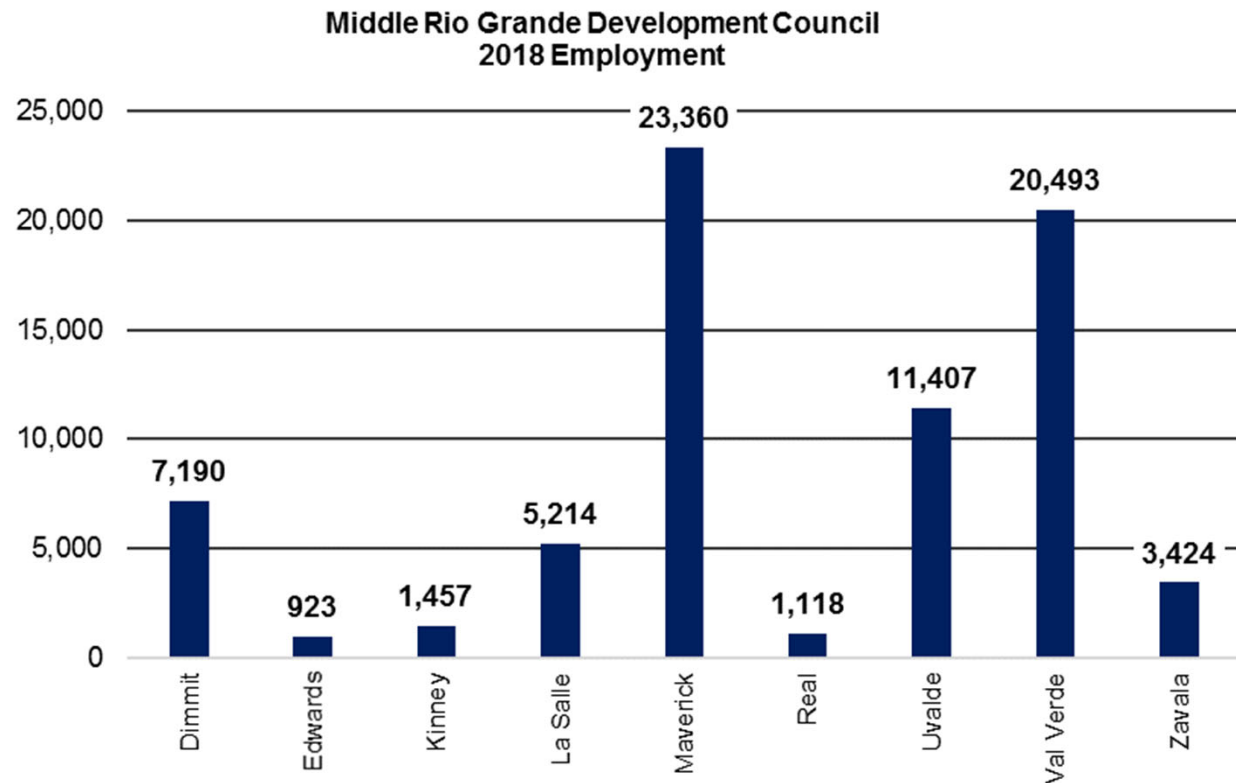

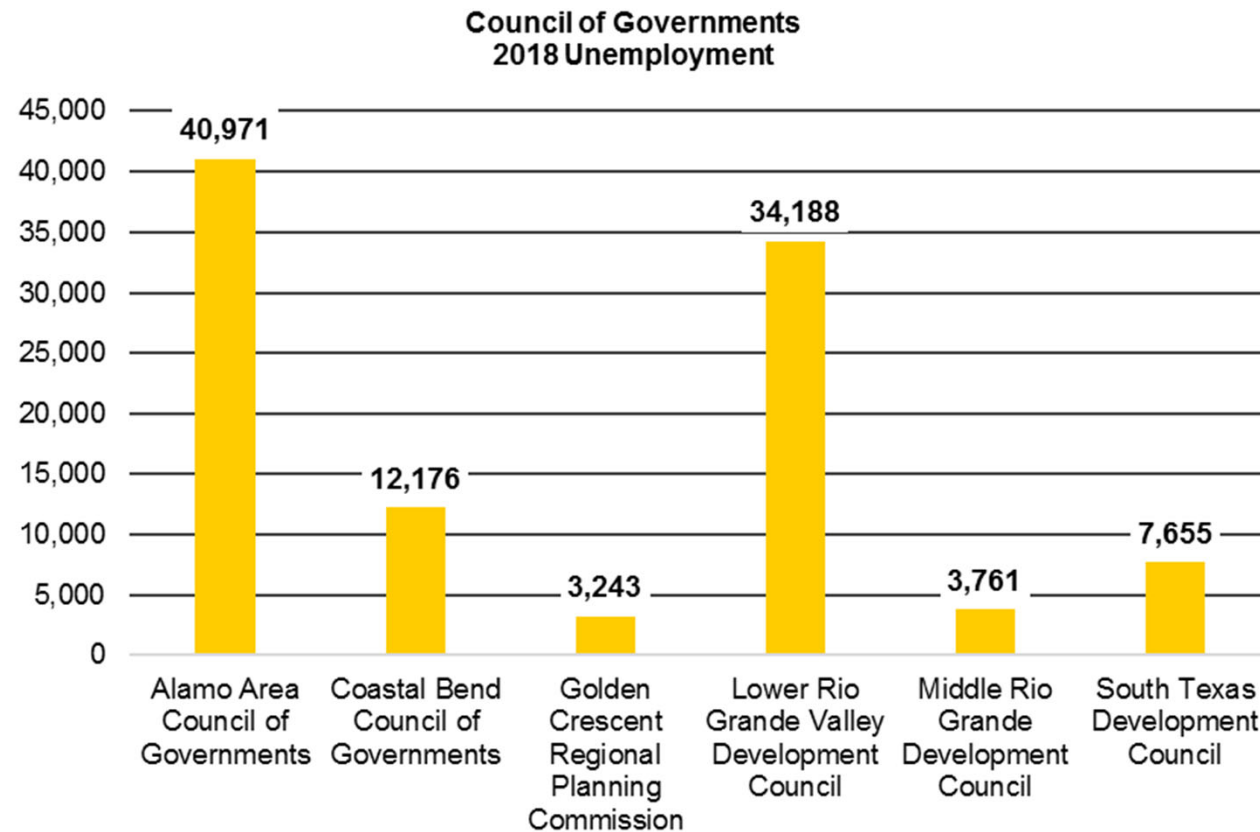

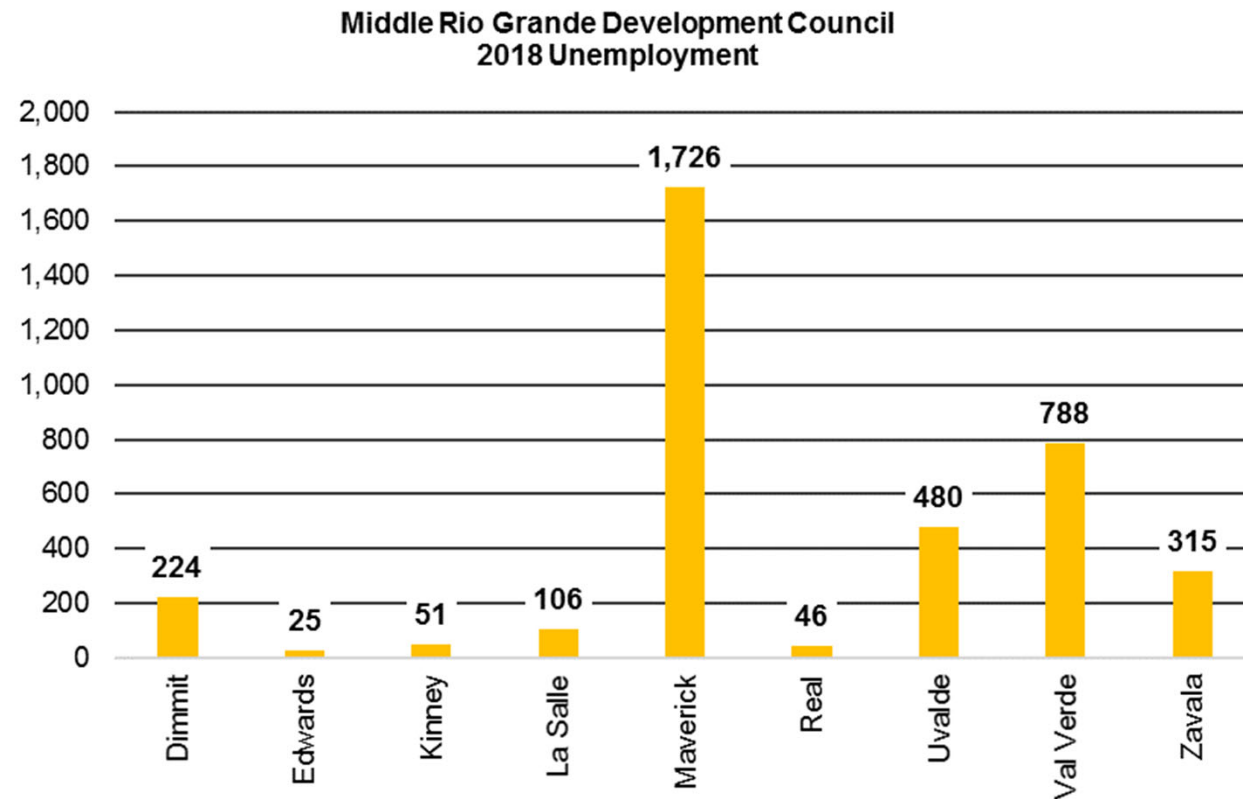

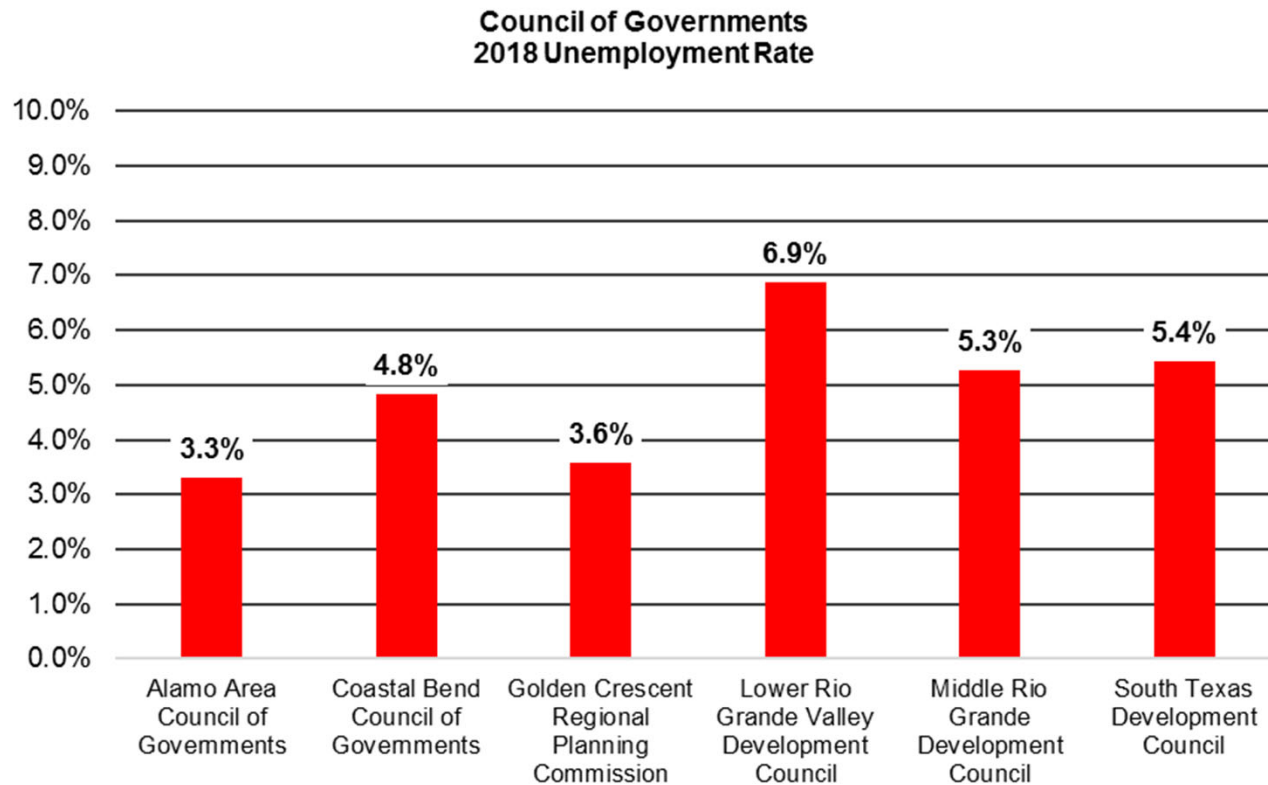
